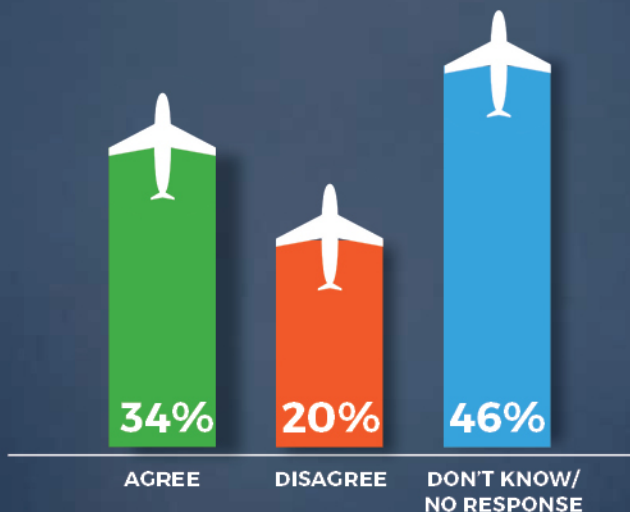


1 in 3 (34%) Pakistanis have heard about the fake pilot's license issue. (Gallup & Gilani Pakistan Poll)

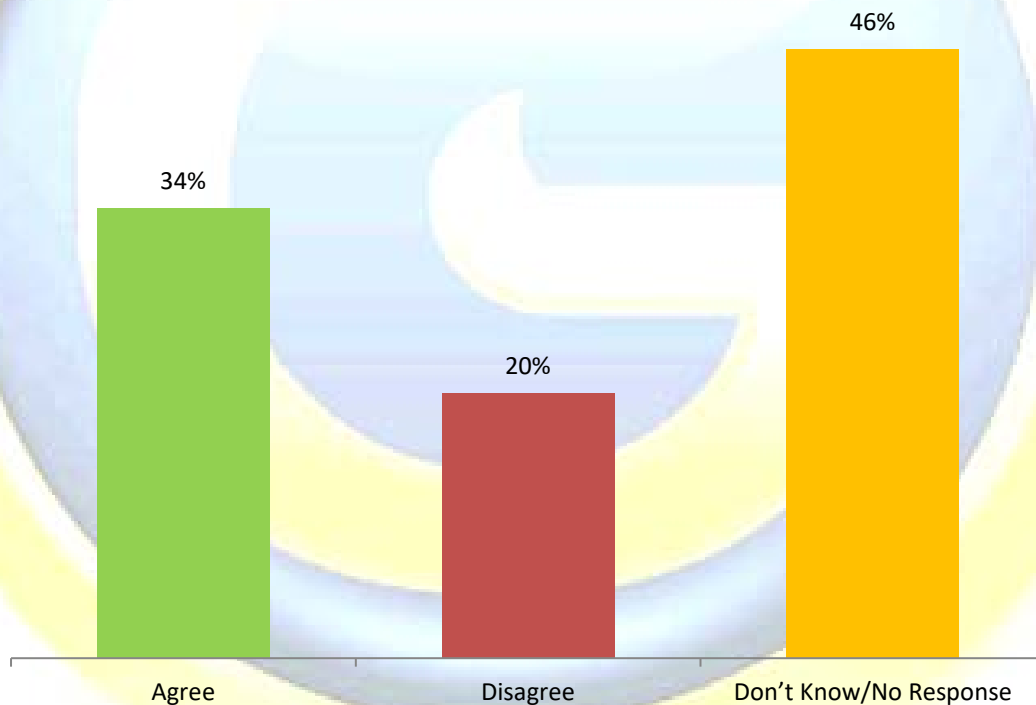
1 in 3 (34 %) Pakistanis have heard about the fake pilot's license issue (Gallup & Gilani Pakistan Poll)

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 34% Pakistanis have heard about the fake pilot's license issue.

A representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, "Do you agree/disagree with the following statement: 'I have heard about fake pilot's issue'?" In response, 34% claim to have heard of the issue, 20% say they have not heard of it and 46% say they do not know/no response.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,326 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during July 9 – August 10, 2020. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
