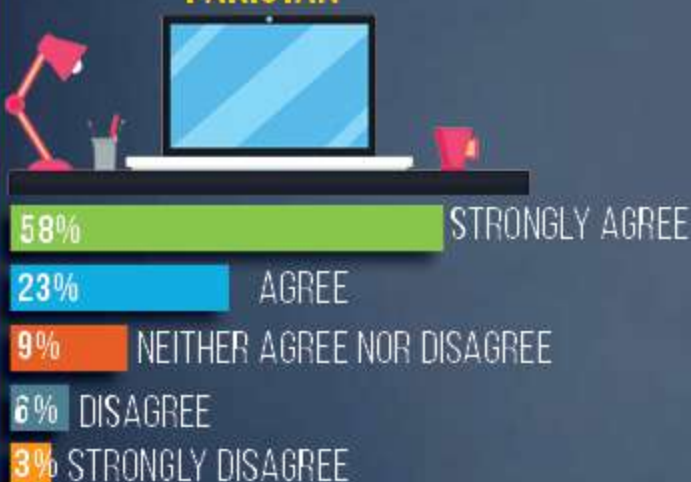


81% Pakistanis compared to the global average of 54% say that work should always come first even if it means less spare time (World Values Survey and Gallup & Gilani Pakistan)

81% Pakistanis compared to the global average of 54% say that work should always come first even if it means less spare time (World Values Survey and Gallup & Gilani Pakistan)

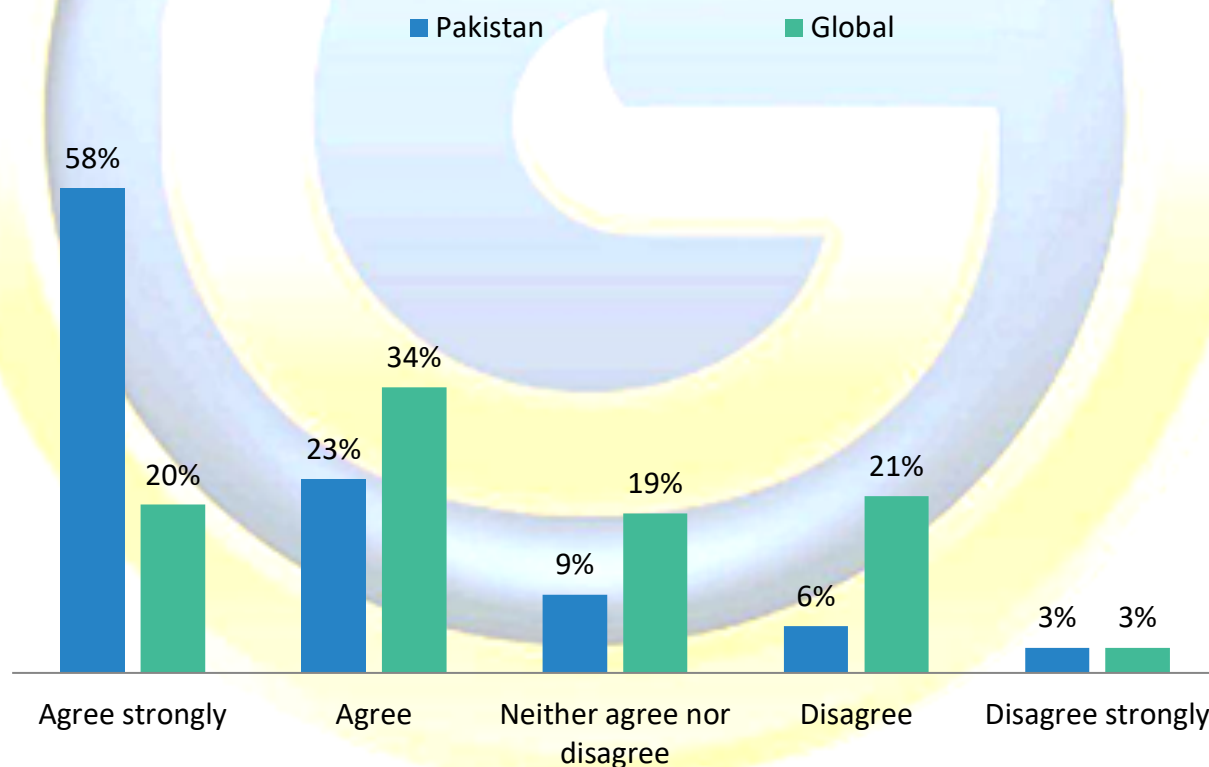

According to a World Values Survey and Gallup & Gilani Pakistan Poll, 81% Pakistanis say work should come first even if it means less spare time.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, *“Do you agree or disagree with the following statement? Work should always come first, even if it means less spare time”* In response to this question, 58% strongly agreed, 23% agreed, 9% neither agreed nor disagreed, 6% disagreed and 3% disagreed strongly.

Global Results: Globally, 20% respondents strongly agreed and 34% agreed with the statement.

The study was released by World Values Survey and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The survey was carried out among a sample of 1995 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, between 2017 and 2019. The global sample was 125,098. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
