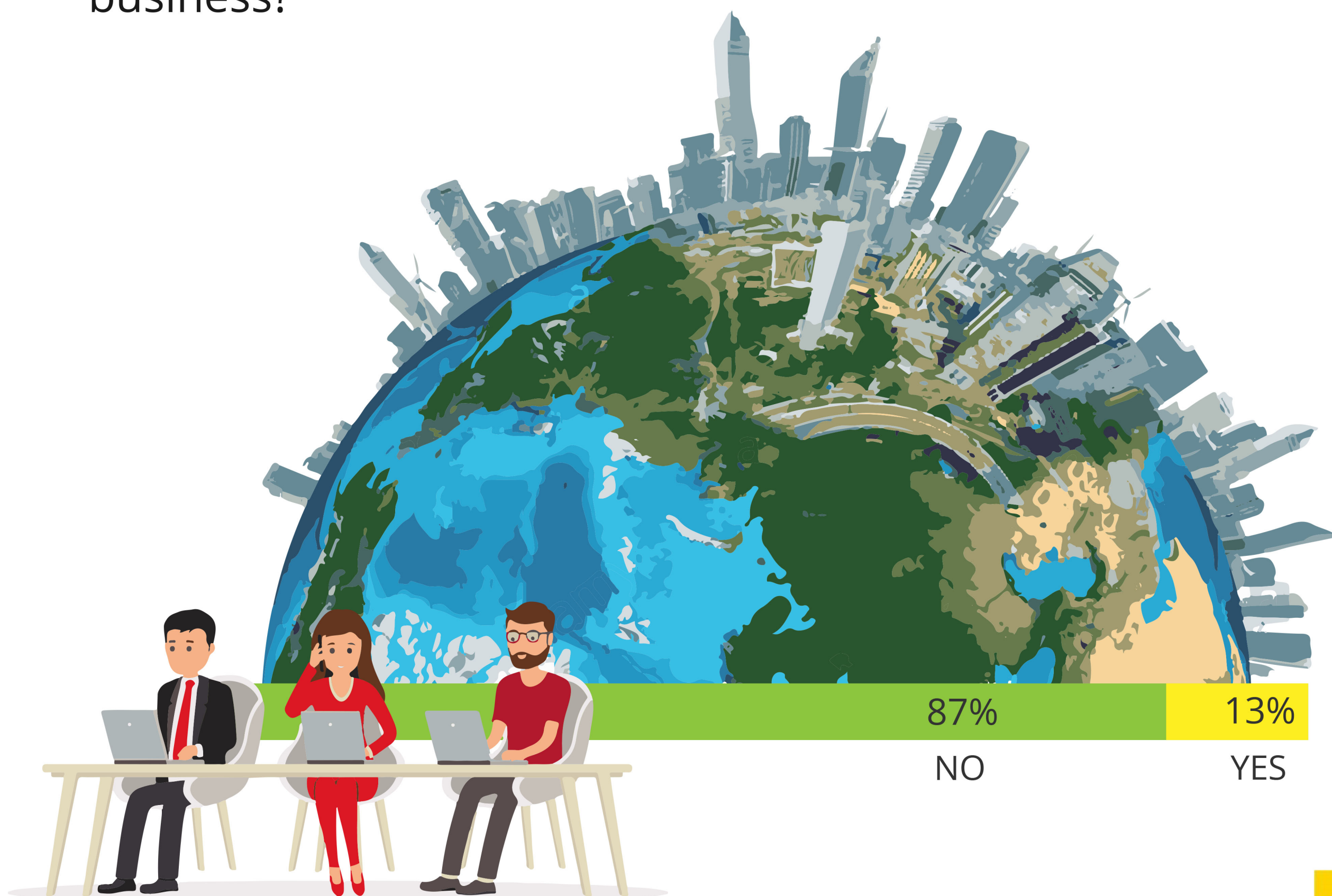

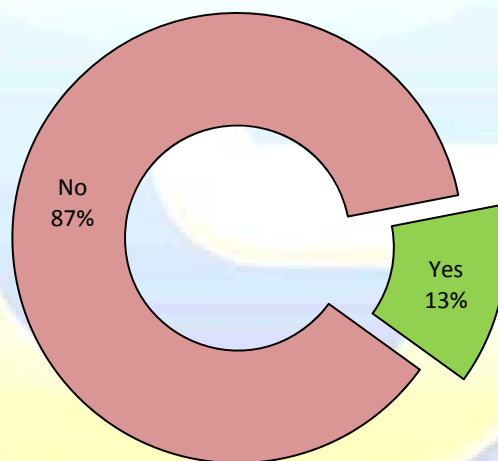
Almost 1 in 10 (13 %) Pakistanis claim that someone from their immediate family is working abroad.(GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)

Islamabad, October 15, 2019

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 13% of Pakistanis say that a household member gone abroad for a job or business.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, *“Has anyone in your household (household means your mother, father, son / daughter, sister / brother, etc.) gone abroad for a job or a business?”* In response, 87% said no, and 13% said yes.

Question: “Has anyone in your household (household means your mother, father, son/daughter, sister/brother) gone abroad for a job or a business?”



This translates to roughly 4 million Pakistanis working abroad, which is an exceptionally large number. These Pakistanis contribute almost 20 billion USD to Pakistani economy in form of remittances.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,287 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during September 22 - September 30, 2019. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
