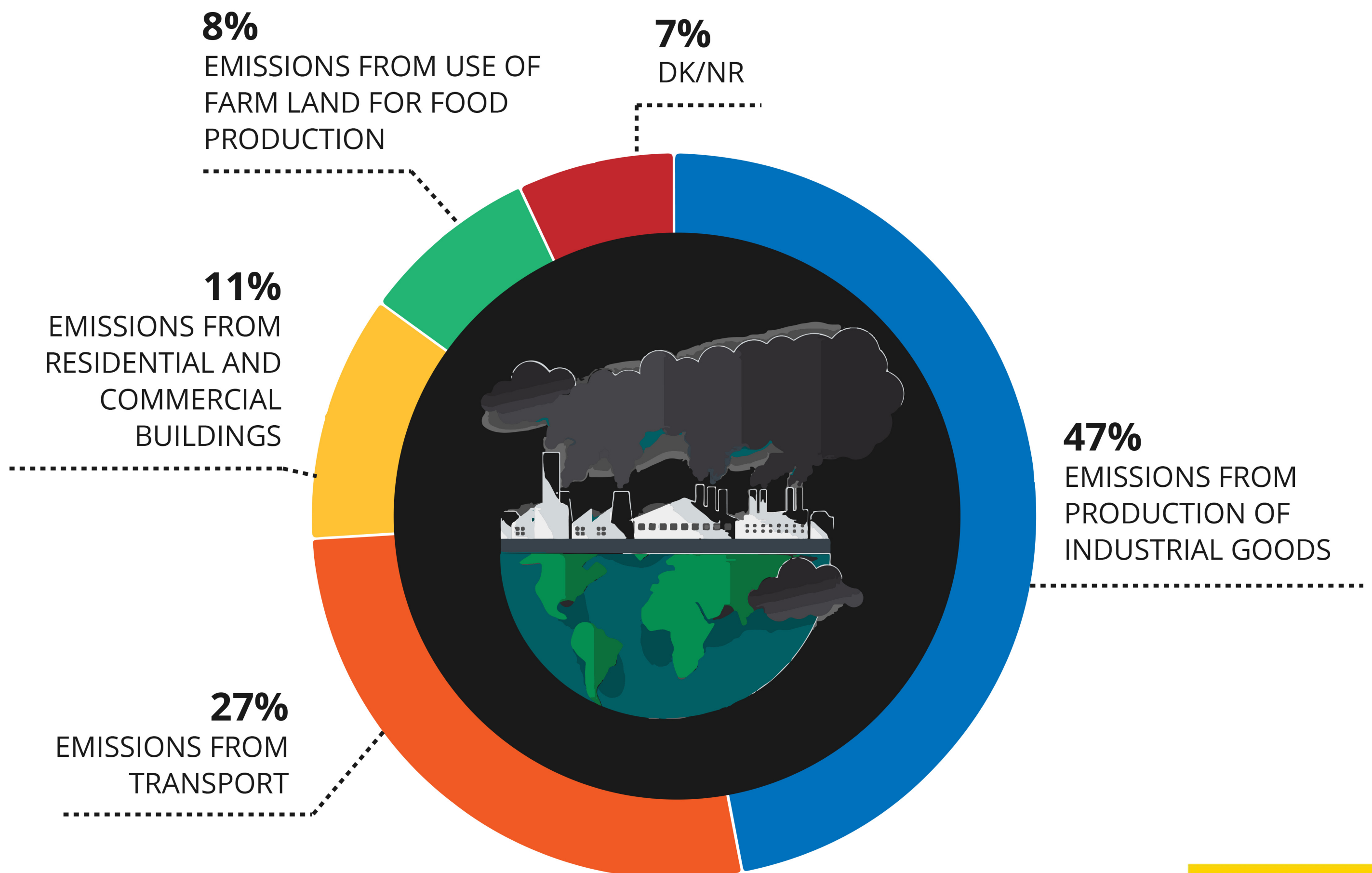

# 47% PAKISTANIS CONSIDER EMISSIONS FROM INDUSTRIES AS THE BIGGEST CONTRIBUTOR TO CLIMATE CHANGE.

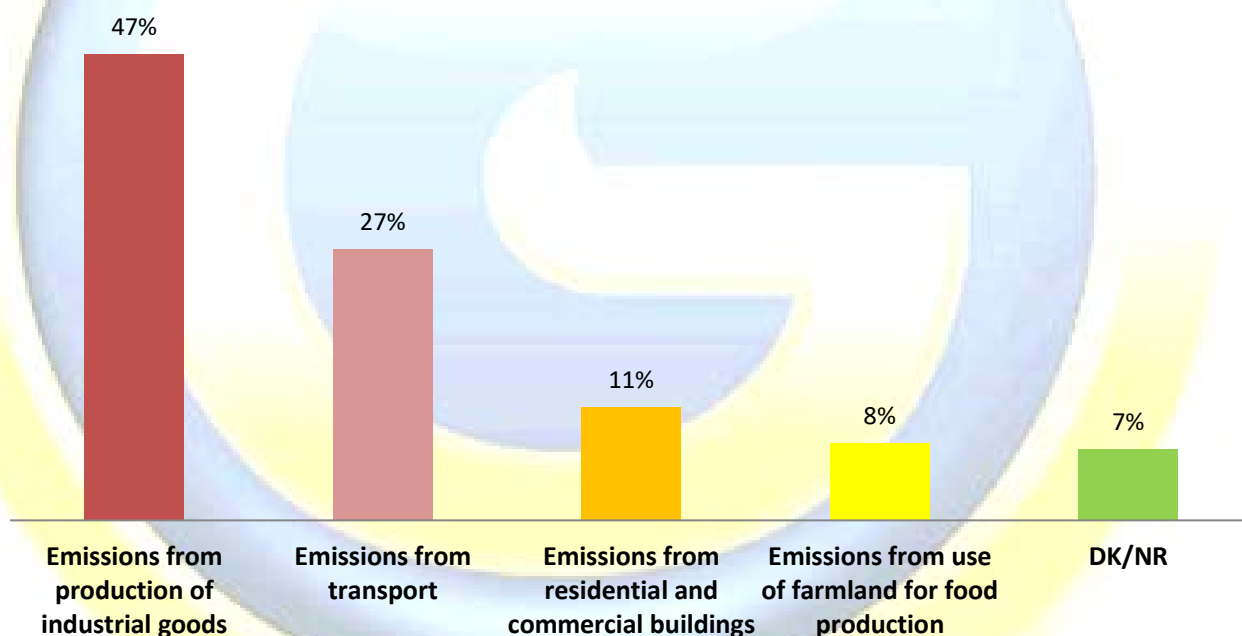
**47 % Pakistanis consider emissions from industries as the biggest contributor to climate change (Gallup & Gilani Pakistan Poll)**

Islamabad, November 4, 2019

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 47% Pakistanis consider emissions from industries as the biggest contributor to climate change.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Which of the following is contributing most to climate change?” In response, 47% said the emissions from production of industrial goods, 27% said emissions from transport, 11% said emissions from residential and commercial buildings, 8% said emissions from use of farmland for food production, and 7% did not know/did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,448 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during June 30-July 09, 2019. The error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 2-3$  percent at the 95% confidence level.
