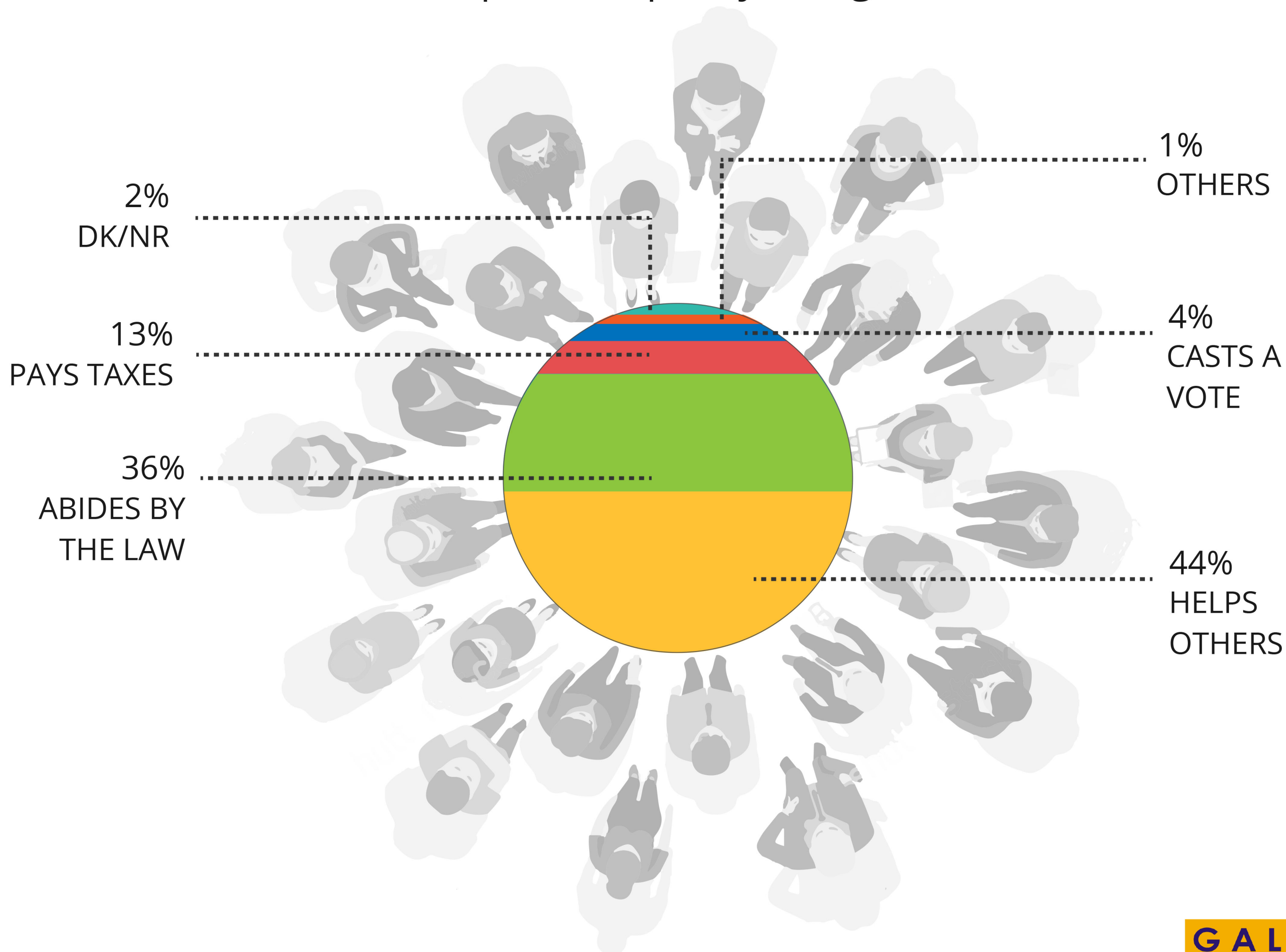

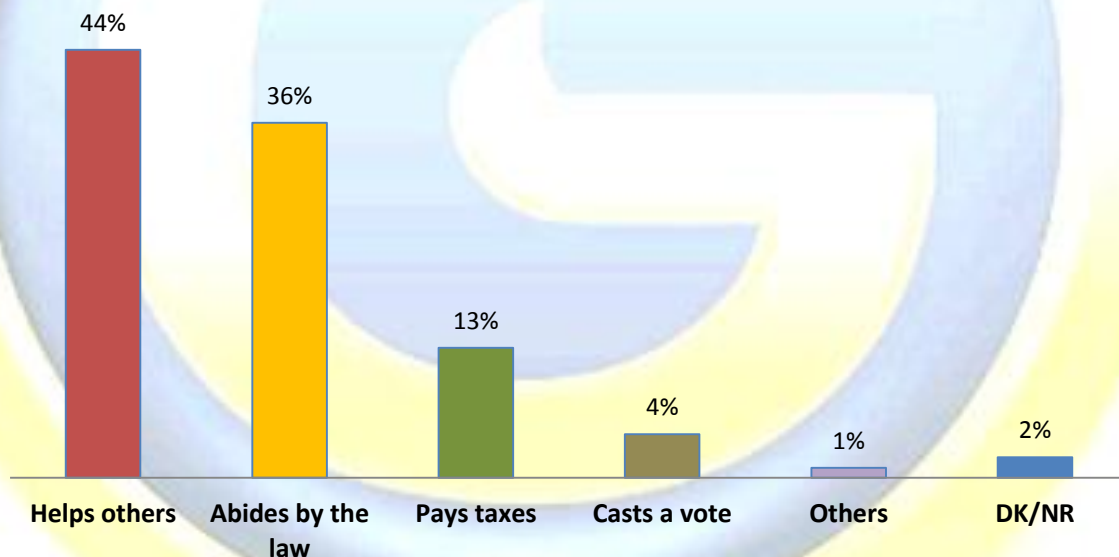

Islamabad, September 20, 2019

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, only 13% Pakistanis cite paying taxes as the most important quality of a good citizen.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Which is the most important quality of a good citizen?” In response, 44% said that a good citizen is one who helps others whereas 36% felt a good citizen is one who abides by the law. 13% Pakistanis thought that a good citizen is one who pays tax, 4% thought it is one who votes, 1% said a good citizen has other qualities and remaining 2% did not know/did not wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,372 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during August 02 – August 09, 2019. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level.
