

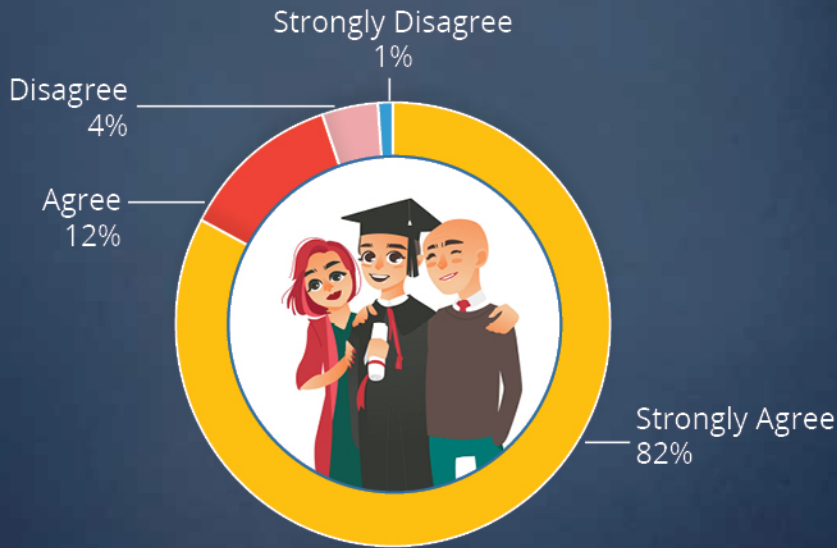

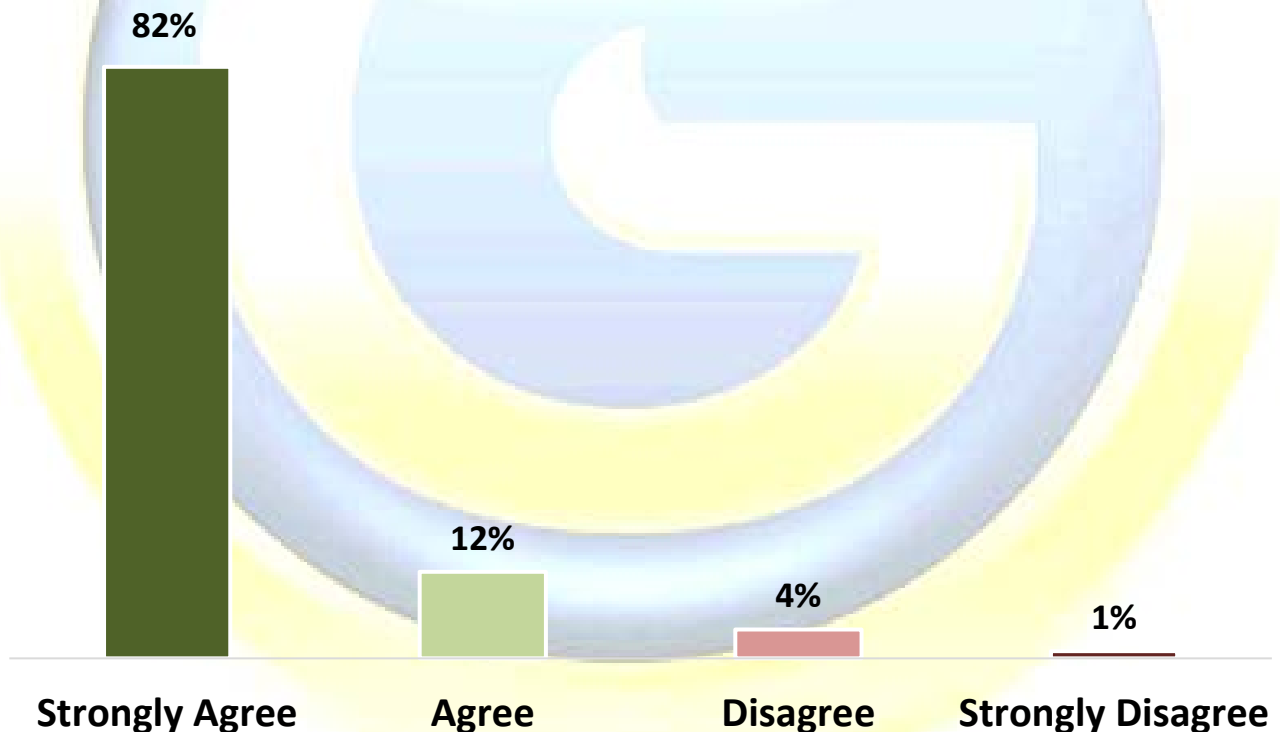

According to a World Values Survey and Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, over 9 in 10 (94%) Pakistanis agree that one of their main goals in life is to make their parents proud. Only 5% disagree.

A representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Do you agree strongly, agree, disagree, or disagree strongly with the following statement: ‘One of my main goals in life has been to make my parents proud’?” In response, 82% Pakistanis strongly agree, 12% agree, 4% disagree and 1% strongly disagree that their main goal in life is to make their parents proud.

The study was released by World Values Survey and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The survey was carried out among a sample of 1995 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, between 2017 and 2019. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
