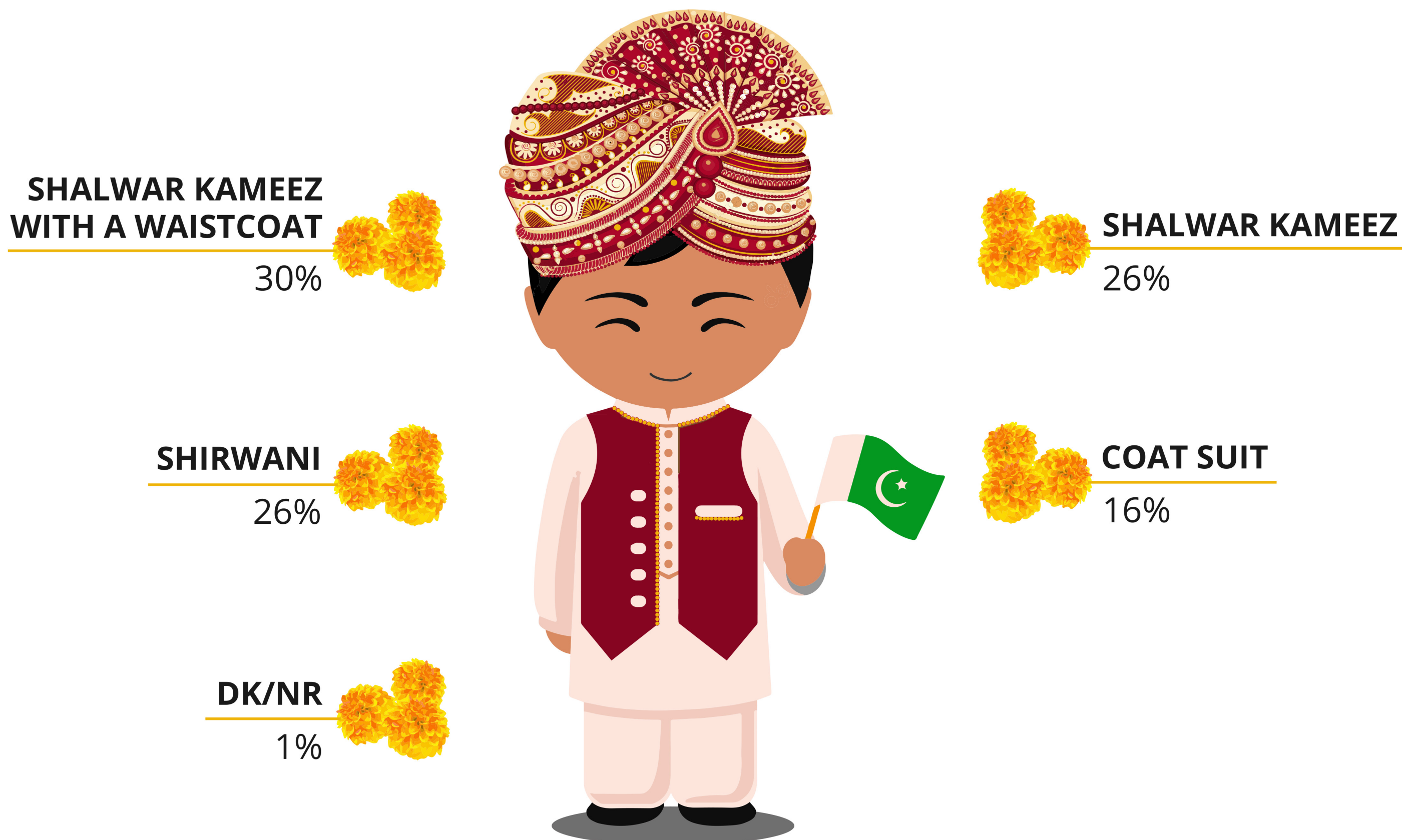

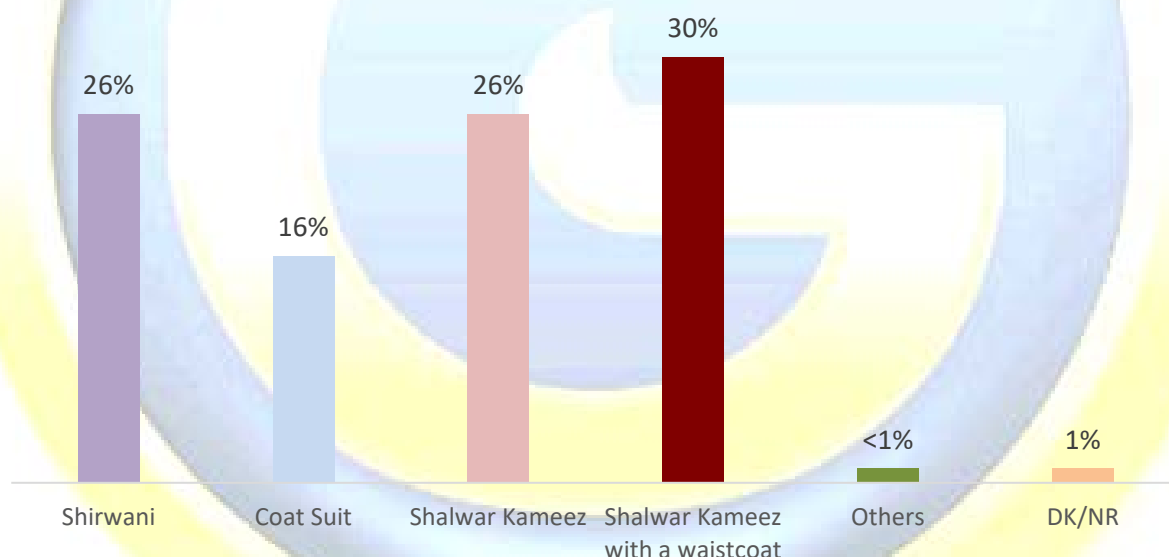

Islamabad, 27 November, 2019

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 30% Pakistanis choose Shalwar Kameez with a waistcoat as the best clothing option for a groom on his wedding.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “In your opinion, what kind of clothing should the groom wear on his wedding functions?” In response, 30% Pakistanis chose Shalwar Kameez with a waistcoat as the best clothing option for a groom on his wedding function. Alternatively, Shirwani and Shalwar Kameez were chosen by 26% Pakistanis each as the best clothing option for a Groom on his wedding function. 16% chose a coat suit as the best option. 1% did not know or did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,214 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during November 06 - November 09, 2019. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
