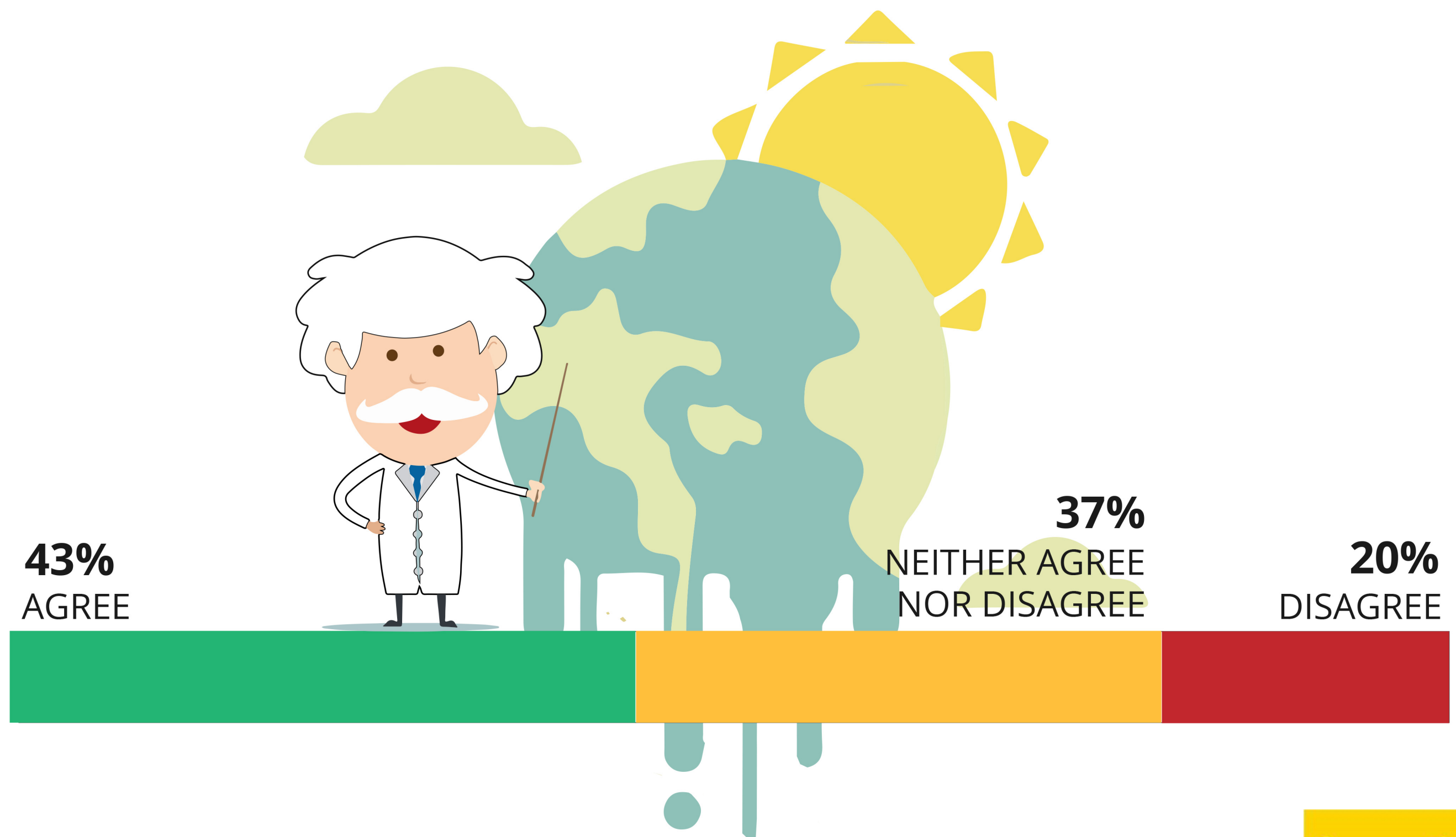

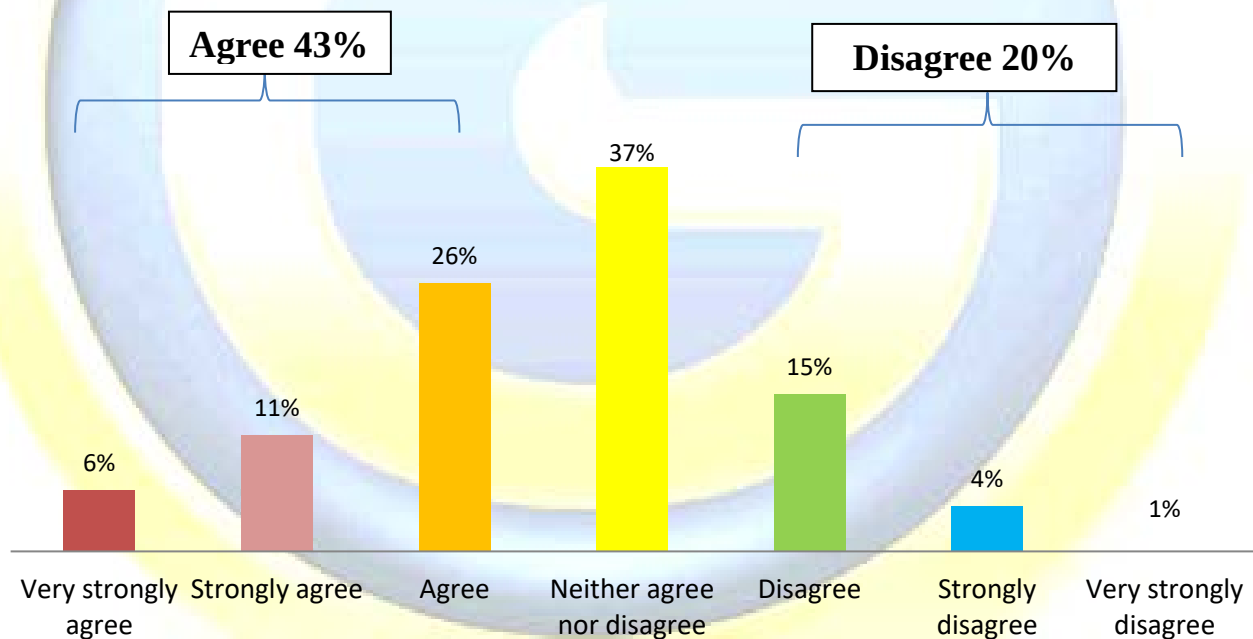

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 43% of Pakistanis are optimistic that scientists will find solutions to climate change without people having to make radical changes to their lifestyle.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, "How strongly do you agree or disagree with the following statement: Scientists will find solutions to climate change without people having to make big changes to their lifestyle." In response, 6% said they very strongly agree, 11% said they strongly agree, 26% said they agree, 37% said they neither agree nor disagree, 15% said they disagree, 4% said they strongly disagree and 1% said they very strongly disagree.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,448 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during June 30-July 09, 2019. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
