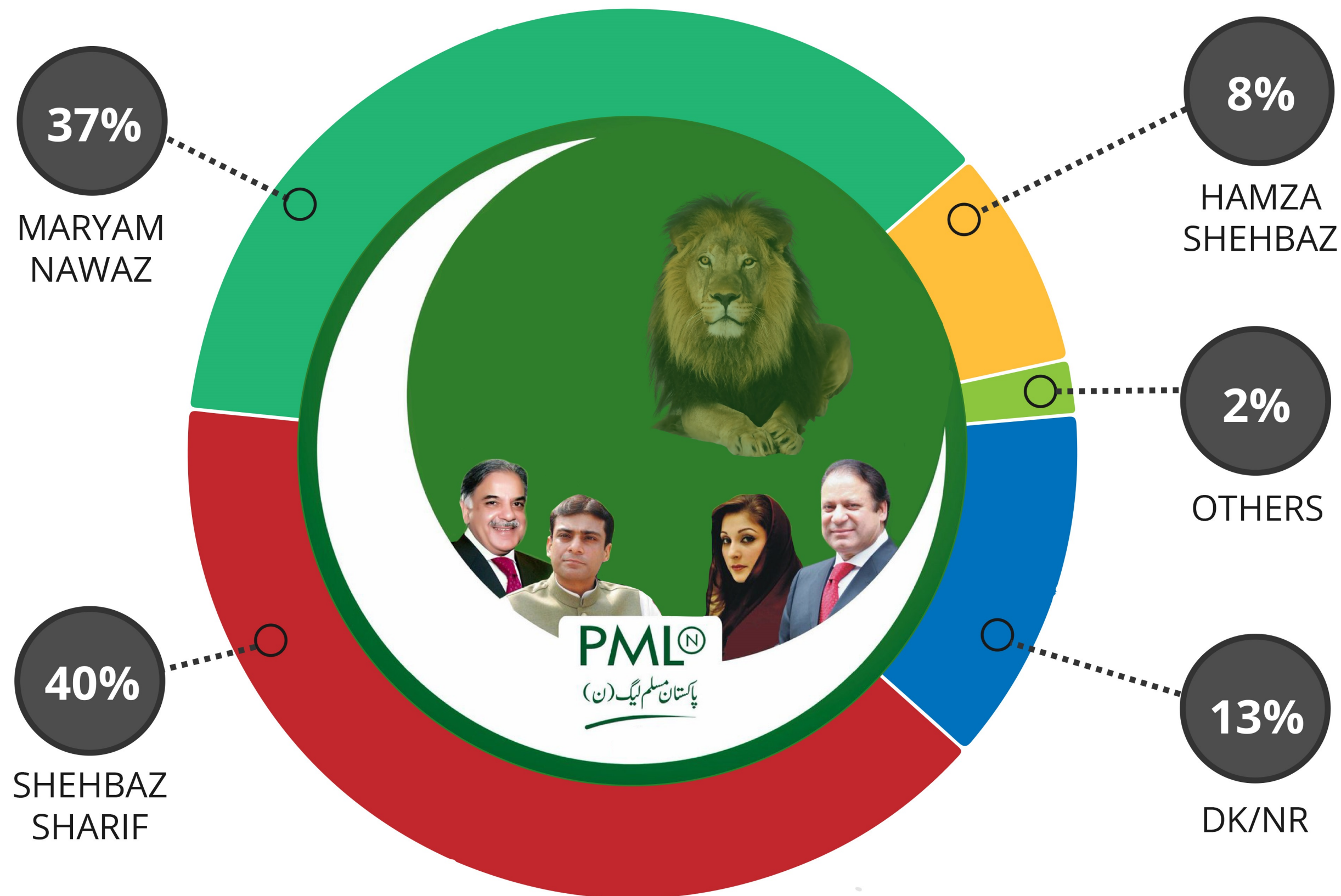

SHEHBAZ SHARIF MORE POPULAR CHOICE TO LEAD PML-N IN THE ABSENCE OF NAWAZ SHARIF, BUT MARYAM NAWAZ FOLLOWS CLOSELY.

**Shehbaz Sharif more popular choice to lead PML-N in the absence of Nawaz Sharif, but Maryam Nawaz follows closely.
(Gallup & Gilani Pakistan Poll)**

Islamabad, 20 November, 2019

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 40% of Pakistanis are of the opinion that Shehbaz Sharif should lead PML-N in the absence of Nawaz Sharif.

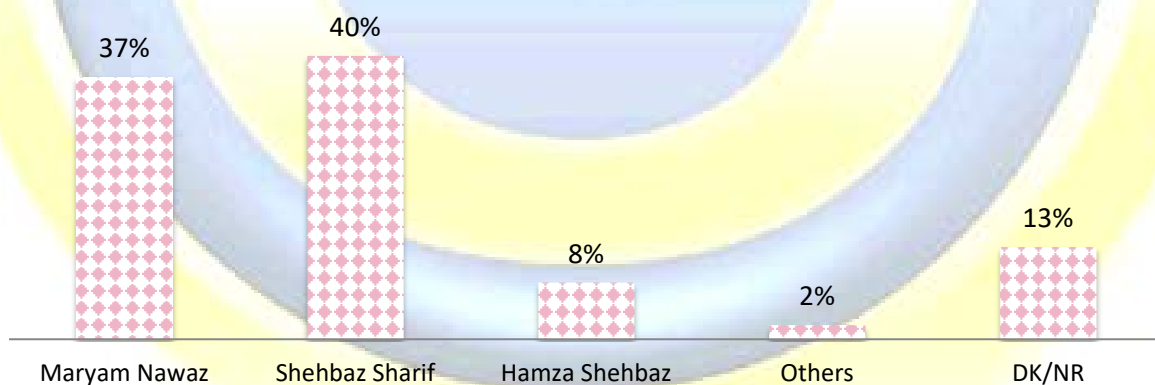
A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “In your opinion who should lead PML-N in the absence of Nawaz Sharif?” In response, 37% chose Maryam Nawaz while 40% said that Shehbaz Sharif should lead PML-N in the absence of Nawaz Sharif. 8% opined that Hamza Shehbaz should lead PML-N, 2% chose someone other than these options and 13% said they did not know or wish to respond.

Gender Breakdown:

Among male respondents, Shehbaz Sharif is even more popular as only 30% males chose Maryam Nawaz, 46% males chose Shehbaz Sharif and 8% chose Hamza Shehbaz.

Among female respondents, Maryam Nawaz is by far a popular choice as 47% chose Maryam Nawaz and only 34% chose Shehbaz Sharif. 10% females chose Hamza Shehbaz as a suitable leader for PML-N in the absence of Nawaz Sharif.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,200 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during November 07 - November 13, 2019. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
