Opinion Poll CORONAVIRUS

Since March, there has been a 22% rise in the proportion of Pakistanis who opine that the federal government is controlling the coronavirus situation very well. 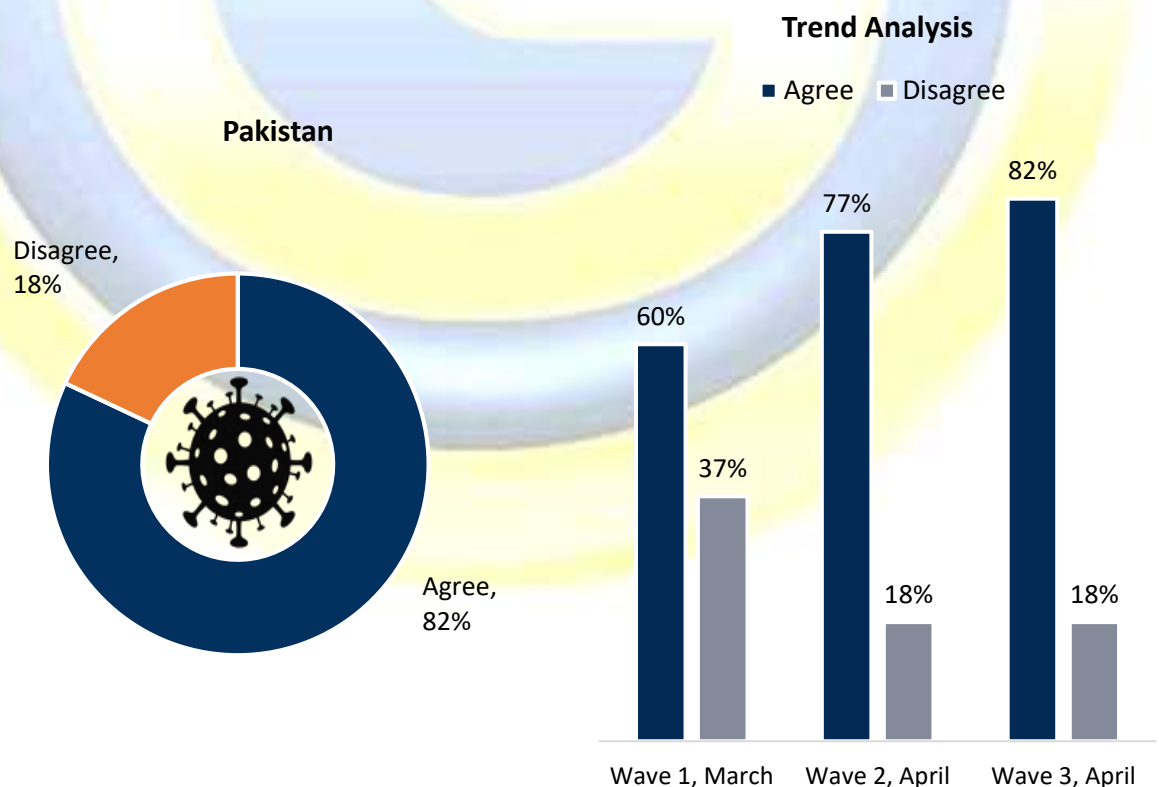

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, since March, there has been a 22% rise in the proportion of Pakistanis who opine that the federal government of Pakistan is controlling the coronavirus situation very well.

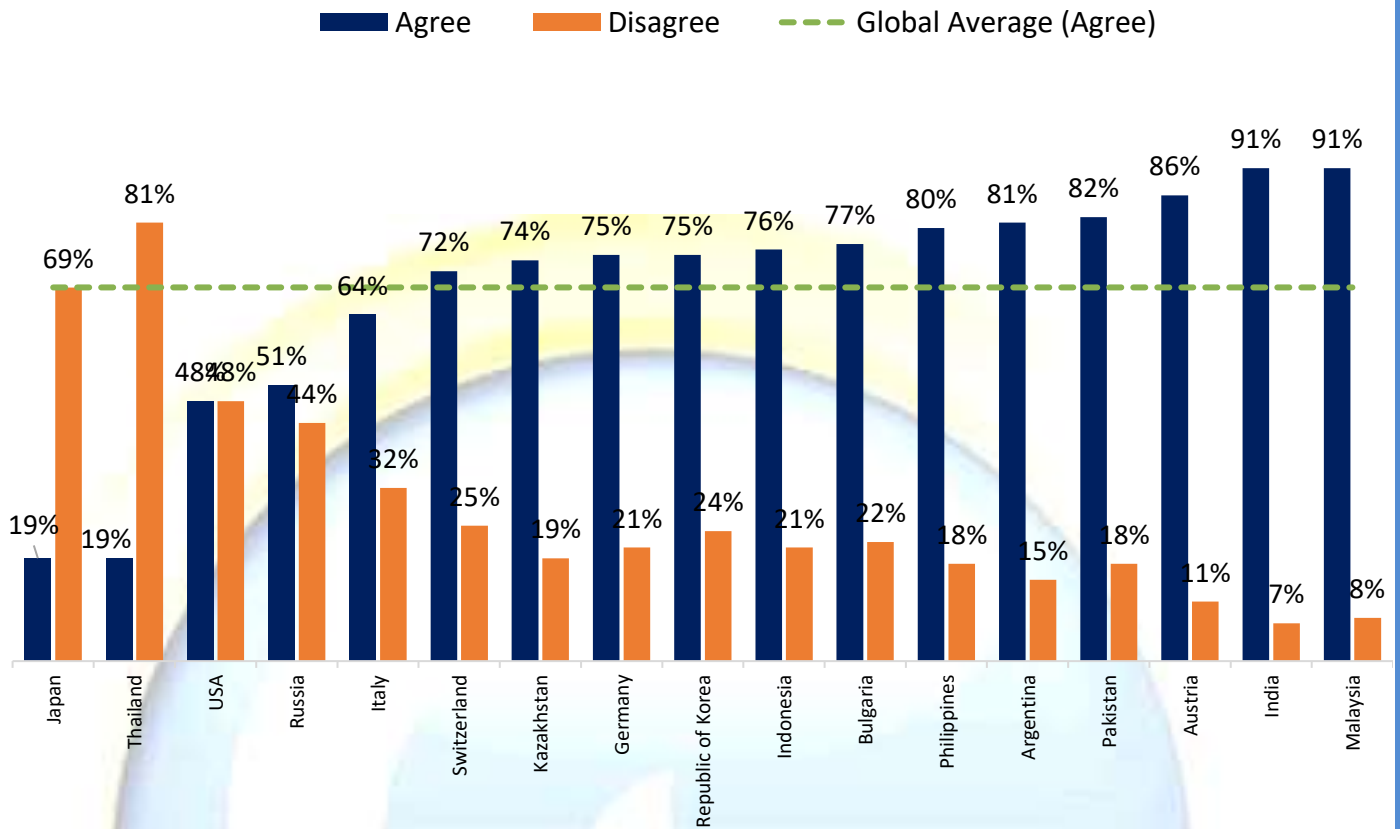
A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question: **“To what extent do you agree/disagree that the Federal Government of Pakistan is controlling the Coronavirus situation very well?”** In response to this question, 82% Pakistanis agree that the federal government is controlling the Coronavirus situation well while 18% disagree.

Global result: Respondents from India and Malaysia report highest level of satisfaction (91%) with their government with respect to controlling spread of COVID-19. Pakistan ranks 4th highest out of 17 countries in terms of satisfaction with the government

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out through telephonic interviews among a sample of 1,014 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during April 04 – April 10, 2020 as a part of Gallup Pakistan Coronavirus Attitude Tracker Survey 2020, Wave 3. Gallup International conducted international fieldwork in a study comprised internationally of 24,652 respondents covering different ethnicities, regions, religions, age and gender. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 3 percent at the 95% confidence level.
