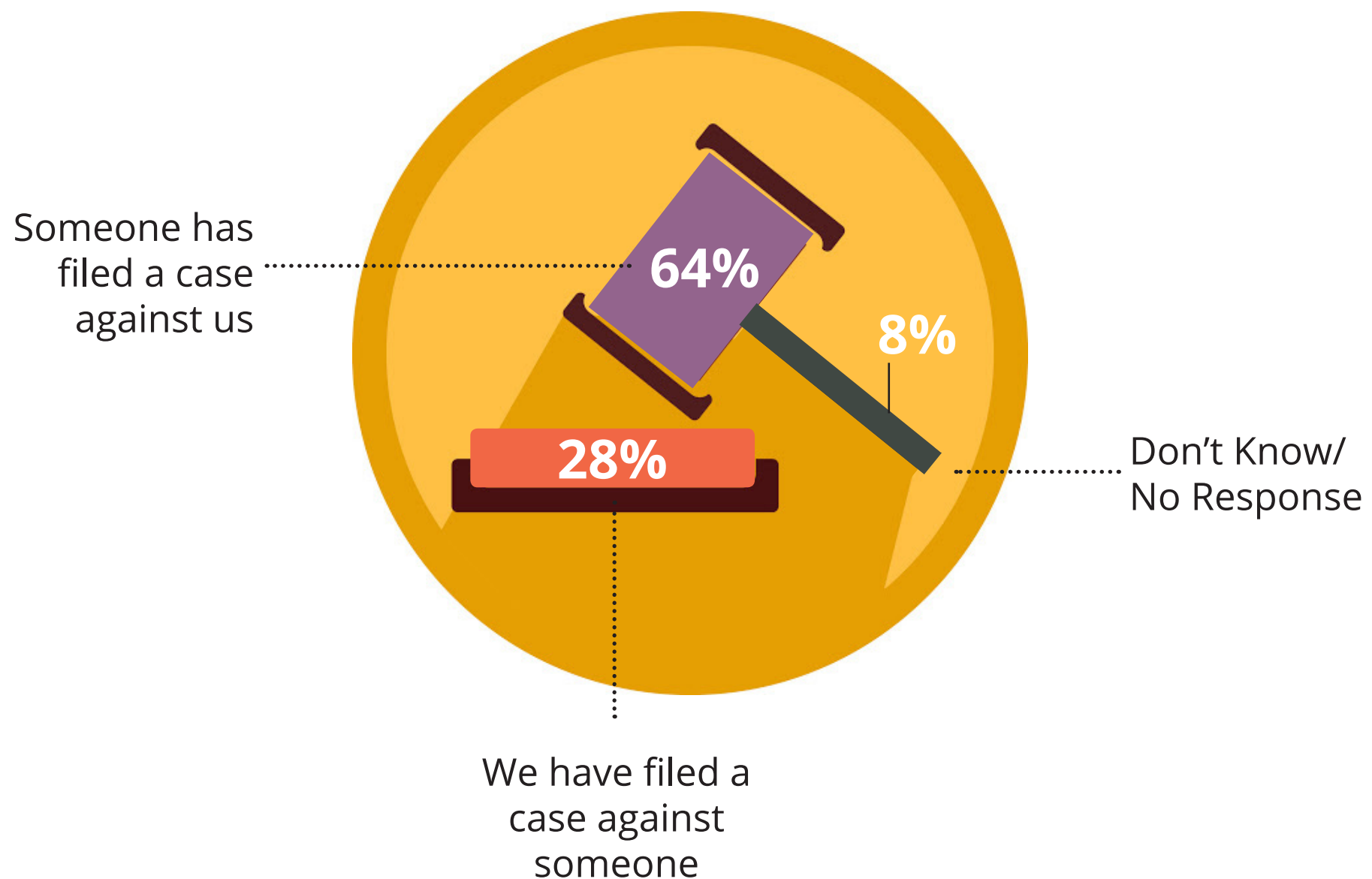

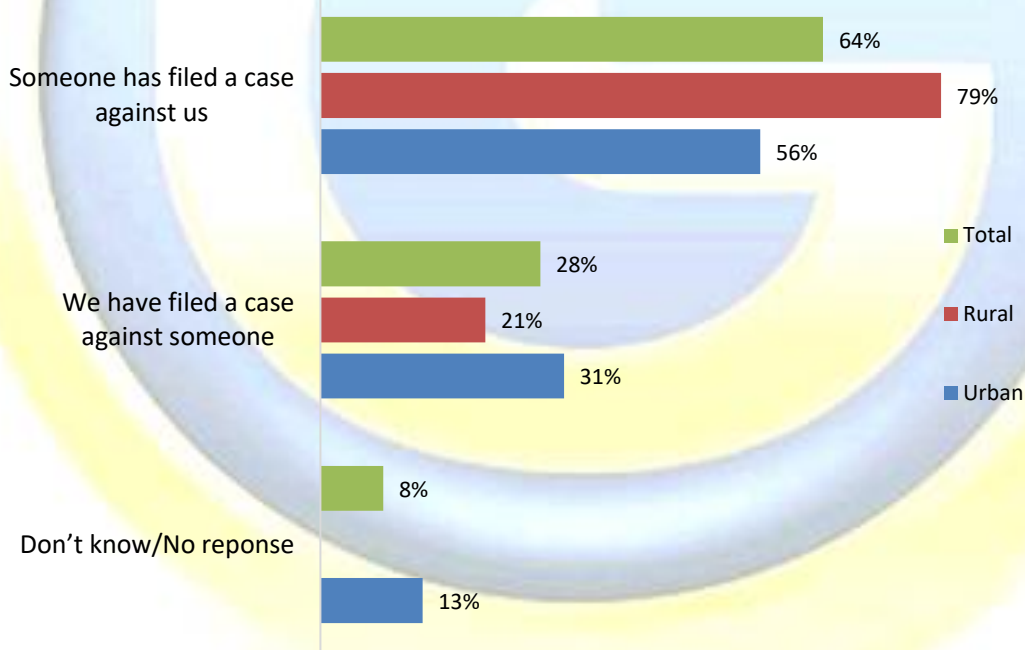
According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 64% Pakistanis who have an ongoing case in court claim that the case was filed against them.

A representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “*Have you filed a case against someone, or has someone filed a case against you?*” In response, 28% said they had filed a case against someone, 64% said someone had filed a case against them, and 8% did not know/did not wish to respond.

Urban-Rural Breakdown: Higher proportion of urban residents have filed a case against someone

Amongst urban respondents, 31% claim they have filed a case against someone while 21% in rural areas claim the same.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,208 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during February 08 - February 15, 2020. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
