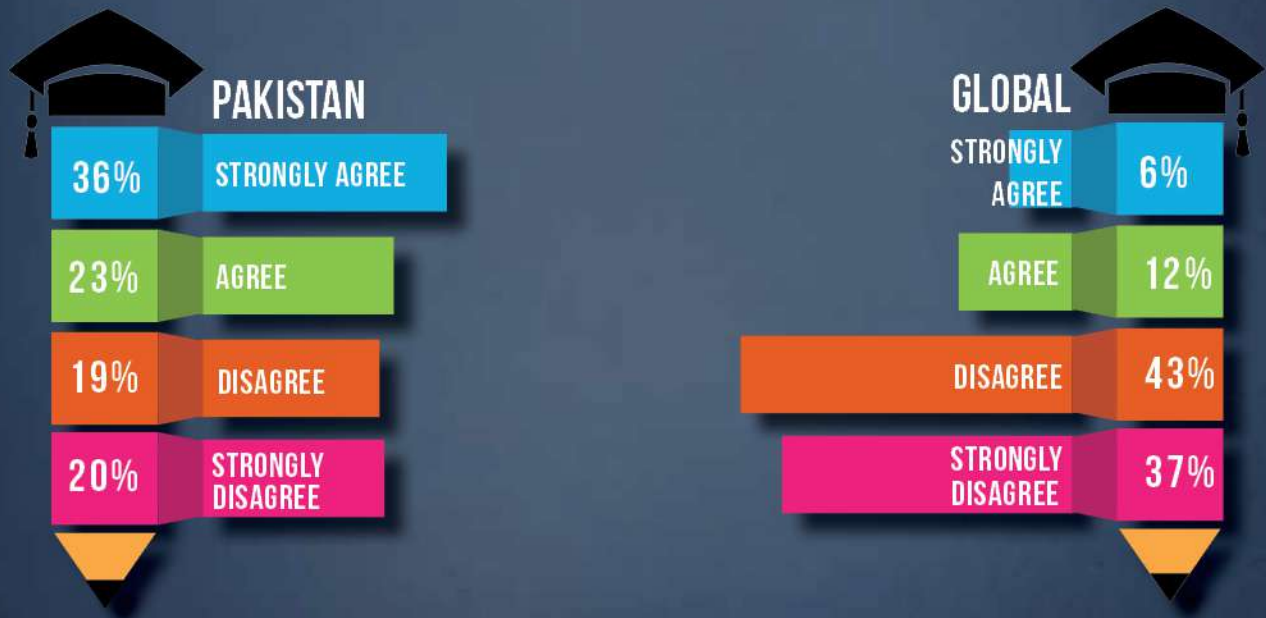

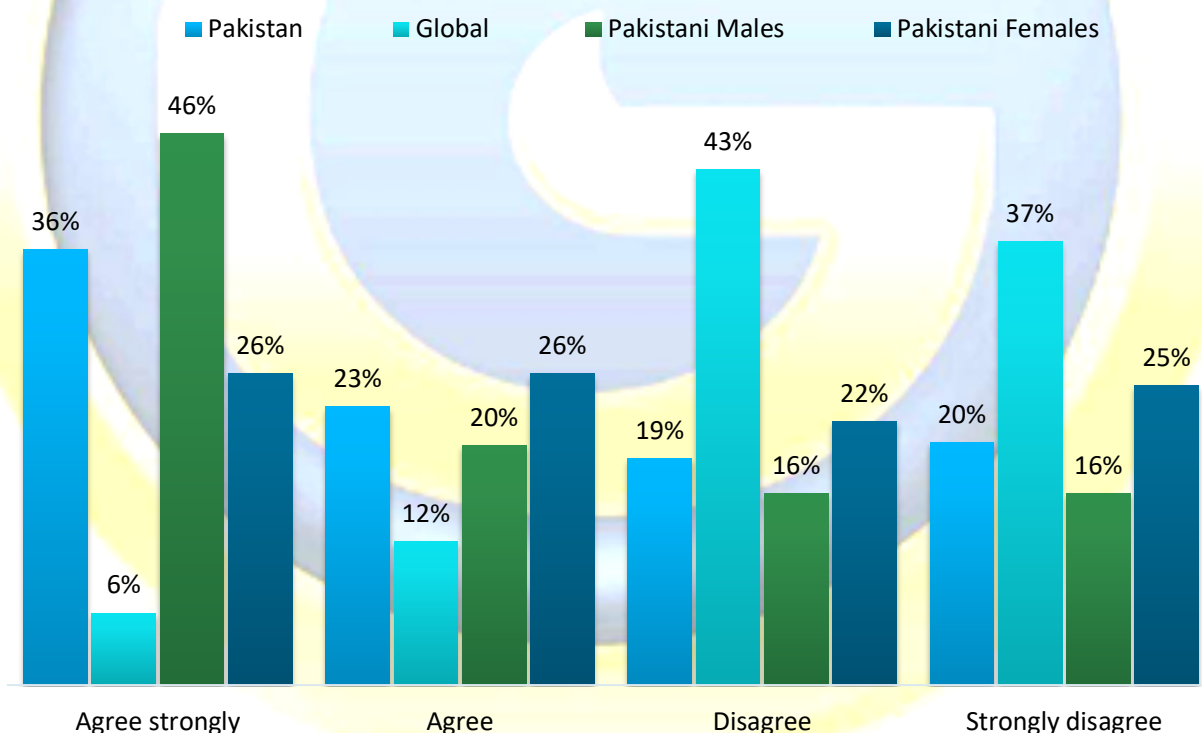
According to a World Values Survey and Gallup & Gilani Pakistan Poll, 59% Pakistanis agree that a university education is more important for a boy than for a girl.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “*Do you think a university education is more important for a boy than for a girl?*” In response to this question, 36% strongly agreed, 23% agreed, 19% disagreed, 20% strongly disagreed and 1% did not know/did not respond.

Gender Breakdown: 66% Pakistani males compared to 52% Pakistani females agree with the statement

Global Results: Only 18% respondents globally agree with the statement while 80% disagree.

The study was released by World Values Survey and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The survey was carried out among a sample of 1995 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, between 2017 and 2019. The global sample was 125,098. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
