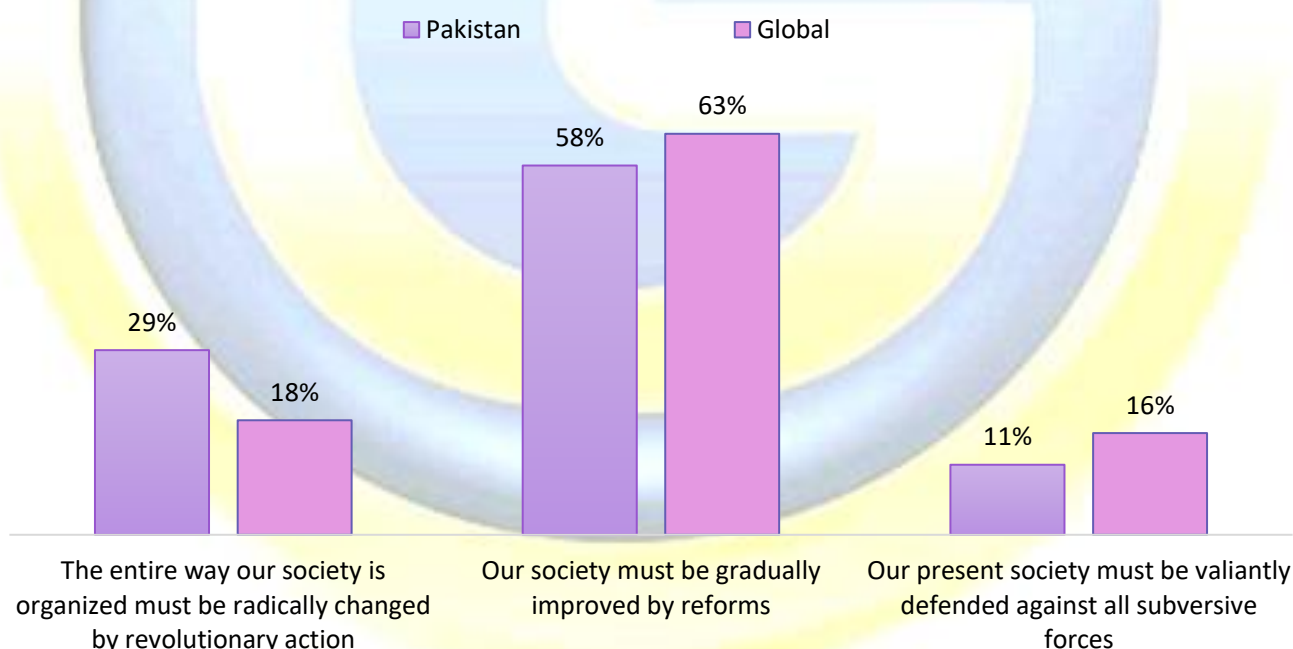

According to a World Values Survey and Gallup & Gilani Pakistan Poll, 58% Pakistanis opine that society should be gradually improved through reforms, while 29% believe that society should be radically revolutionized.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Which of the following three basic kinds of attitudes concerning the society we live in best describes your own opinion.” In response to this question, 58% said society should be gradually improved via reforms, 29% said society should be radically changed by revolutionary action and 11% said the present society should be valiantly defended against all subversive forces.

Global Results: Globally, 63% said society should be gradually improved via reforms.

The study was released by World Values Survey and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The survey was carried out among a sample of 1995 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, between 2017 and 2019. The global sample was 125,098. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
