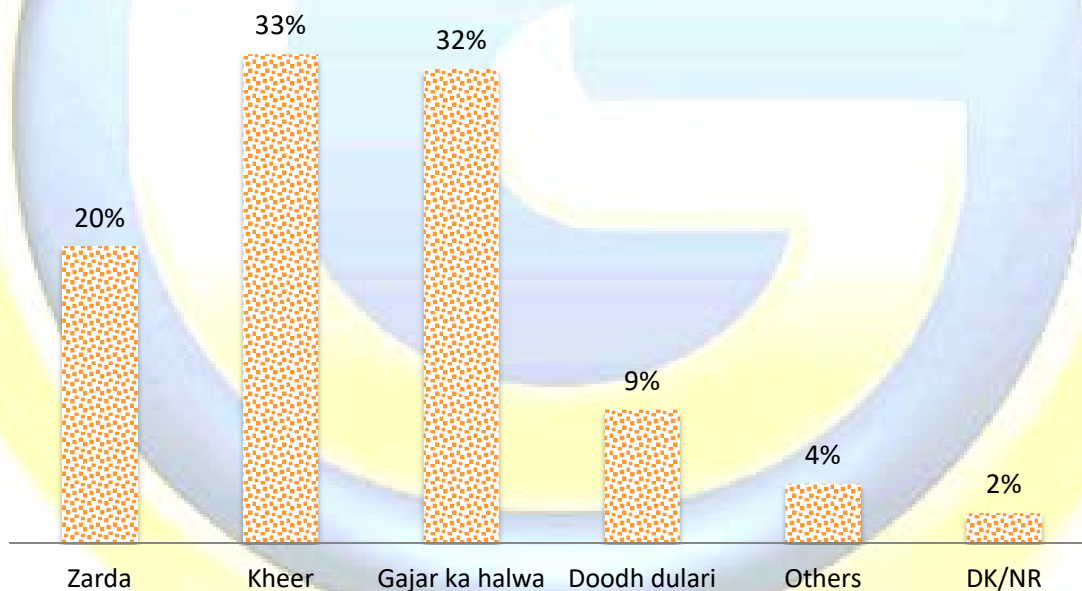

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, Kheer is Pakistan's favorite wedding dessert, followed closely by Gajar ka Halwa.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, "In your opinion, what is the best sweet dish for a wedding function (whether the function is in the morning or in the evening)?" In response, Kheer was preferred by 32% Pakistanis as a sweet dish for a wedding function. Another 33% Pakistan prefer Gajar ka halwa as a sweet dish for a wedding function, 20% Pakistanis prefer Zarda, 9% prefer doodh dulari, and 4% prefer other sweet dishes. 2% did not know or did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,214 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during November 06 - November 09, 2019. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
