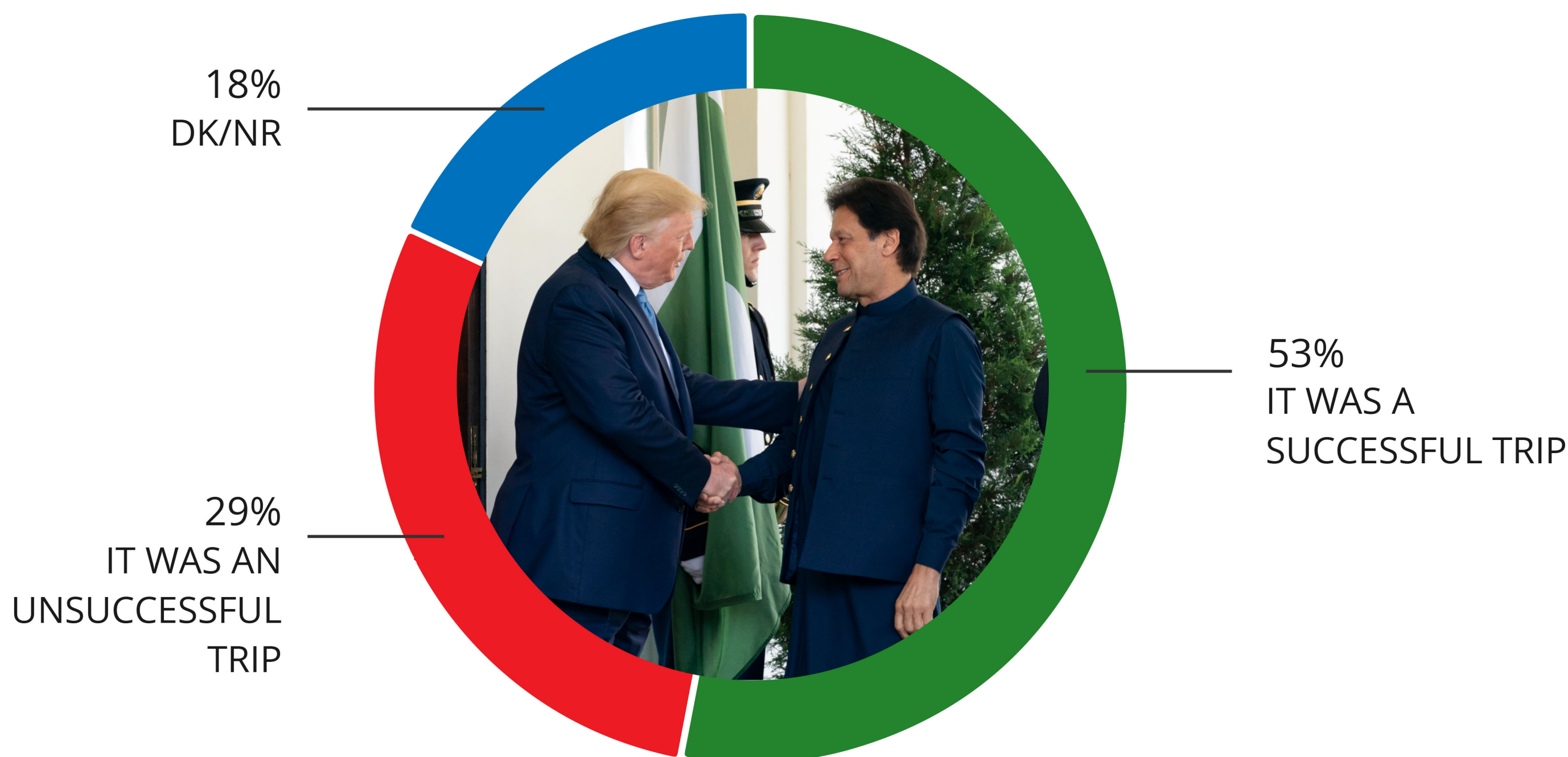

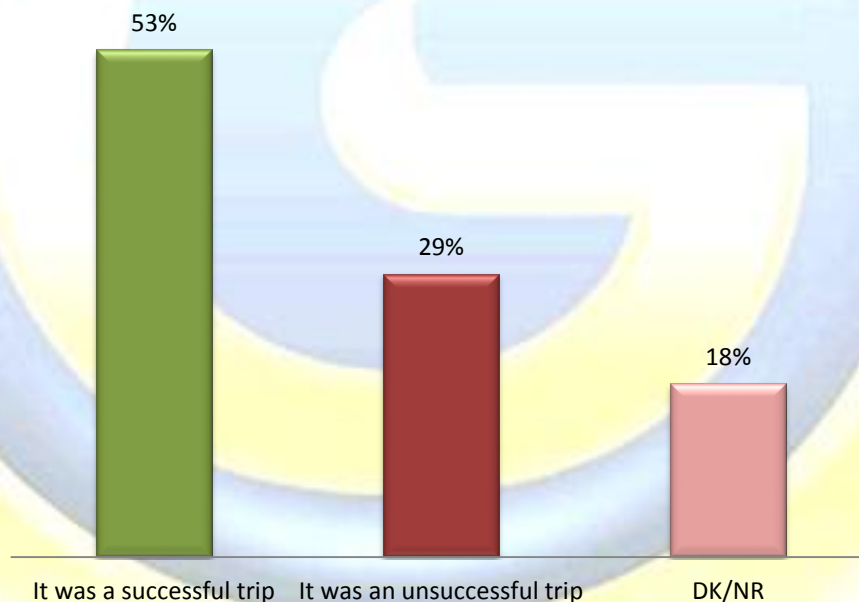

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, over 1 in 2 Pakistanis believe that Prime Minister Imran Khan's recent visit to America was a success

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, "Some days ago Prime Minister Imran Khan visited United States of America. Some people think his visit was successful while some think his visit was a failure. What is your opinion on this matter?" In response, 53% believed that it was a successful trip whereas 29% Pakistanis felt that it was an unsuccessful trip. 18% said they did not know/wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,372 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during August 02 – August 09, 2019. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
