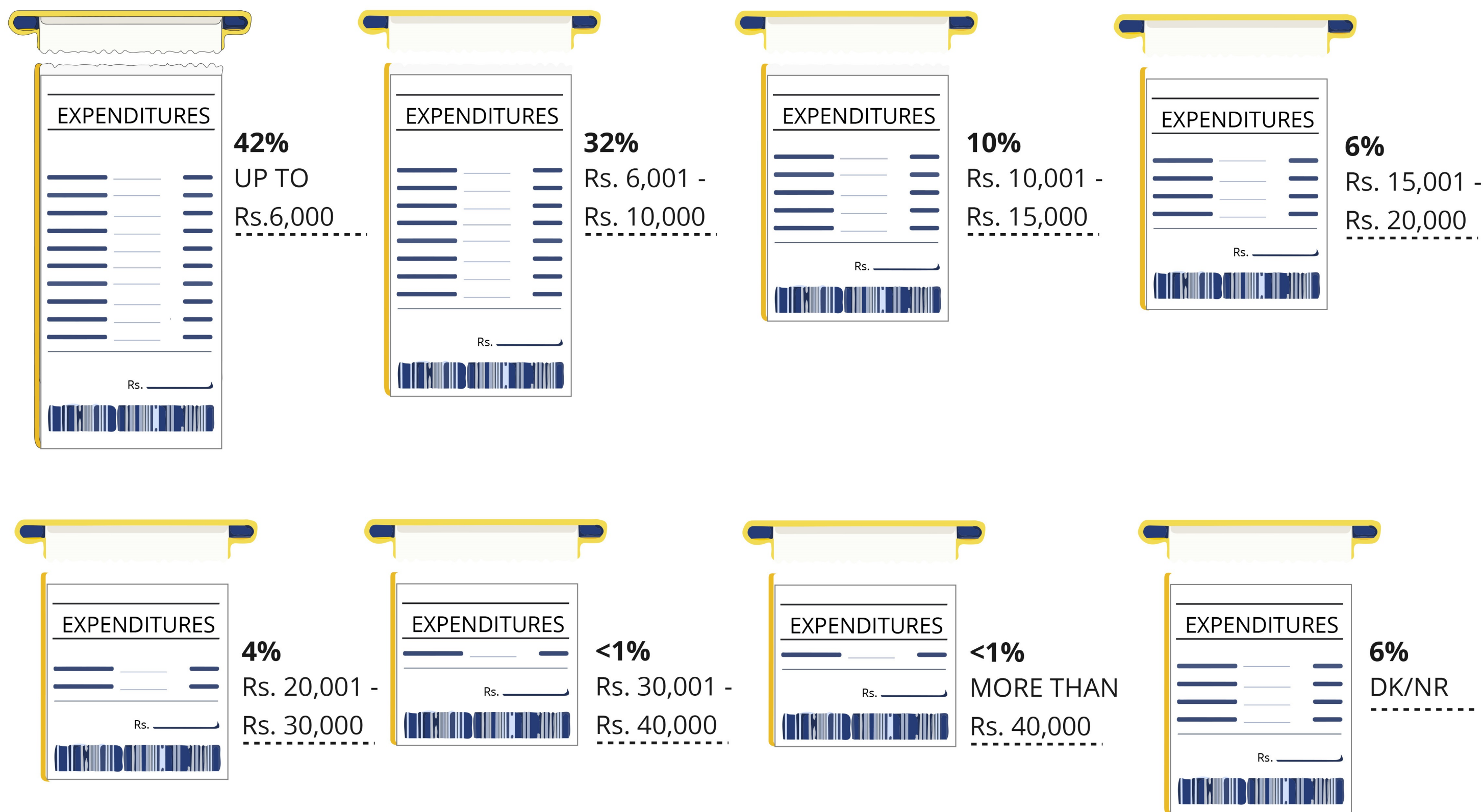

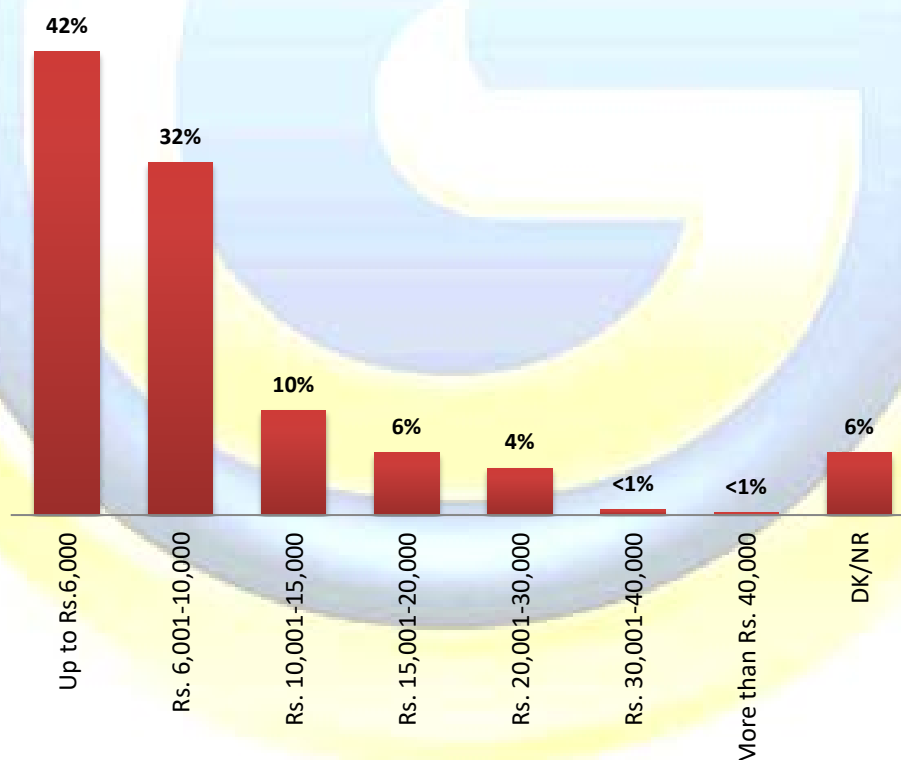

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, over half Pakistanis (52%) claim that their monthly expenditure has increased by more than Rs. 6,000 in the past year.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Kindly tell us, compared to last year by how much has your monthly expenditure increased in this year?” In response, 42% said less than Rs. 5,000, 32% said between Rs. 6,001-10,000, 10% said Rs.10,001- 15,000, 6% said Rs. 15,001-20,000, 4% said Rs. 20,001-30,000 and 6% did not know or wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,200 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during October 07- October 20, 2019. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
