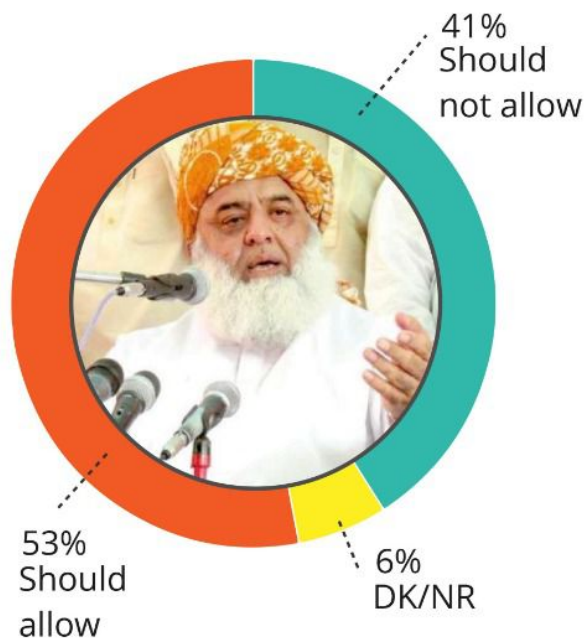


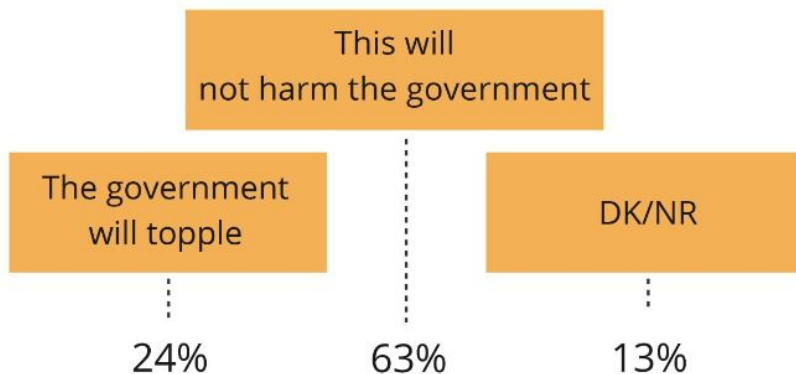

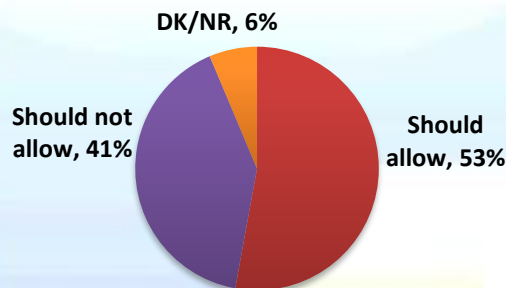

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, more than half the Pakistanis (53%) opine that the PTI government should allow Maulana Fazlur Rehman to conduct the Azadi march. 63% Pakistanis also believe that the March will fail to topple Imran Khan as PM.

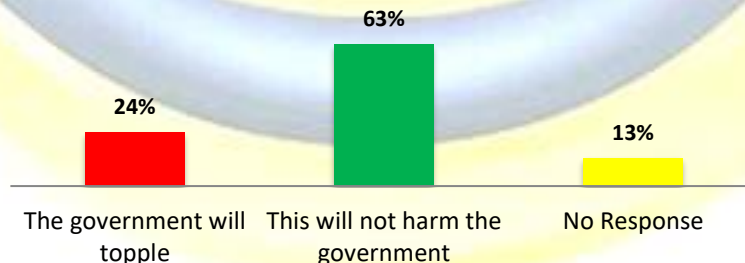
A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, *“Some people believe that the PTI government should allow Maulana Fazlur Rehman to conduct the Azadi march, whereas some people believe that PTI government should not allow Fazlur Rehman to conduct the Azadi March. What is your opinion on this?”* In response, 53% said it should be allowed, 41% said it should not be allowed and 6% did not know/did not respond.

Question: “Some people believe that the PTI government should allow Maulana Fazlur Rehman to conduct the Azadi march, whereas some people believe that PTI government should not allow Fazlur Rehman to conduct the Azadi March. What is your opinion on this?”



Respondents were further asked, *“Some people believe that Maulana Fazlur Rehman’s Azadi march will topple the PTI government, while others believe that it will not harm the PTI government. What is your opinion on this?”* In response, 63% said this will not harm the government, 24% said the government will topple and 13% did not respond.

The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,200 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during October 07 - October 20, 2019. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level.
