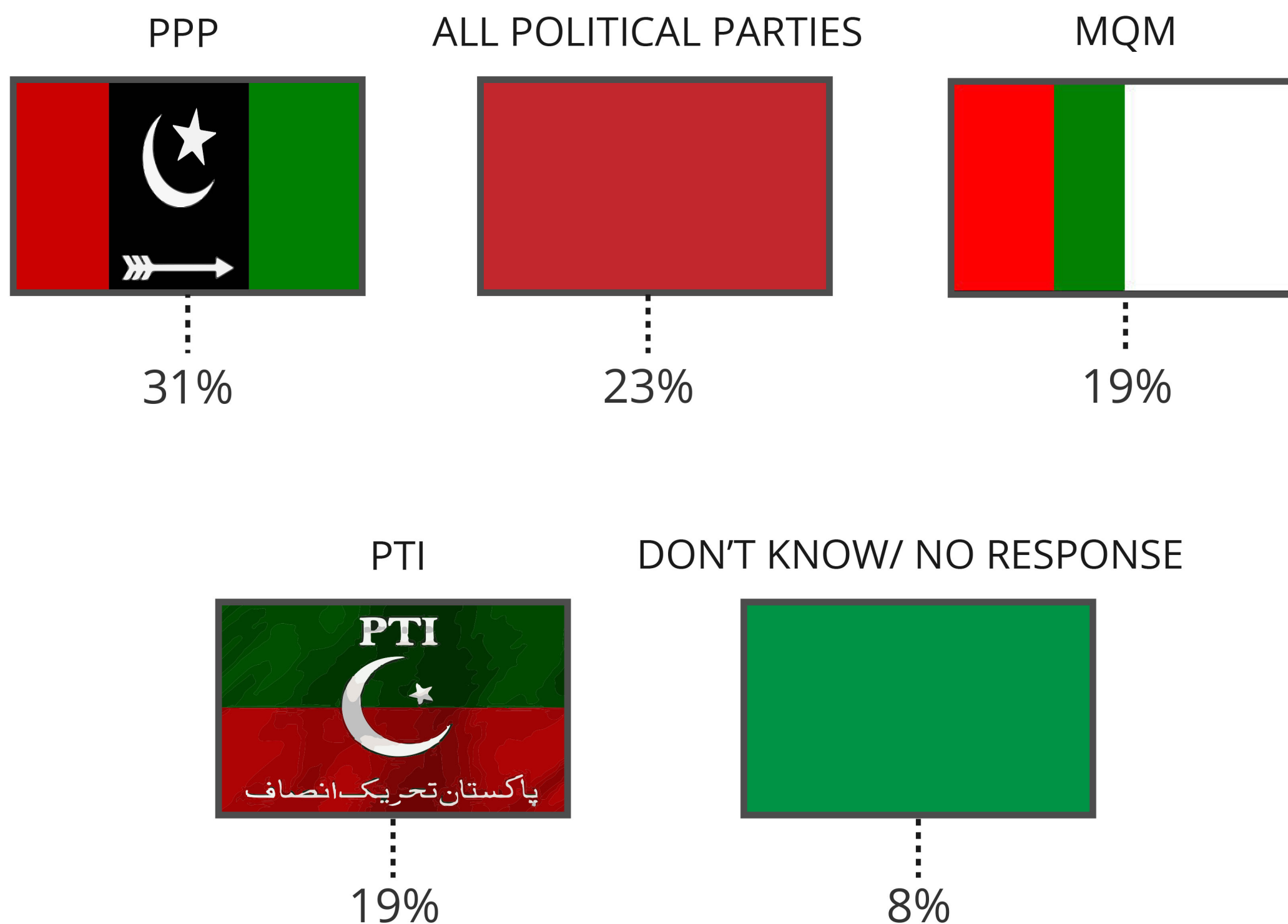

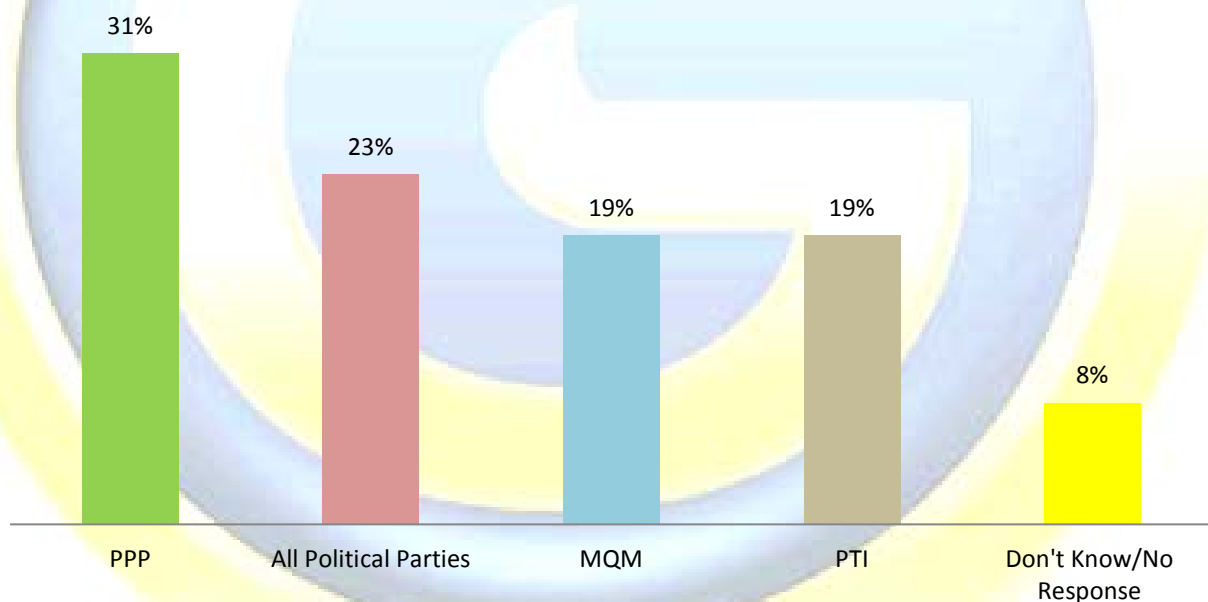
Almost 1 in 3 (31%) Pakistanis hold the PPP government currently responsible for the poor performance in Karachi (GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)

Islamabad, October 18, 2019

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 31% of Pakistanis hold the PPP government responsible for the poor performance in Karachi.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “In your opinion, which political party is currently responsible for the poor performance in Karachi?” In response, 31% said PPP, 23% said all, 19% said MQM, 19% said PTI and 8% did not know/ did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,287 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during September 22 - September 30, 2019. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level.
