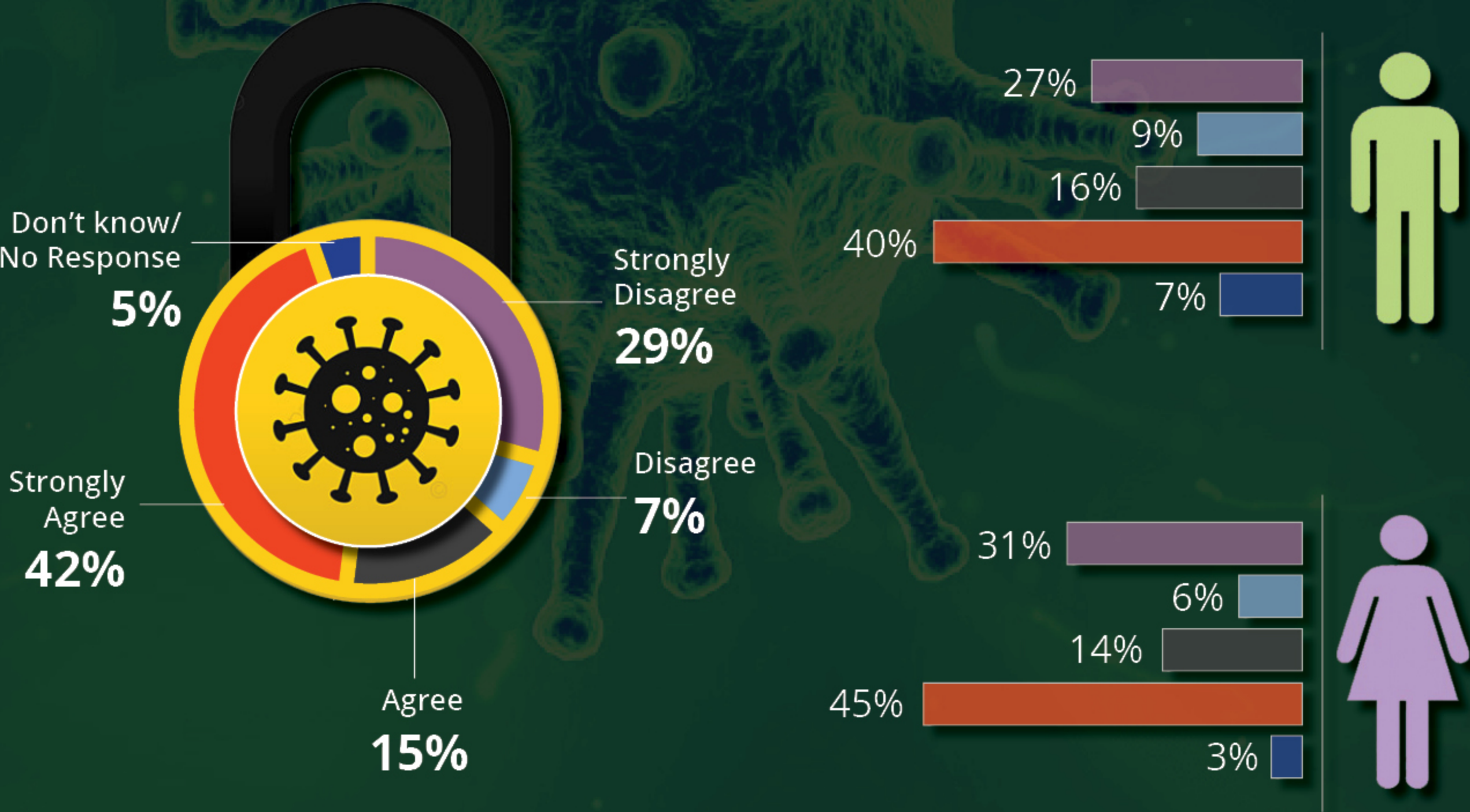

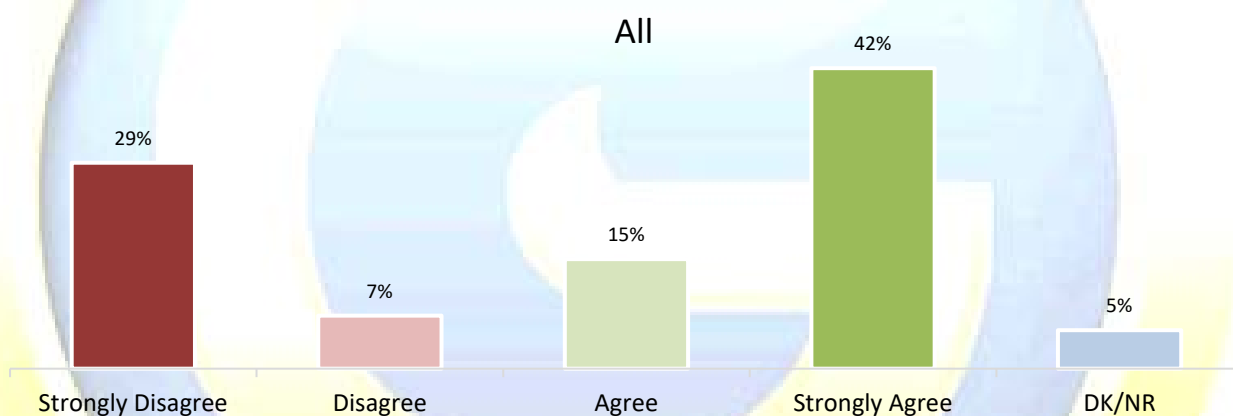
Nearly 3 in 5 (57 %) Pakistanis claim that if they were Prime Minister, they would never have imposed a lockdown (Gallup & Gilani Pakistan Coronavirus Perception Tracker)

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 57% Pakistanis claim that if they were Prime Minister, they would never have imposed a lockdown.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statement: ‘If I was Prime Minister I would never impose lock down?’” In response to this question, 29% strongly disagree, 7% disagree, 15% agree, 42% strongly agree while 5% said they did not know/did not respond.

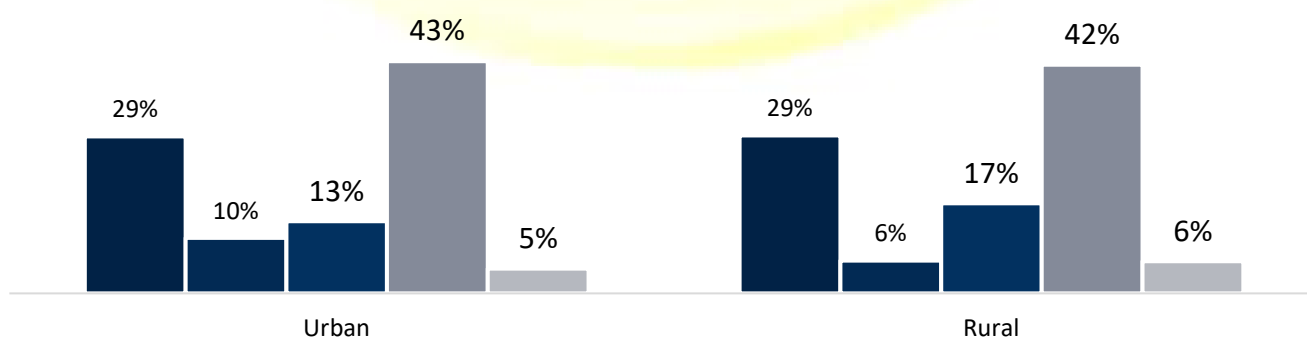
Question: “To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statement: ‘If I was Prime Minister I would never impose lock down?’”



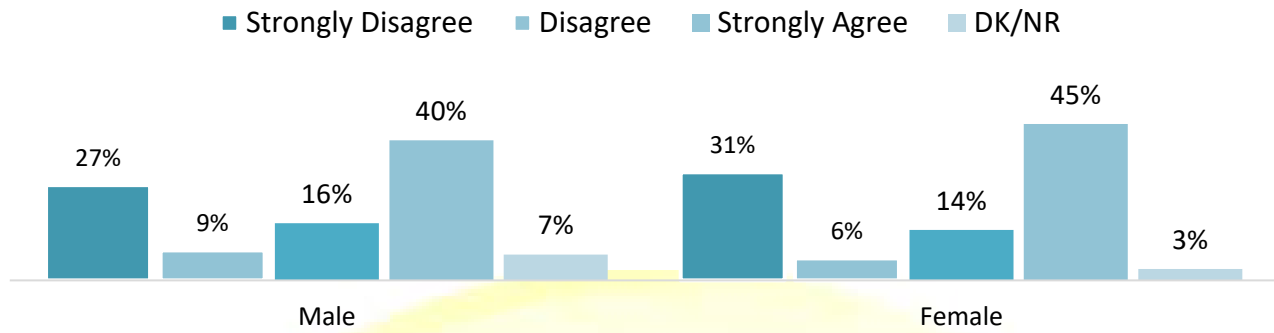

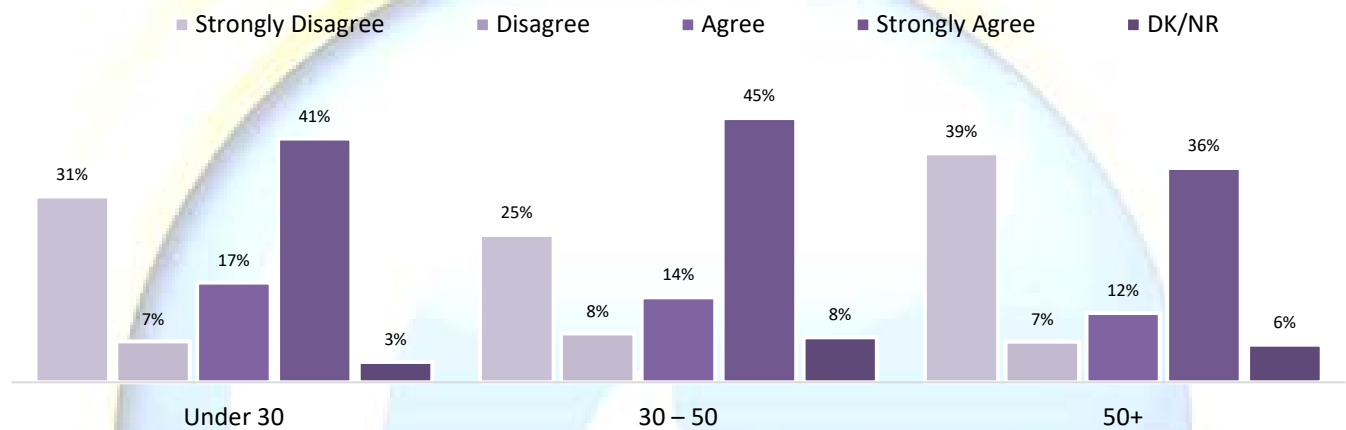

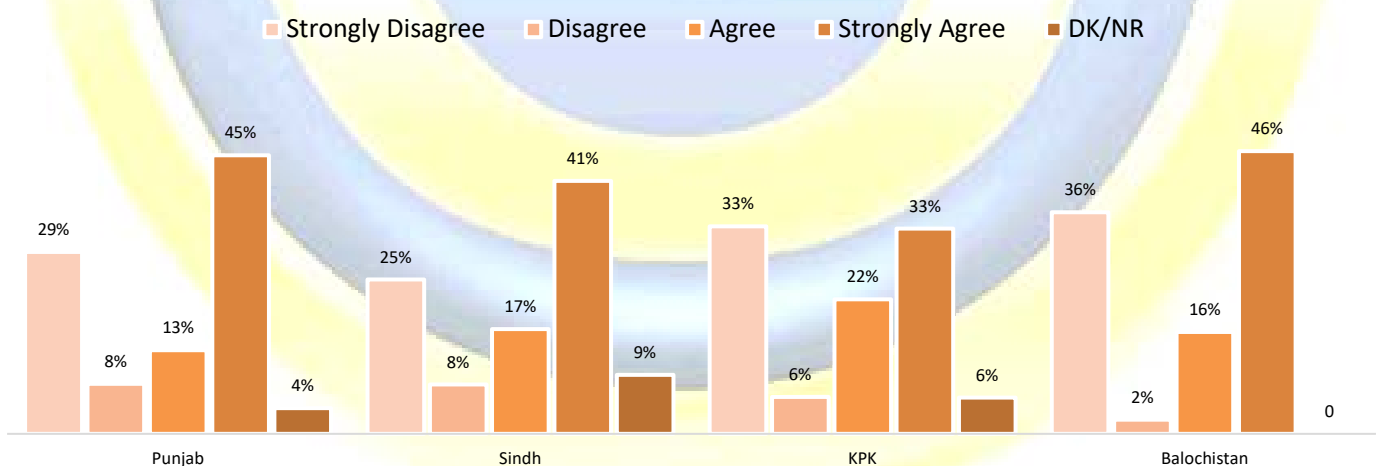
Gender Breakdown

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,326 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during July 9 – August 10, 2020. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
