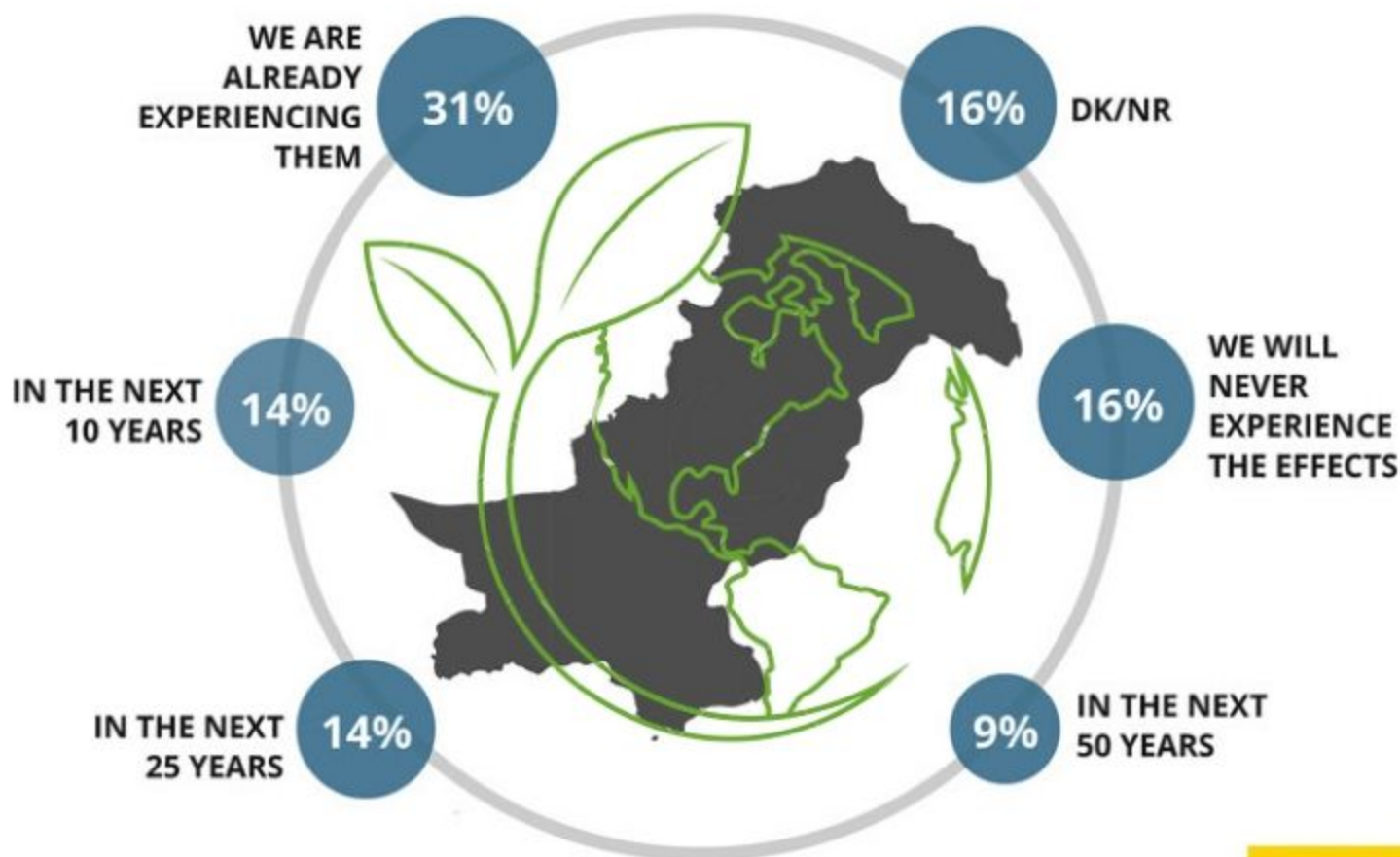

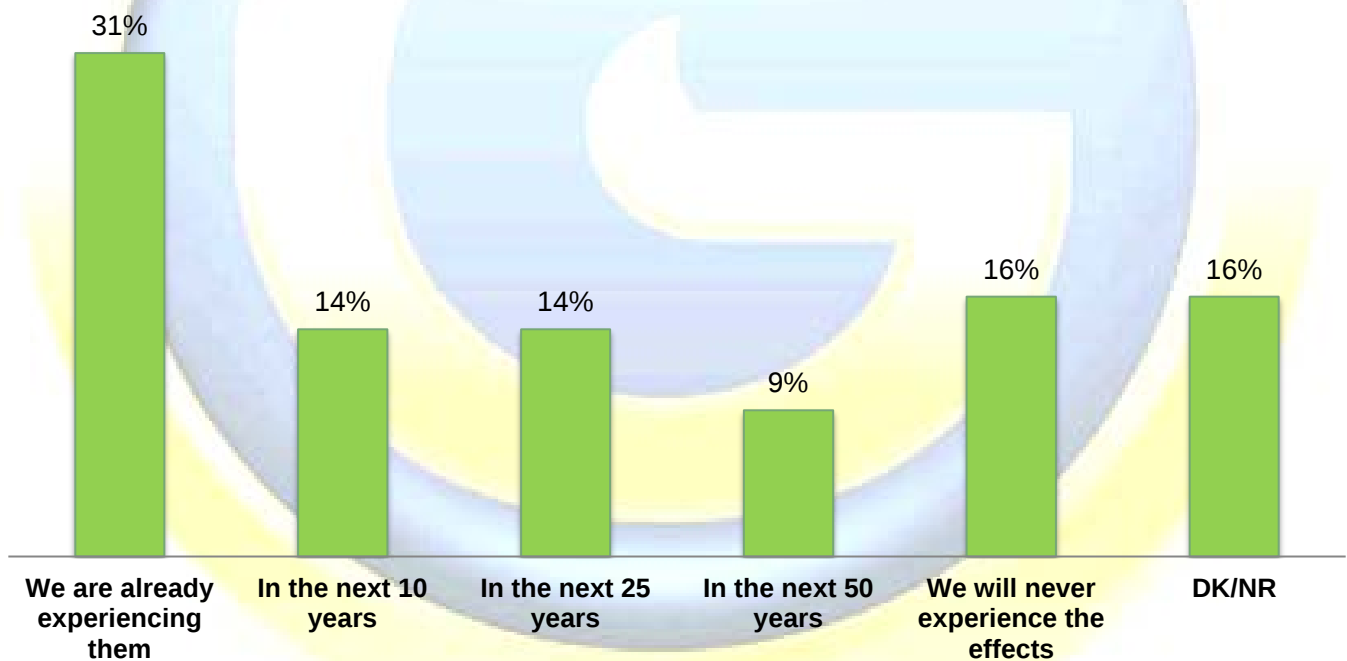
**32 % of Pakistanis either doubt the negative effects of climate change or do not know about them (GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)**

Islamabad, 14 November, 2019

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 32% of Pakistanis either doubt the negative effects of climate change or do not know about them.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “When, if at all, do you think you will start experiencing the effects of climate change in Pakistan?” In response, 31% said we are already experiencing effects of climate change, 14% said in the next 10 years, 14% said in the next 25 years, 9% said in the next 50 years, 16% said we will never experience the effects, and 16% said they did not know or wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,448 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during June 30-July 09, 2019. The error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 2-3$  percent at the 95% confidence level.
