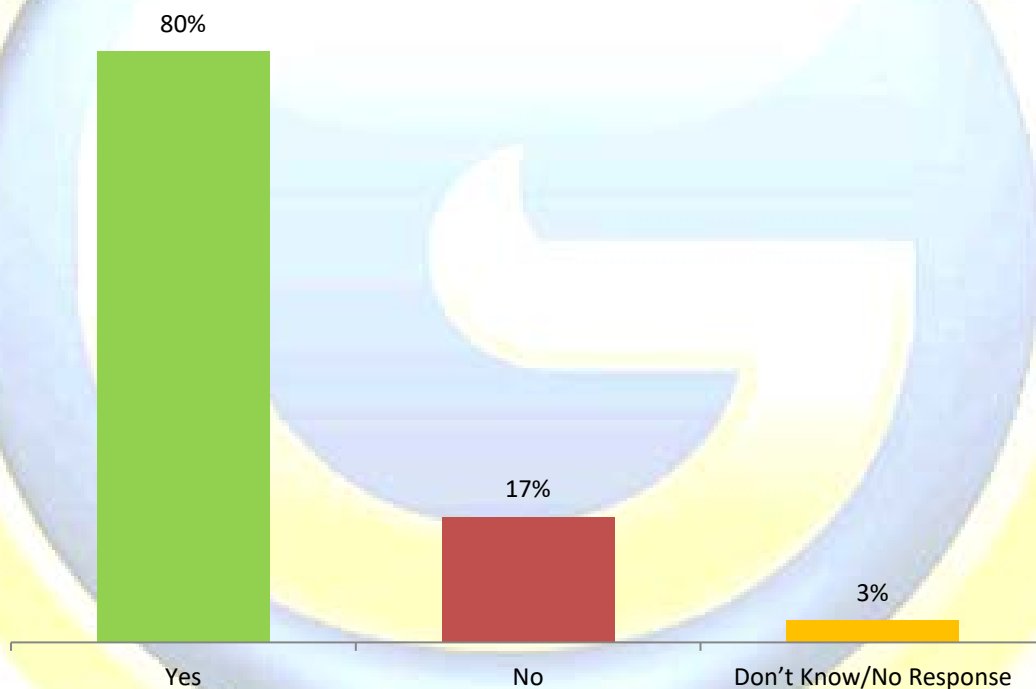

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 80% Pakistanis claim to have experienced load shedding in their homes the previous day.

A representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “*Was there load shedding in your house yesterday?*” In response, 80% reported having experienced load shedding, 17% said no and 3% say they do not know/refused to answer.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,326 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during July 9 – August 10, 2020. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
