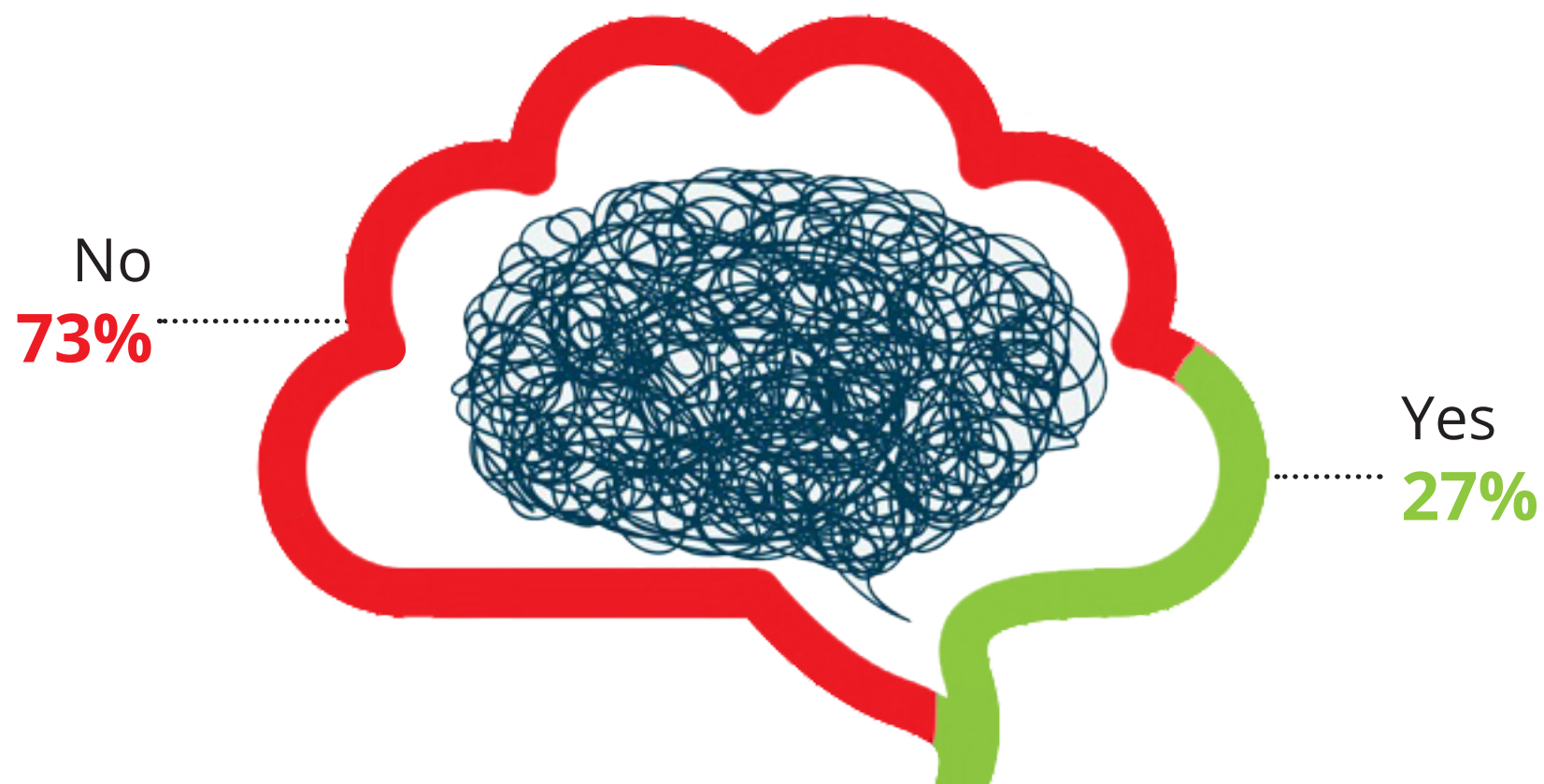

Over 1 in 4 Pakistanis (27%) claim that someone in their household is suffering from depression (Gallup & Gilani Pakistan Poll)

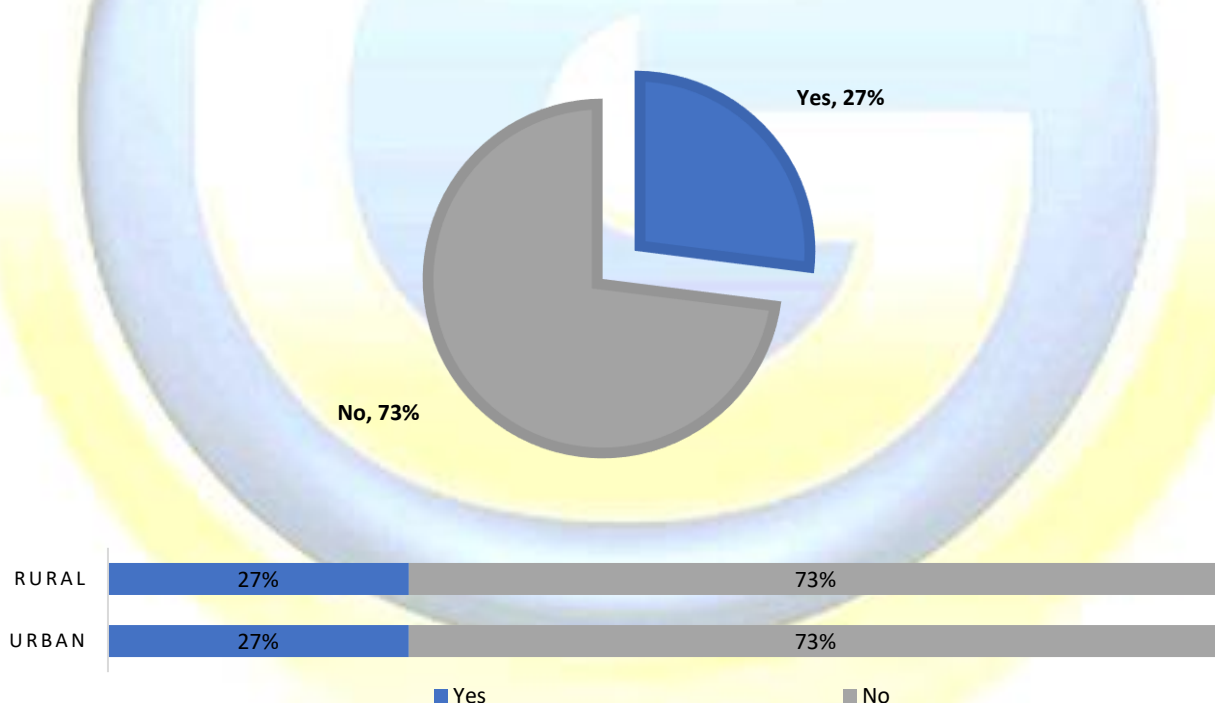
According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, over 1 in 4 Pakistanis (27%) claim that someone in their household is suffering from depression.

A representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Are any of your household members suffering from depression?” In response, 27% said yes while 73% said no.

Implication: Roughly 8 million Pakistani households report a person suffering from depression within their household.

Urban-Rural Breakdown: An equal proportion (27%) of urban and rural respondents have reported that someone from their household is suffering from depression.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,256 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during March 11 – March 18, 2020. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level.
