

Public Opinion Polling on China-Pakistan Economic Corridor

The results in this Report do not represent views held by the authors or Gallup Pakistan. The results only represent public opinion, computed on the basis of views expressed by anonymous respondents selected through the procedure outlined in the Methodology section of this Report.



Executive Summary

Section 1: Awareness of CPEC in Pakistan

In 2018, nearly half the Pakistanis reported that they are not familiar with CPEC.

Respondents were asked if they were familiar with the agreement signed between China and Pakistan, the Pak-China Economic Corridor. In response, only 29% respondents said that they were familiar with it, while 49% said they were not familiar with it.

Similar questions were asked in 2015 and 2016. Interestingly, awareness of CPEC among the Pakistani population has shown a decline over the years.

Section 2: People's Perception of the Importance of CPEC

65% of Pakistanis believe CPEC is beneficial for Pakistan.

Respondents were asked whether they think CPEC is beneficial or harmful for Pakistan. 65% said it is very, or only beneficial. Only 5% said it is very harmful or only harmful. 3% of the respondents said CPEC is neither beneficial nor harmful for Pakistan.

Majority of Pakistanis opine that CPEC is important for the development of Pakistan.

Repondents were asked how important the Pak China Corridor is for the development of Pakistan. 86% said it is very important, or important to some extent. Only 14% respondents were of the opinion that it is not important at all, or unimportant to some extent.

Section 3: Chinese President's Visit to Pakistan

A large majority of Pakistanis (94%) had heard of the Chinese President, Xi Jinping's visit to Pakistan in 2015.

Respondents were asked if they had heard or read about the Chinese President's visit to Pakistan. 94% said yes, they had heard or read about it. Only 6% said no.



Majority of the respondents opined that the visit was successful in strengthening ties between Pakistan and China.

Respondents were asked how successful was the visit in strengthening bilateral trade, economic and social ties between Pakistan and China. 89% of the respondents said that it was very much, or somewhat successful, while only 11% said that the visit was very little, or not at all successful.

A large proportion (87%) of the respondents was of the opinion that the Pakistan economy will be affected positively in the future by Chinese aid.

Respondents were asked to what extent in their opinion will the Pakistan economy be affected positively in the future by Chinese aid and provision of loans worth billions of dollars. 87% of the respondents said the economy would be very much or somewhat positively affected, while 11% were of the opinion that there would be very little effect, or not at all.

More than half the proportion of respondents was of the opinion that the Pak-Iran Gas Pipeline Project would have a very positive impact on Pakistan's economy.

Following up, the respondents were asked to report their opinion on the negative or positive affect of the Pak-Iran Gas Pipeline Project on the country's economy. 56% of the respondents were of the opinion that the effect would be very positive, and 30% opined that it would be somewhat positive. On the contrary, 12% respondents said that the effect of the Pipeline Project will be somewhat negative, and only 2% said that the impact would be very negative.

Section 4: Miscellaneous

In 2015, a large proportion (82%) of the respondents thought that the Chinese investment in energy plans can lead to an end to the energy crisis in Pakistan within two years.

Respondents were asked if they think that with China's help, the implementation of energy plans can lead to an end to the energy crisis in Pakistan within 2 years. 82% of the respondents said yes, while 17% said no.

76% of the respondents are of the view that China plans the Pak-China Economic Corridor.

Respondents were asked which country they think plans CPEC. 76% of the respondents said China, while only 9% said Pakistan.



Nearly 2 in 3 respondents opine that including Saudi Arabia in CPEC is a good step.

Respondents were their opinion on including Saudi Arabia in CPEC. 64% of the respondents were of the view that this is a good step, while 26% were of the view that this is a bad step. 11% respondents didn't know or did not respond.

Nearly half the respondents (43%) disagreed with India's opinion that China shouldn't invest heavily in Pakistan given the security conditions in the country.

Respondents were asked their opinion on India's concern over China's investment in Pakistan because of the prevailing security condition in the country. 43% respondents were of the view that India's opinion is very, or somewhat incorrect. On the contrary, 31% respondents said that India's opinion is very or somewhat correct. 14% said it is neither incorrect, nor correct.

2 in 5 respondents opine that Pak-China agreements don't pose a threat to India at all.

Respondents were asked regarding India's concern that Pak-China agreements pose a great threat to India. 41% respondents said that the agreements don't post any threat to India at all, and 16% said that there is very little threat. On the contrary, 20% said that India is greatly threatened, and 22% said that it is somewhat threatened.

72% respondents are of the opinion that the relationship between Pakistan and China is stable.

Respondents were asked their opinion on the relationship between Pakistan and China. 72% said the relationship is very stable, or stable to an extent. On the contrary, only 9% said their relationship is unstable, or very unstable. 19% respondents were of the view that the relationship between Pakistan and China is neither stable, nor unstable.

More than half the respondents are of the view that the tensions between India and Pakistan will have a negative impact on CPEC.

Respondents were asked to what extent, in their opinion, the recent tensions between India and Pakistan will have a negative impact on the Pak China Economic Corridor project. 58% respondents said that the impact will be very negative, or negative to some extent. Whereas, 40% respondents were of the view that there will be very less, or no negative impact at all.



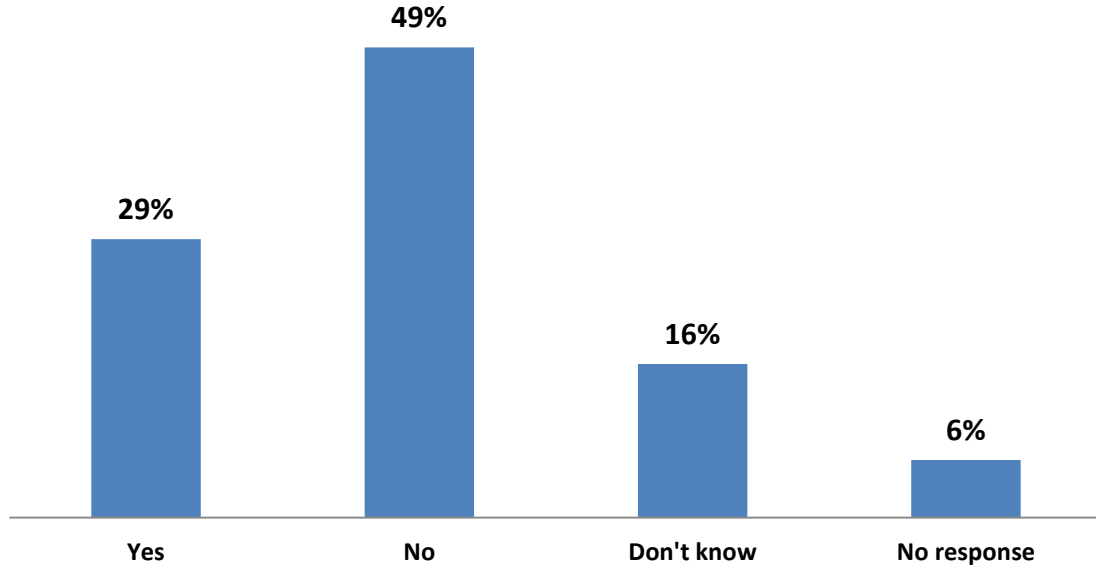

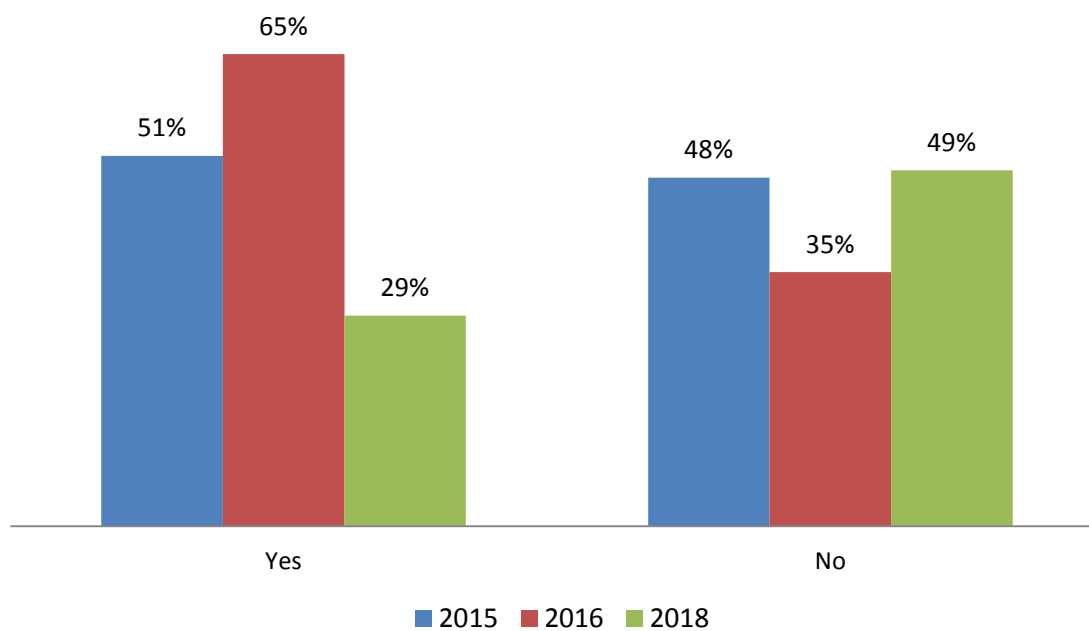

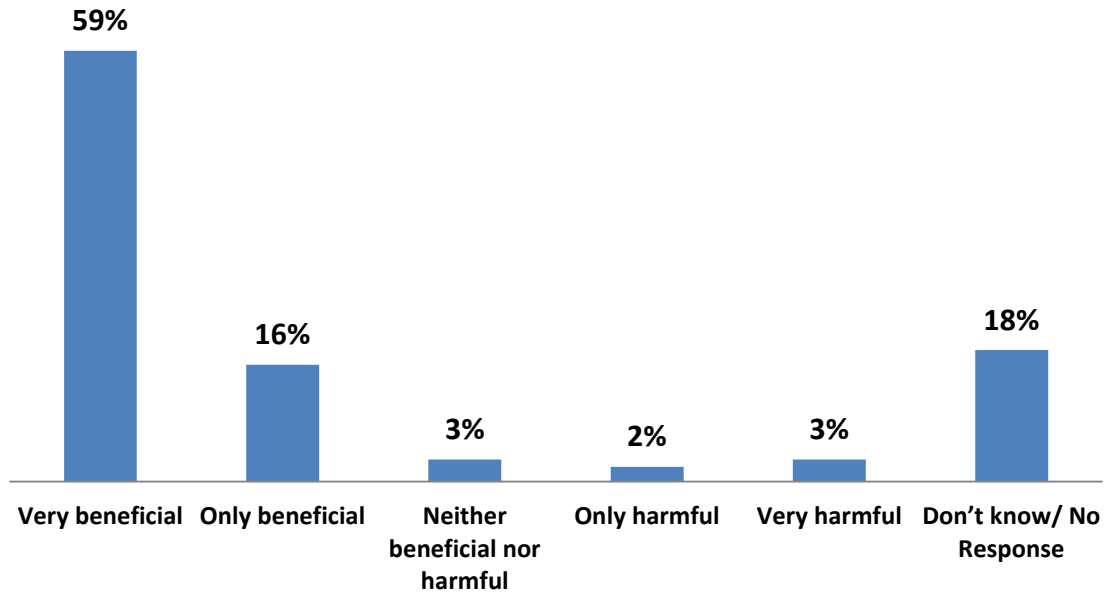

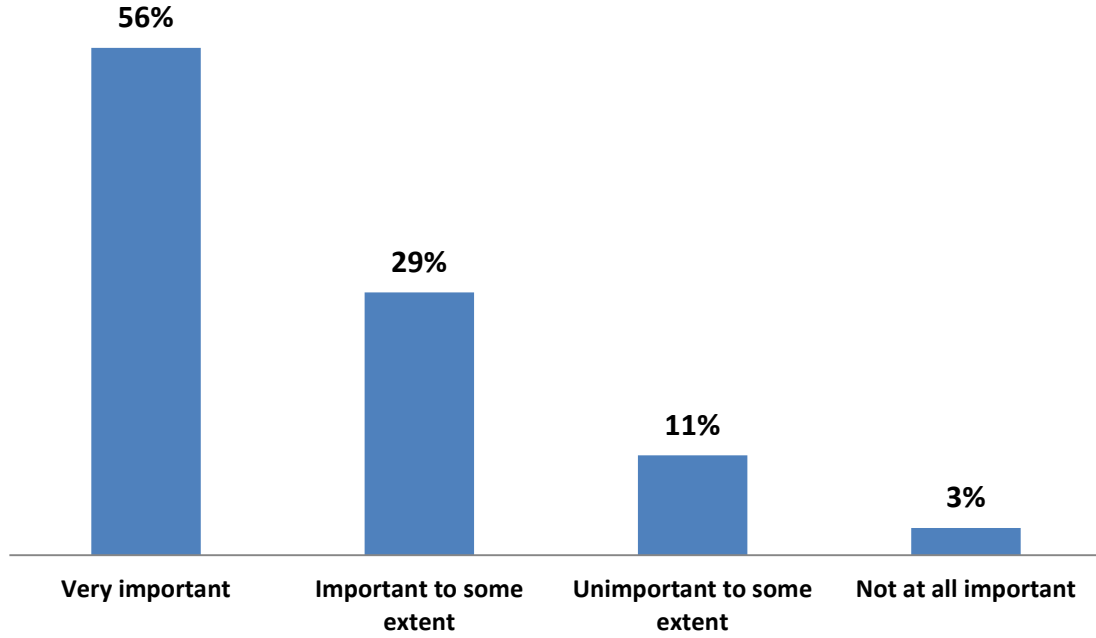

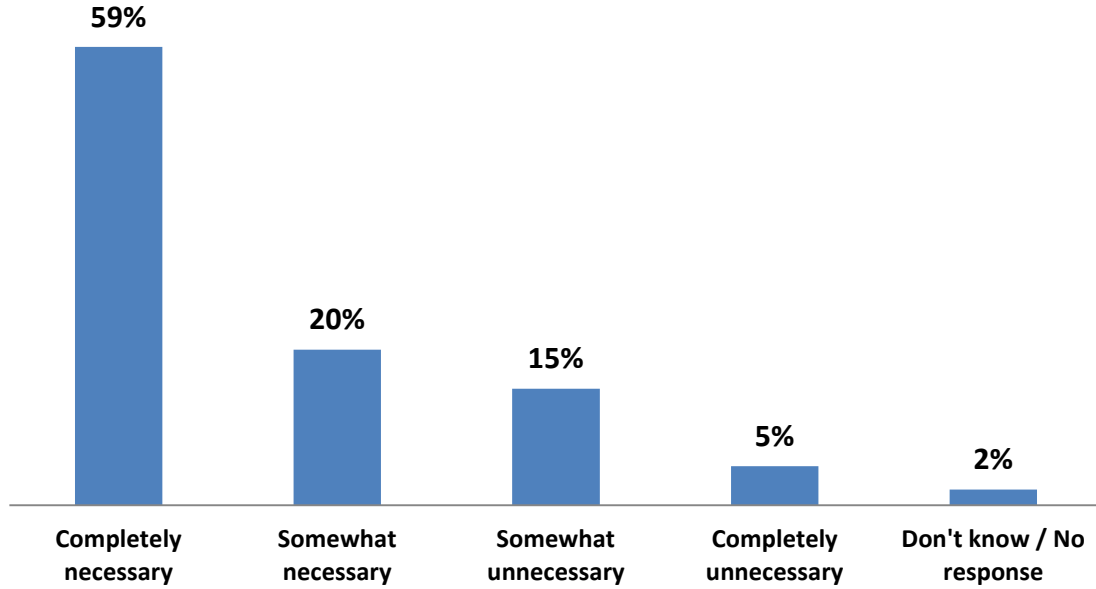

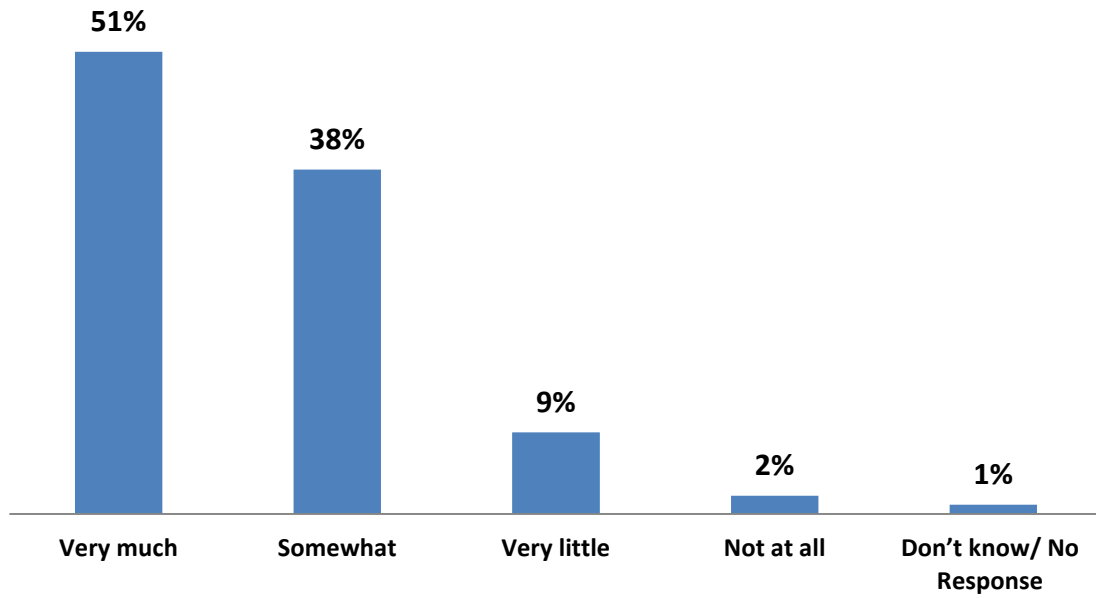

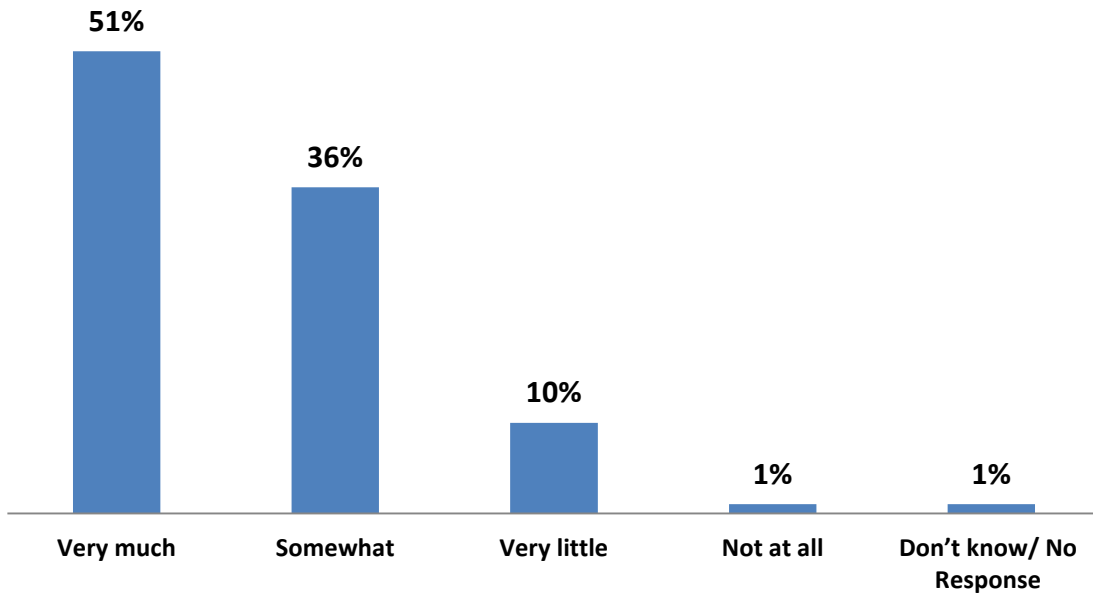

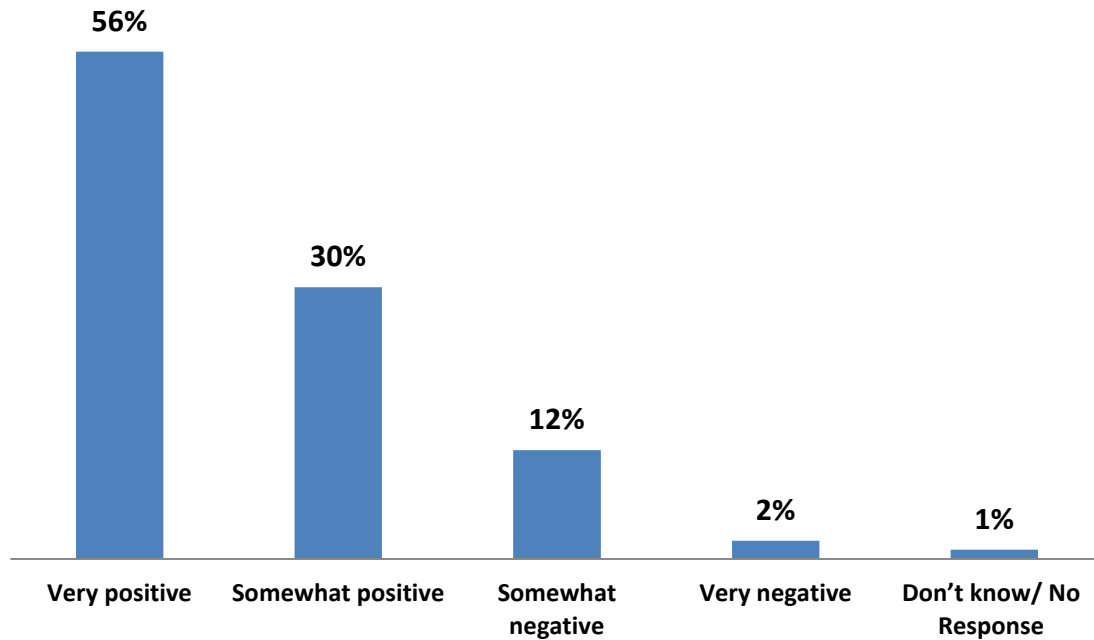

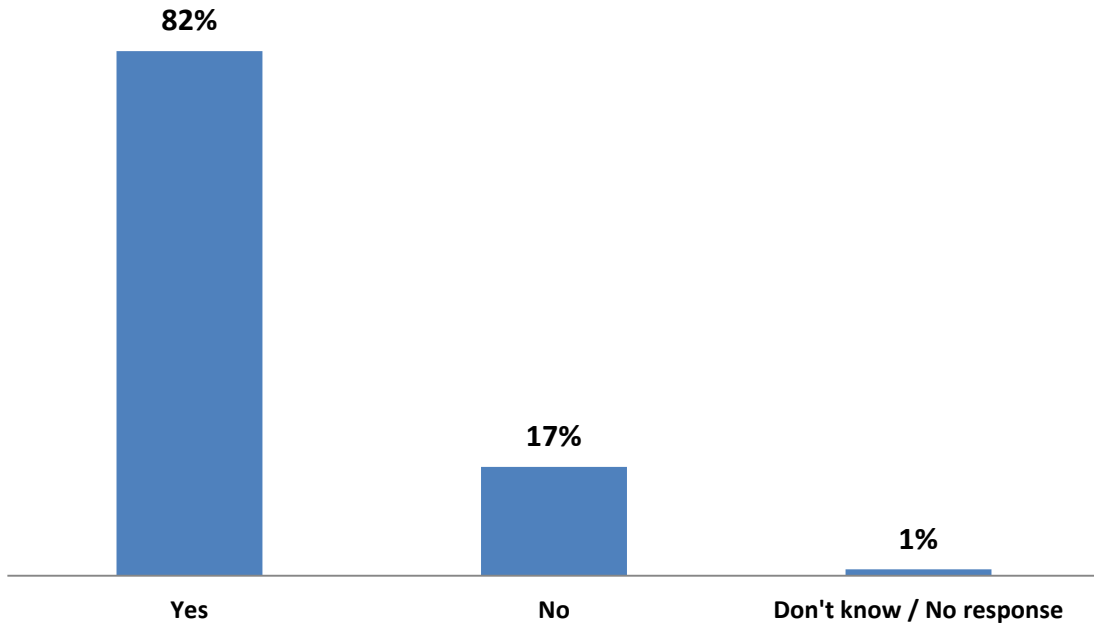

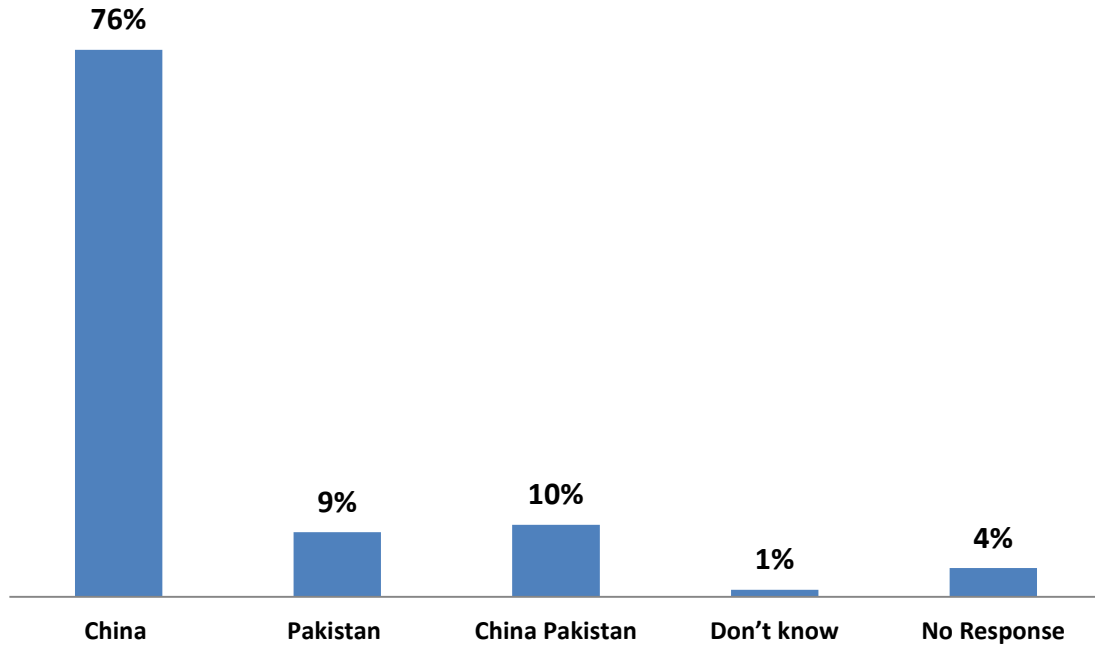

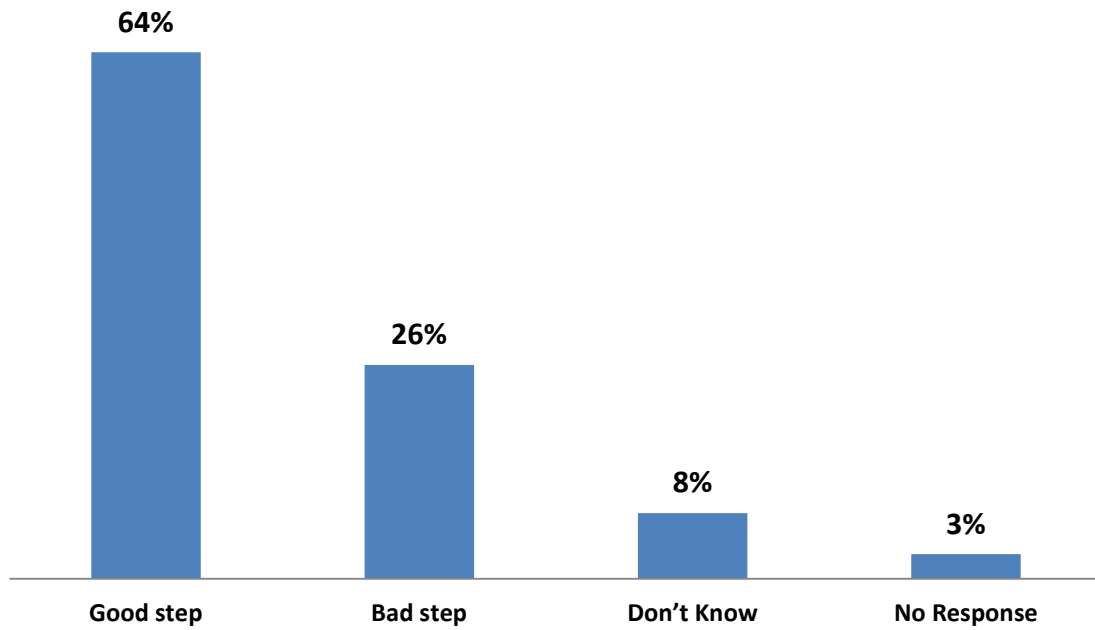

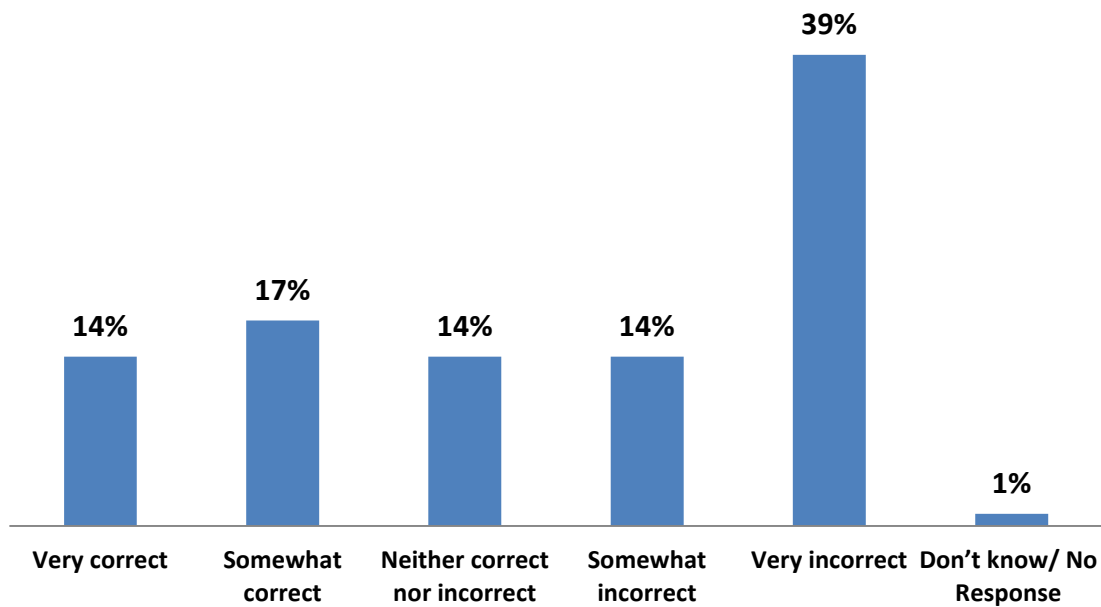

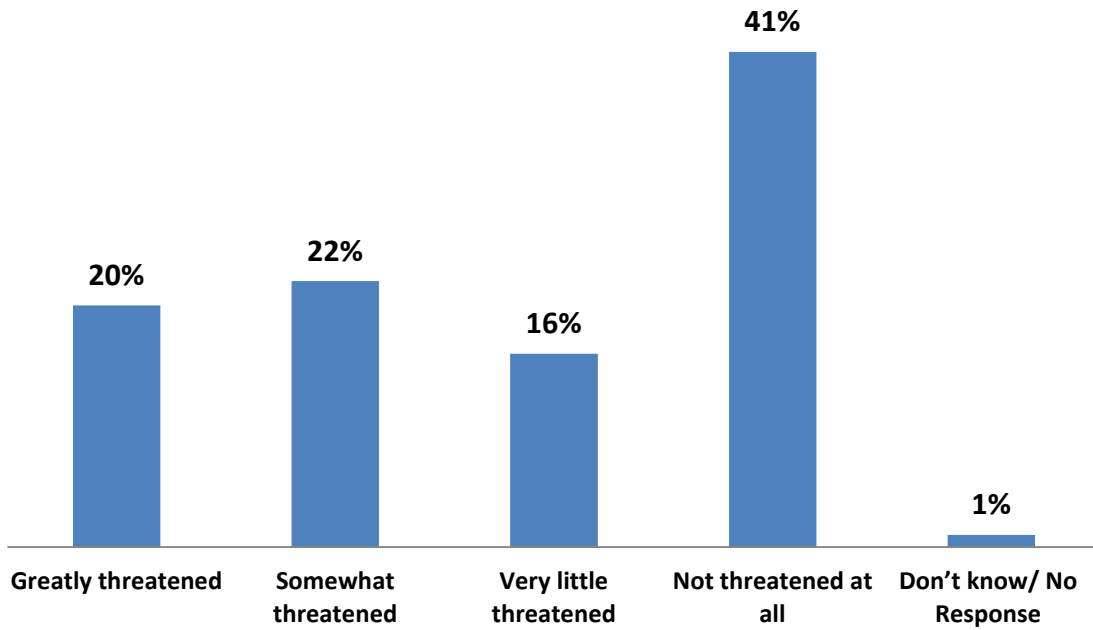

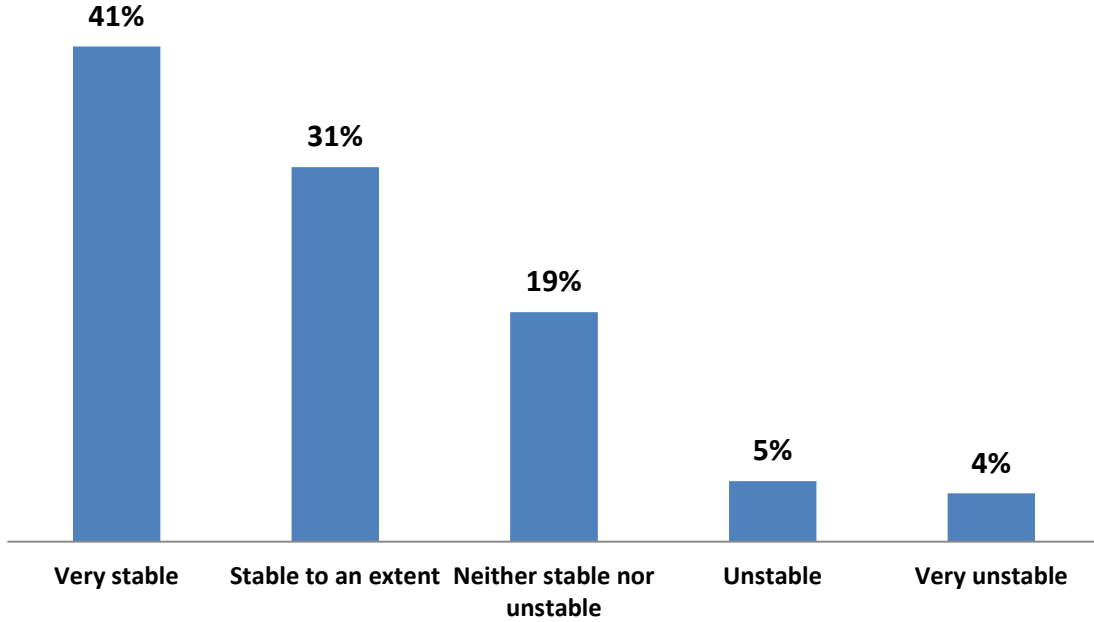

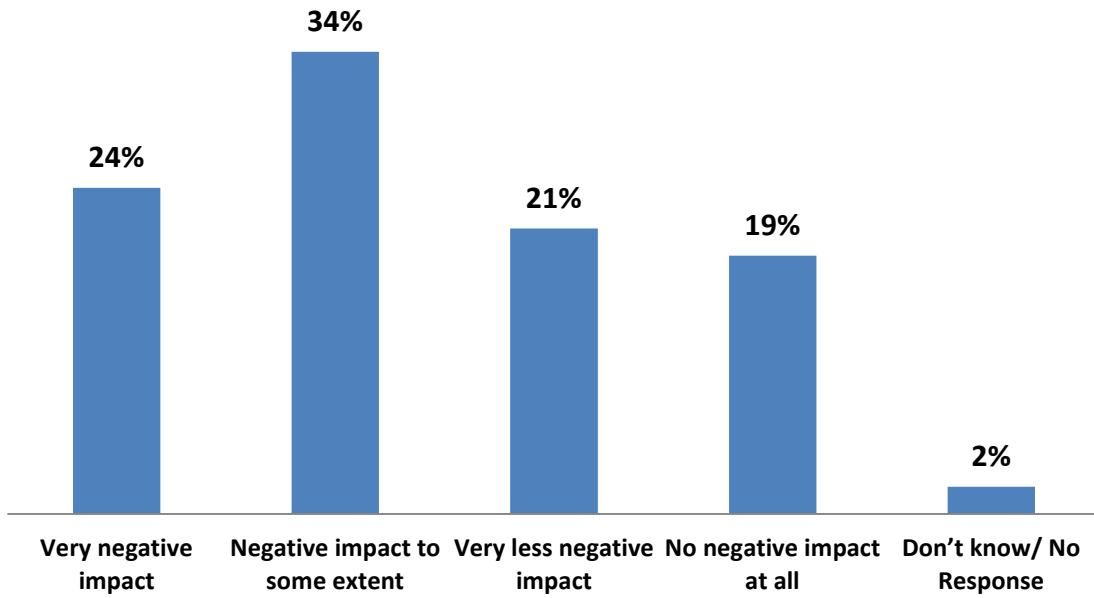
