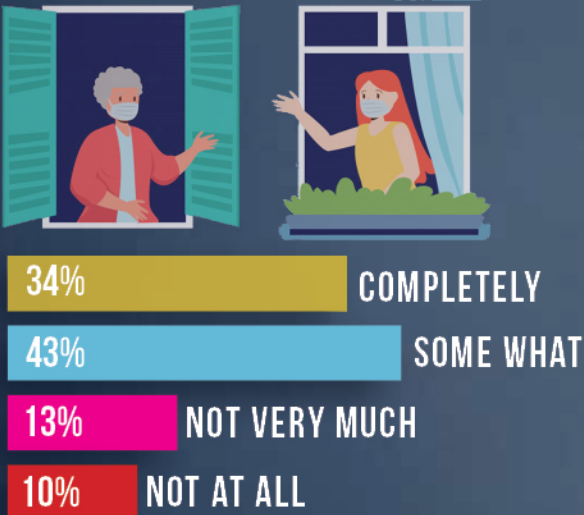


**77% PAKISTANIS SAY THEY TRUST PEOPLE FROM THEIR NEIGHBORHOOD,

& GILANI PAKISTAN)**

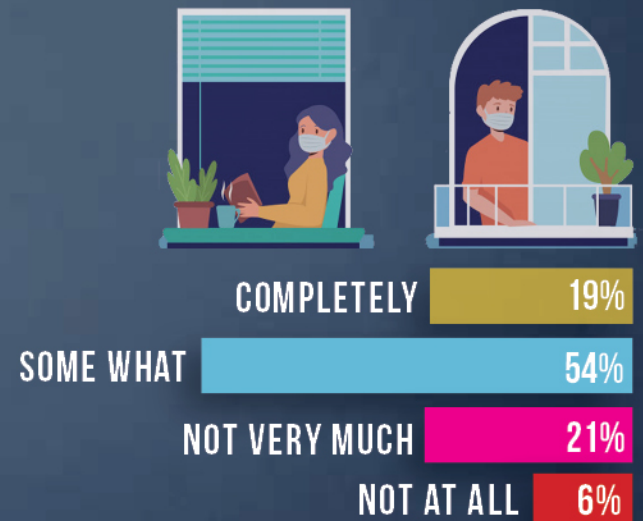

77% Pakistanis say they trust people from their neighborhood, 4% higher than the global average (World Values Survey and Gallup & Gilani Pakistan)

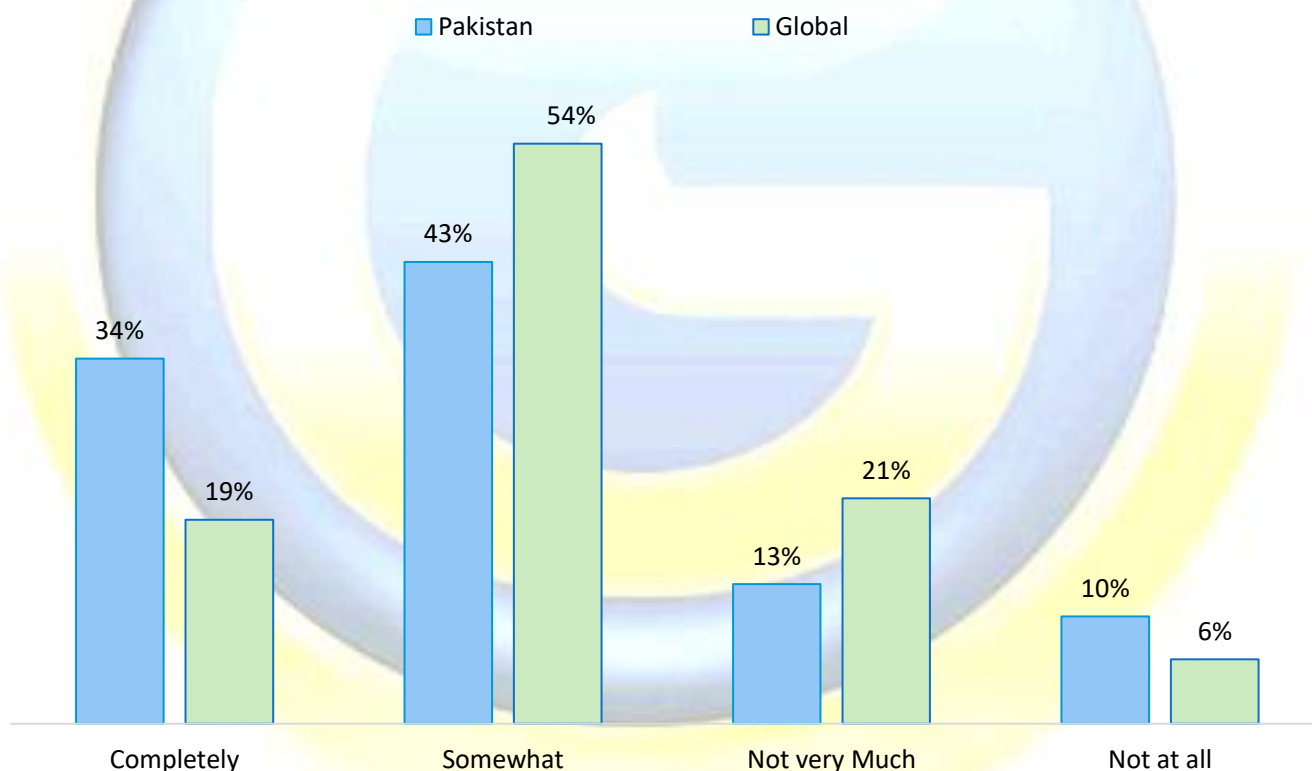

According to a World Values Survey and Gallup & Gilani Pakistan Poll, 34% Pakistanis trust people from their neighborhoods completely.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “*How much do you trust people from your neighborhood?*” In response to this question, 34% said completely, 43% said somewhat, 13% said not very much and 10% said not at all.

Global Results: Globally, 19% trust people from their neighborhoods completely.

The study was released by World Values Survey and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The survey was carried out among a sample of 1995 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, between 2017 and 2019. The global sample was 125,098. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
