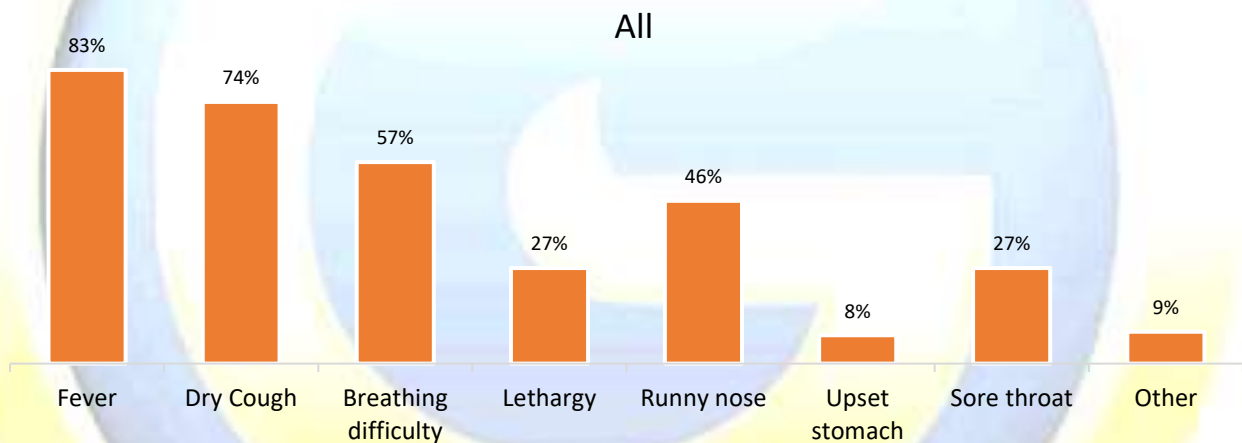

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 4 in 5 (83%) Pakistanis believe fever is a symptom of coronavirus. 74% identify dry cough as a symptom.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “*What do you think are Coronavirus symptoms?*” In response to this question, 83% said they think fever is a symptom of the virus, 74% said dry cough, 57% said breathing difficulties, 27% said lethargy, 46% say runny nose is a symptom while 27% identify sore throat as a symptom, 8% say upset stomach and 9% choose other symptoms.

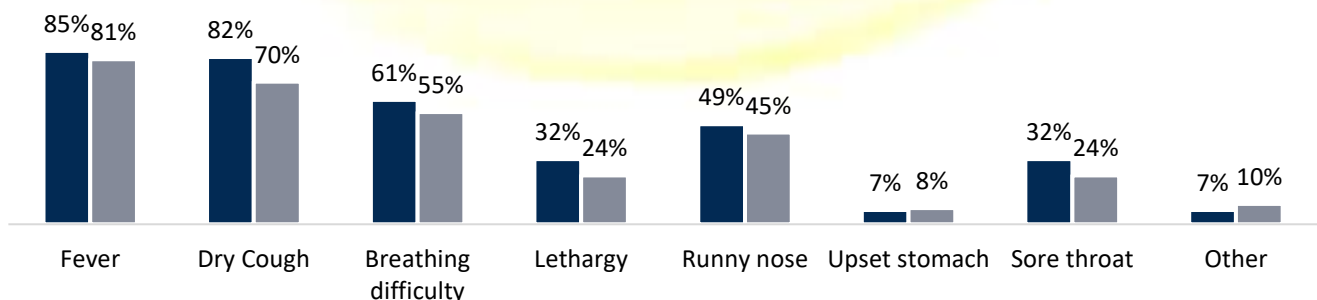
Question: “What do you think are Coronavirus symptoms?” (Multiple Response)



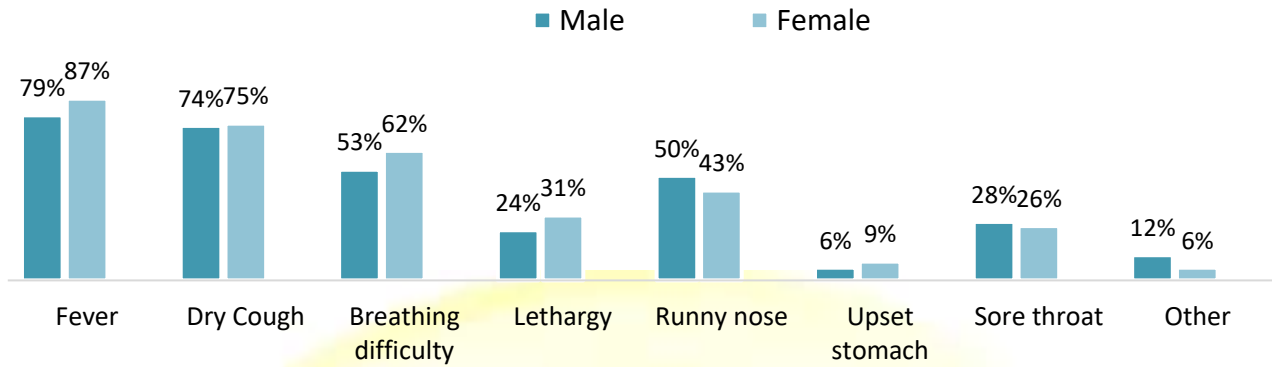

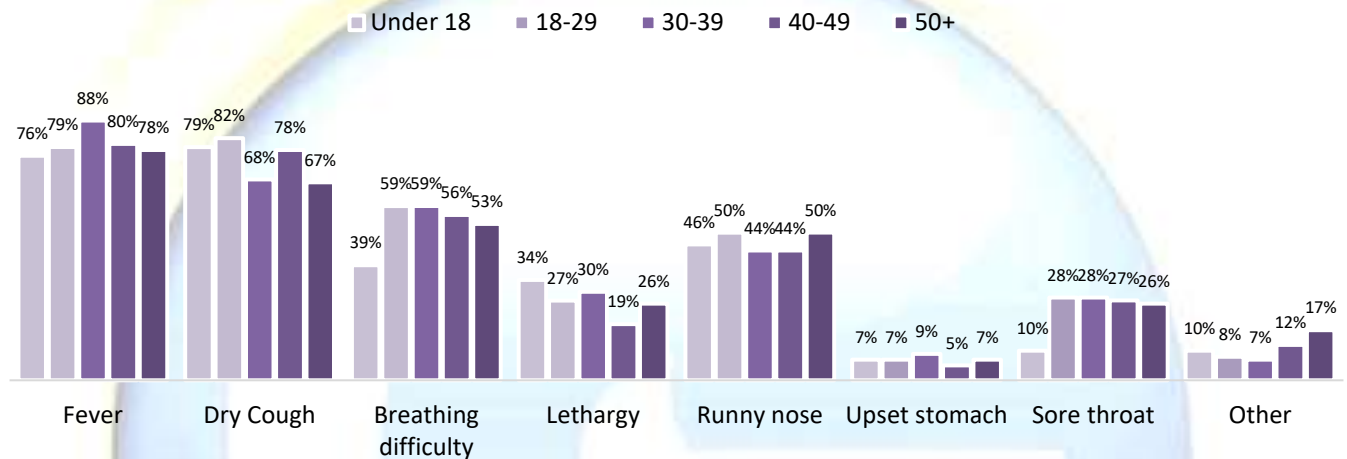

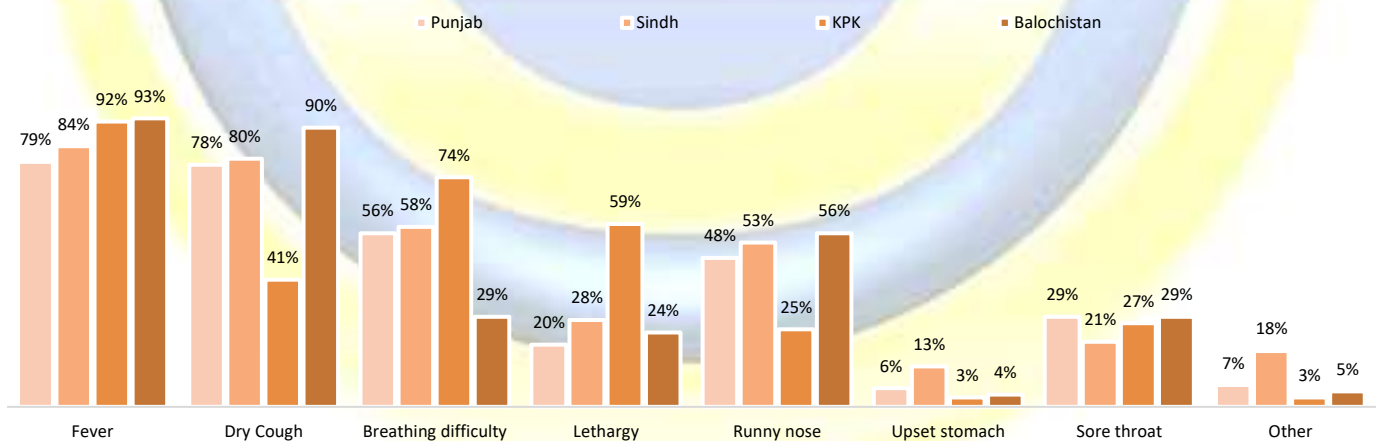
Gender Breakdown

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out through telephonic interviews among a sample of 1,144 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during May 01 – May 20, 2020 as a part of Gallup Pakistan Coronavirus Attitude Tracker Survey 2020, Wave 5. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 3 percent at the 95% confidence level.
