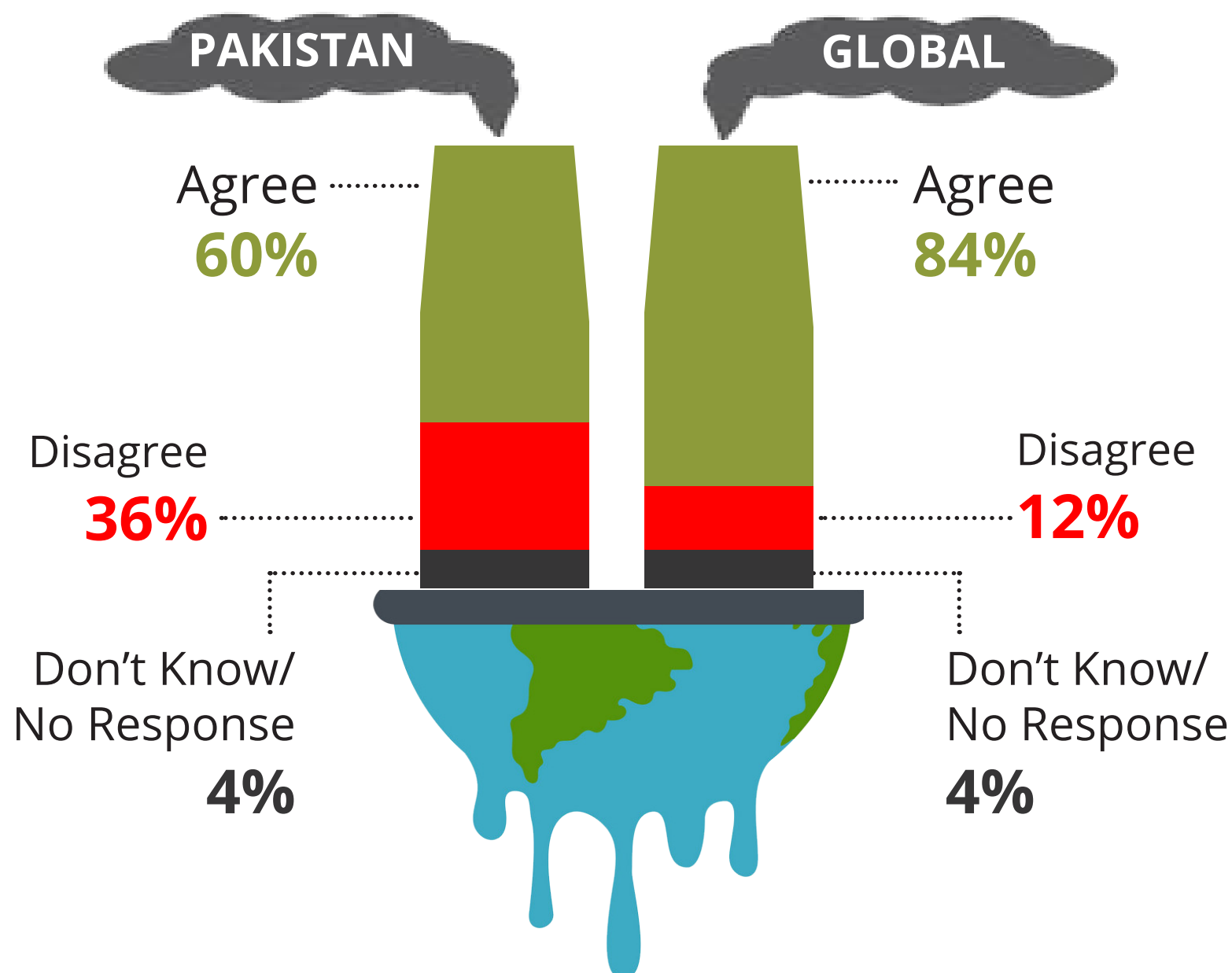

OVER 4 IN 5 (84%) RESPONDENTS OF A GLOBAL SURVEY AGREE THAT GLOBAL WARMING IS A RESULT OF HUMAN ACTIVITY. A LOWER PERCENTAGE FROM PAKISTAN (60%) AGREES

Over 4 in 5 (84%) respondents of a global survey agree that global warming is a result of human activity. A lower percentage from Pakistan (60%) agrees (Gallup Pakistan & WIN World Survey 2019)

According to a WIN World Survey, 84% respondents over the world agree that global warming is a result of human activity.

A sample of 29,368 men and women from 40 countries across the globe was asked, “To what extent do you agree or disagree that global warming is a result of human activity.” 84% of the respondents say they somewhat or totally agree with the statement, while only 12% said they somewhat or totally disagree. 4% of the respondents did not know or did not respond.

In comparison, 60% of Pakistanis agreed with the statement, 36% said they disagree, and 4% did not know or did not respond.

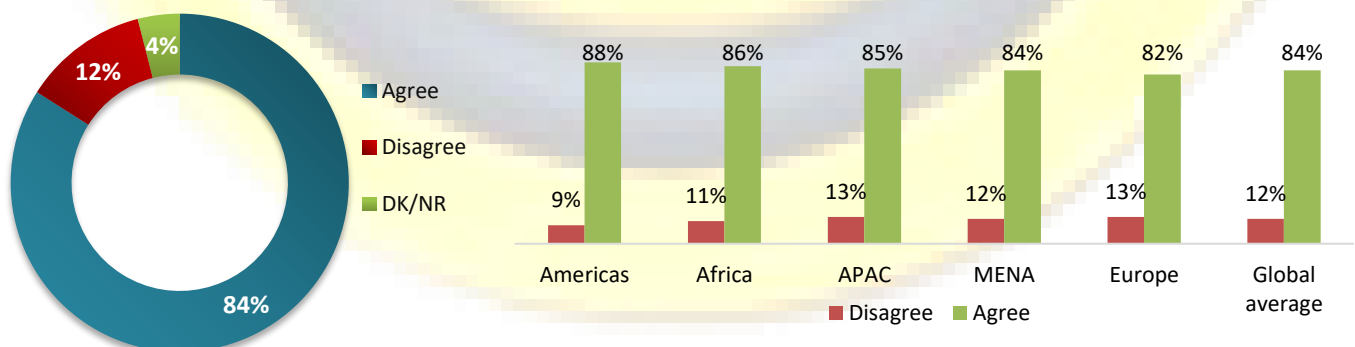
Age and Education breakdown: *Younger and more educated cohort more likely to be aware of the impact of human activity on climate change*

Respondents between 18-24 years of age (Generation Z) are most aware about the effects of human activity on climate change, with 85% respondents belonging to this generation agreeing with the statement. People with higher level of education are more likely to believe that global warming is a result of human activity.

Regional Analysis:

Regional results show that respondents from the Americas have the highest rate of agreement with the statement, with 88% respondents agreeing (totally or somewhat) that human activity results in global warming. Respondents from Europe are least likely to agree with the statement (82%).

Field work in Pakistan conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International Association

The study was released as part of The WWS (WIN Worldwide Survey), a study conducted every year with the purpose to measure people’s thoughts, expectations, worries and perceptions related to relevant topics for society and business. A total of 29,368 people were interviewed globally from 40 countries. The fieldwork was conducted during October 2019 – December 2019. The margin of error for the survey is between 2.4 and 4.4 at 95% confidence level. The global average has been computed according to the share of the covered adult population of the surveyed countries.
