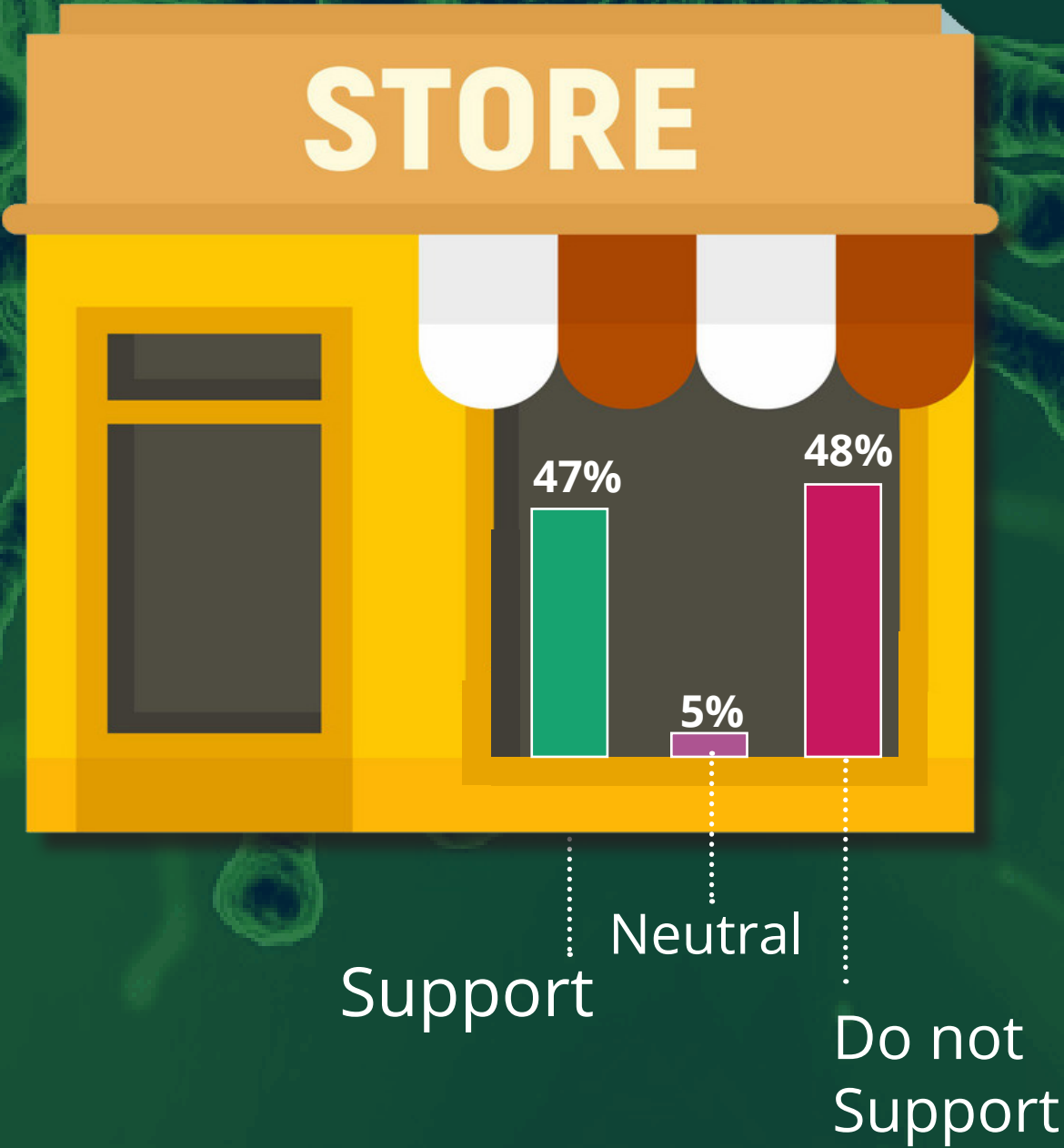

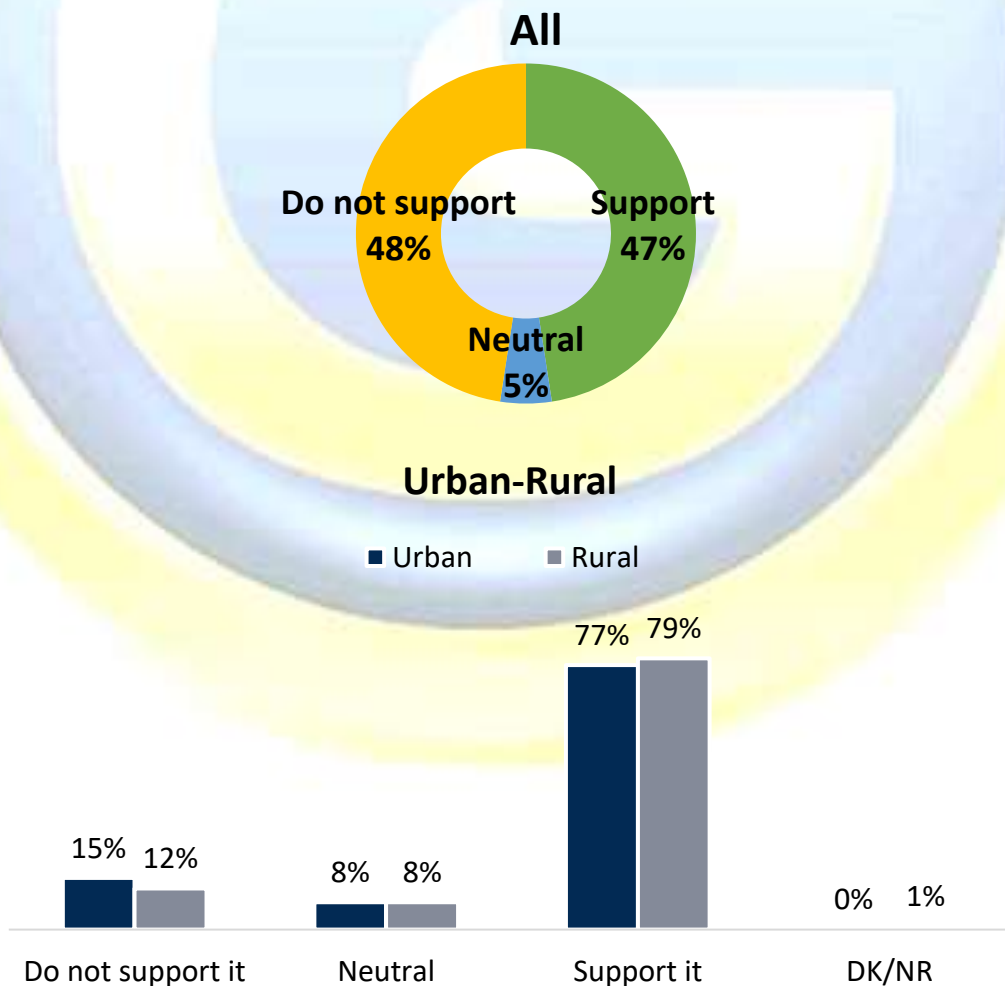

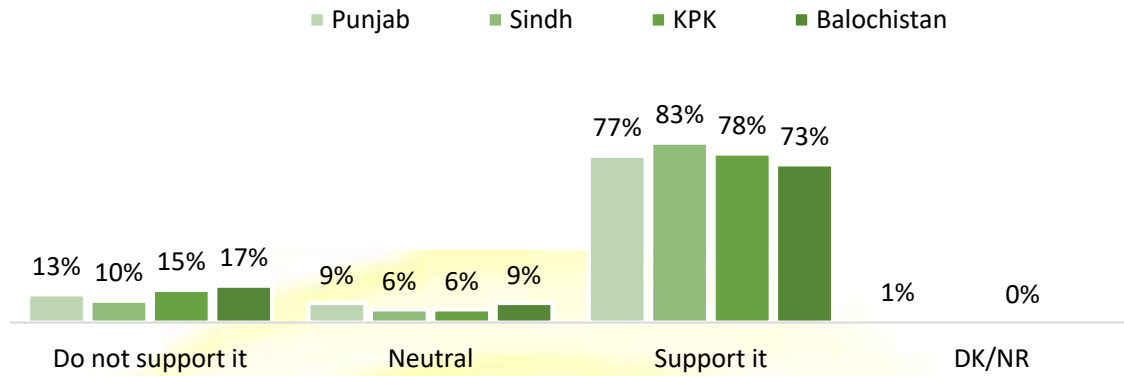
According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 47% Pakistanis support resumption of businesses across the country by relaxing the lockdown while 48% do not support.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, *“To what extent do you support further opening up of business across the country by easing lockdown?”* In response to this question, 47% agreed, 48% say they do not support and 5% are neutral about the opening up of businesses.

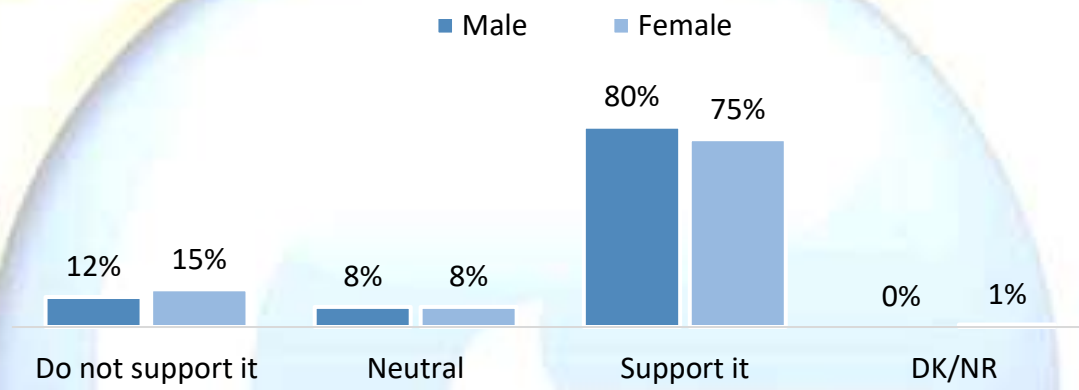
Question: “To what extent do you support further opening up of business across the country by easing lockdown?”



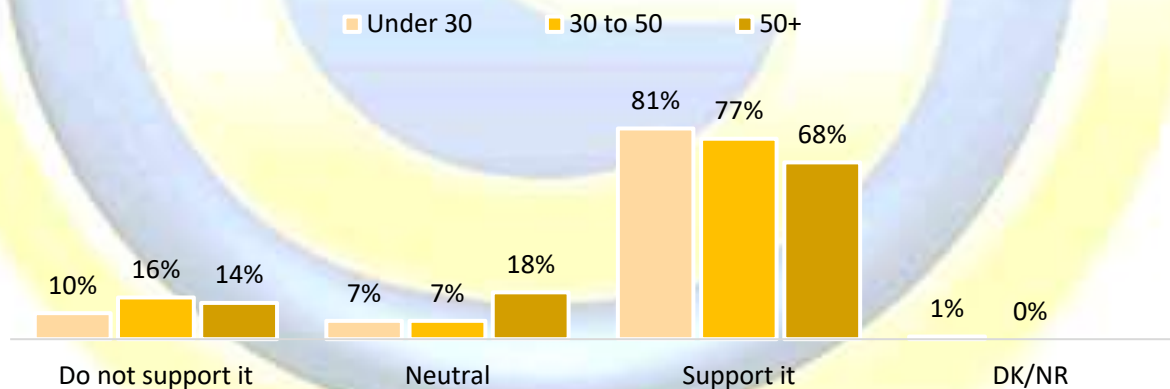
Provincial Breakdown

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out through telephonic interviews among a sample of 1,050 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during June 04 – June 13, 2020 as a part of Gallup Pakistan Coronavirus Attitude Tracker Survey 2020, Wave 6. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 3 percent at the 95% confidence level.
