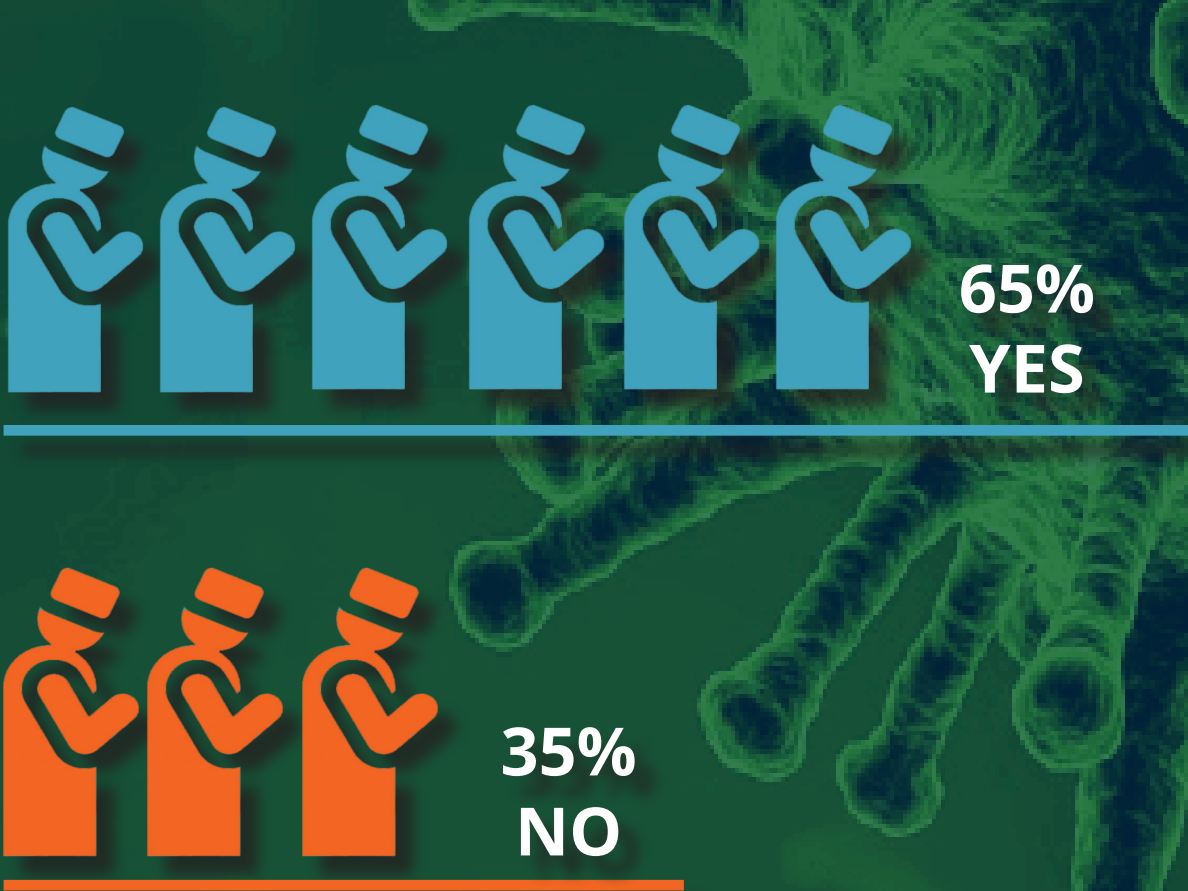

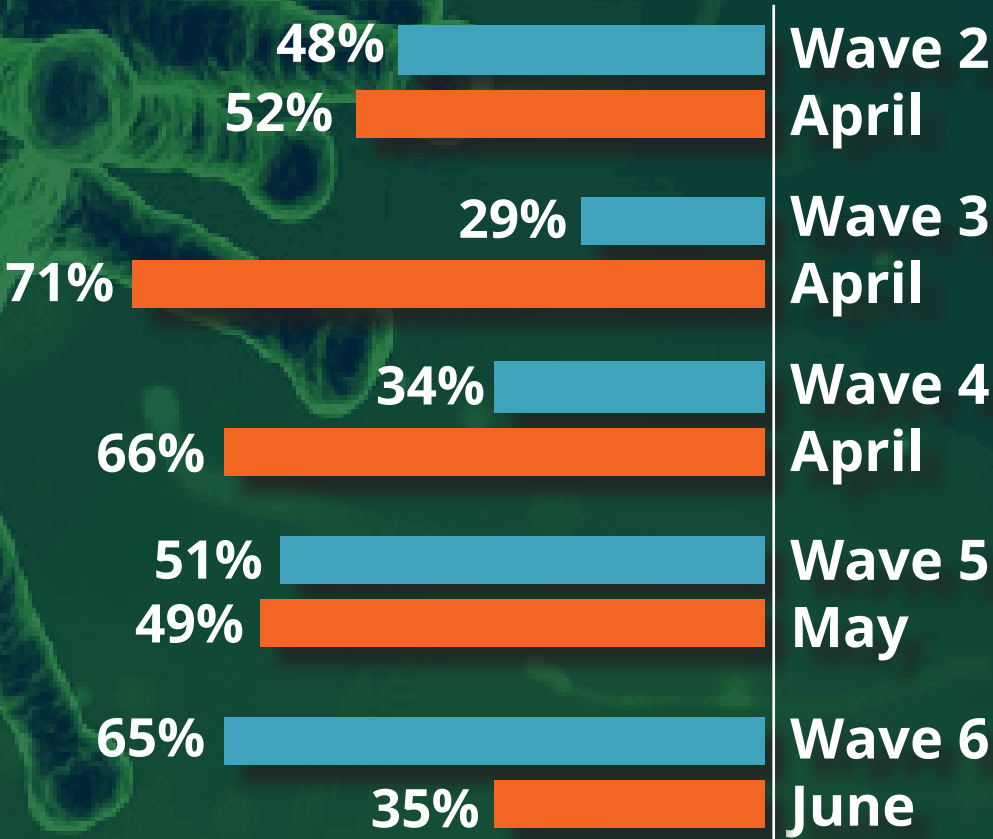

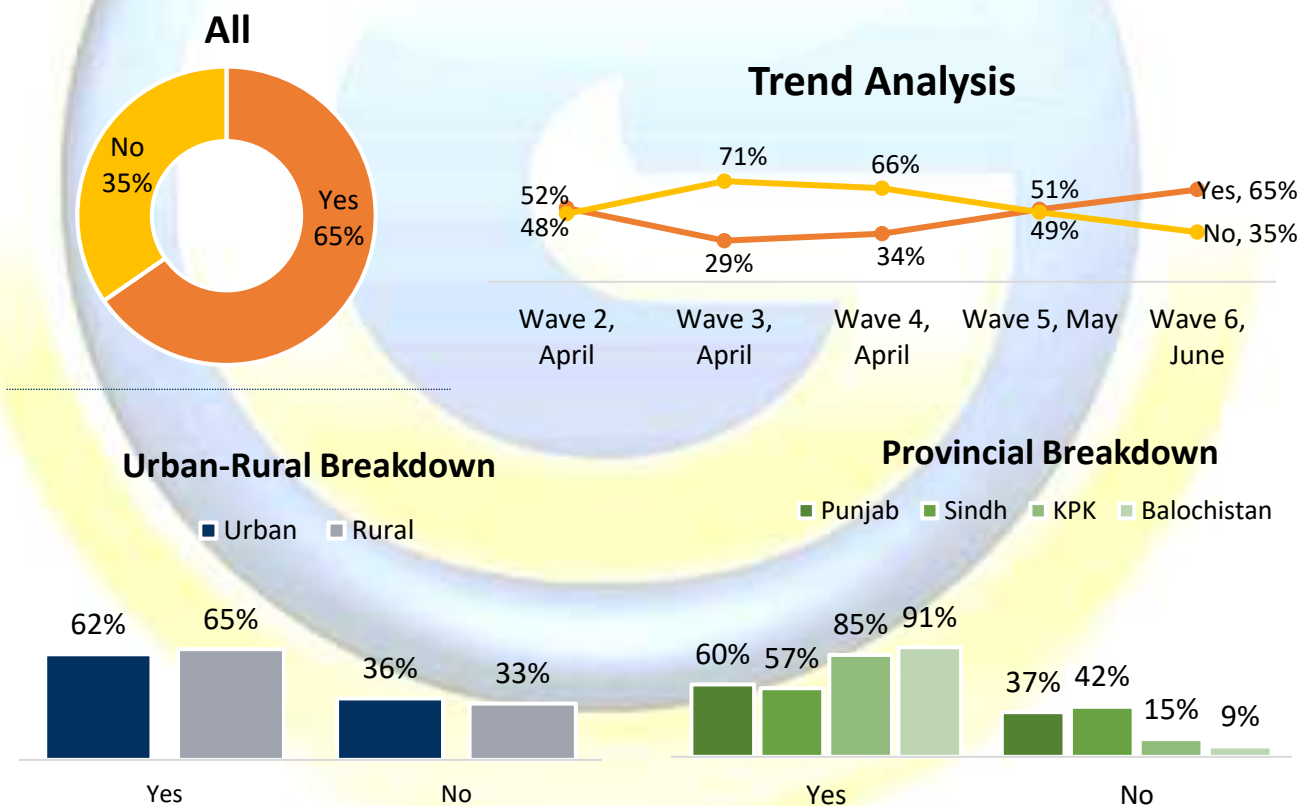
Since Wave 3 in early April, a hefty 36% increase recorded in the proportion of respondents who report a male family member offering Jummah prayers in a mosque (Gallup & Gilani Pakistan Weekly Coronavirus Perception Tracker)

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, since wave 3 in early April, a hefty 36% increase recorded in the proportion of respondents who report a male family member offering Jummah prayers in a mosque.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Did any male member of your household go for Friday prayers last Friday?” In response to this question, 65% agreed while 35% disagreed.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out through telephonic interviews among a sample of 1,050 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during June 04 – June 13, 2020 as a part of Gallup Pakistan Coronavirus Attitude Tracker Survey 2020, Wave 6. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 3 percent at the 95% confidence level.
