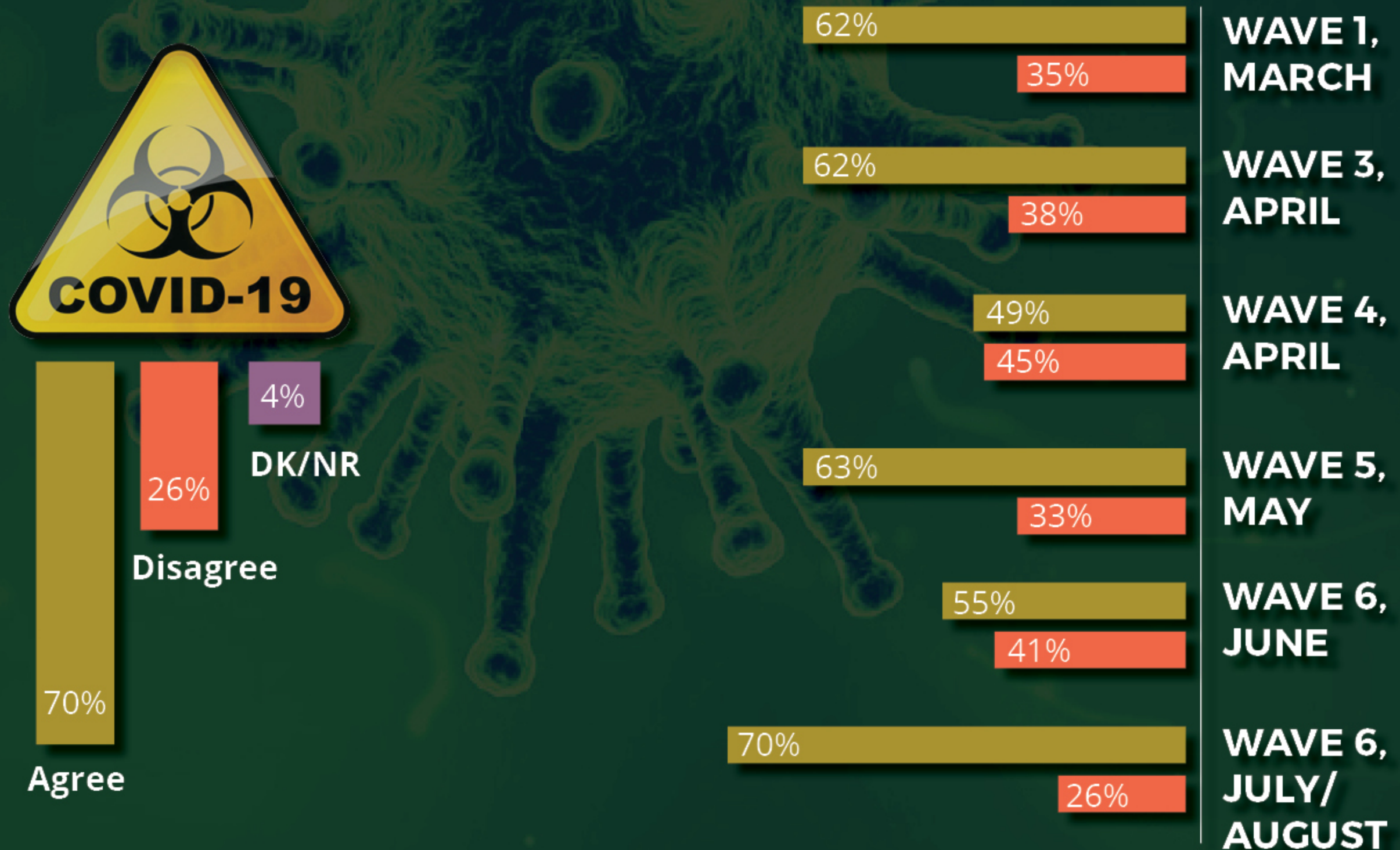

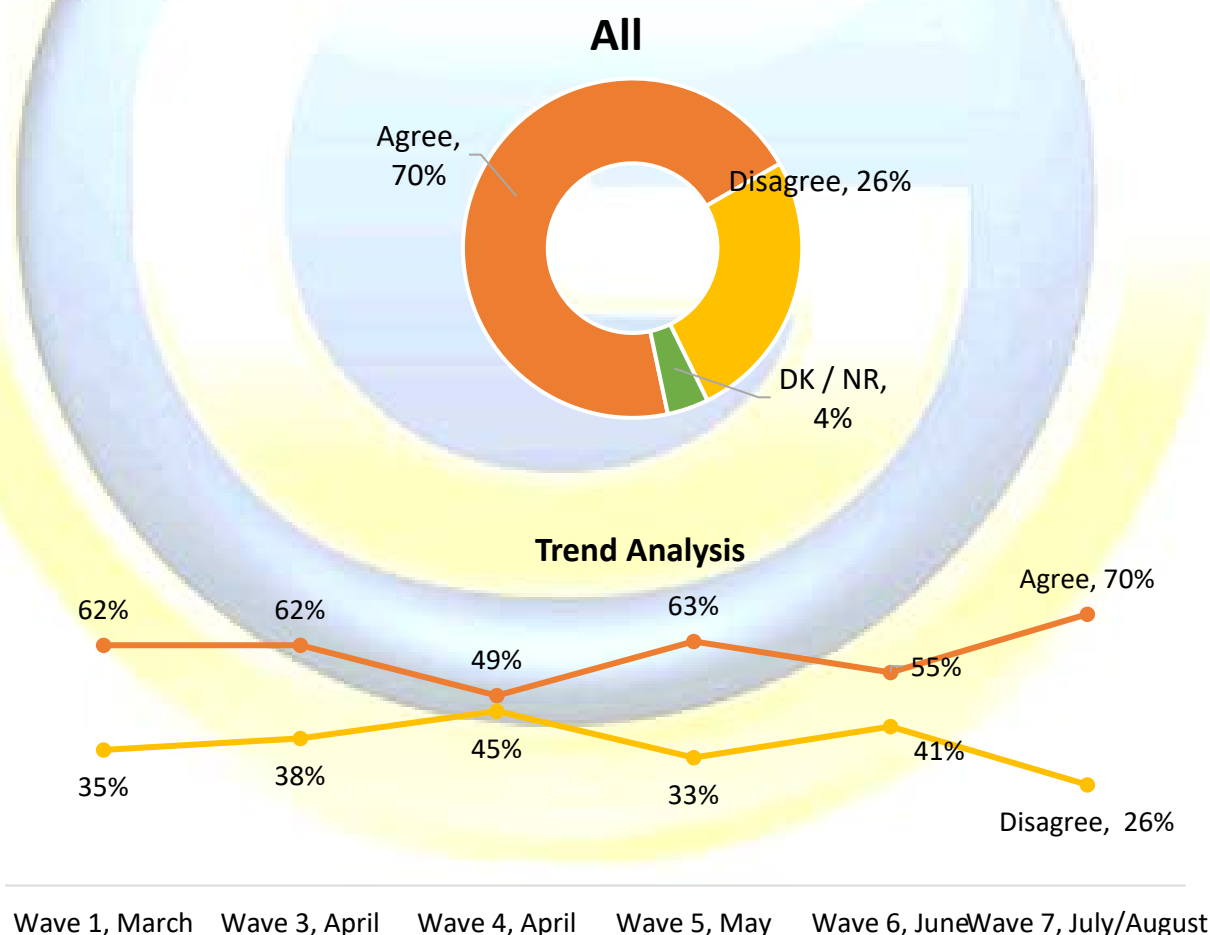

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, over 2 in 3 Pakistanis now believe the threat of Coronavirus to be exaggerated.

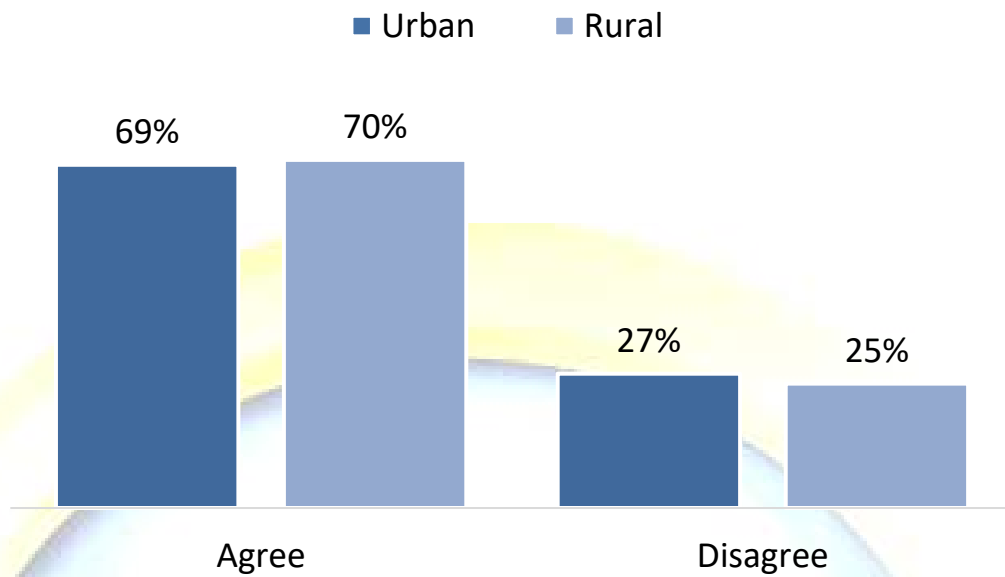
A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “*To what extent do you agree/disagree that the threat of Coronavirus is being exaggerated?*” In response to this question, 70% agreed, 26% disagreed and 4% said they do not know/did not respond.

Question: “To what extent do you agree/disagree that the threat of Coronavirus is being exaggerated?”

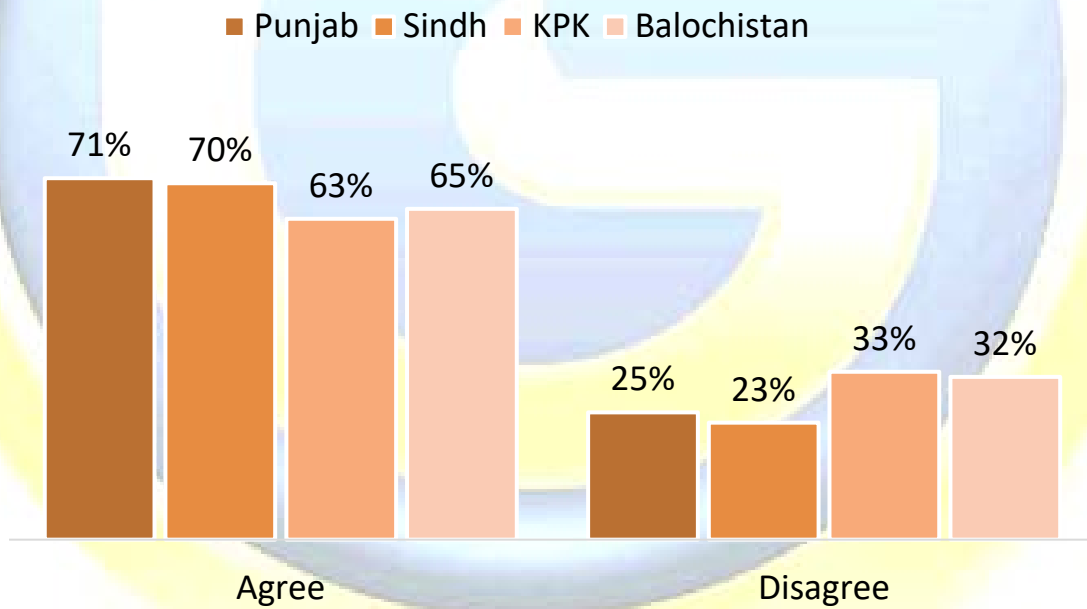

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,326 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during July 9 – August 10, 2020. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
