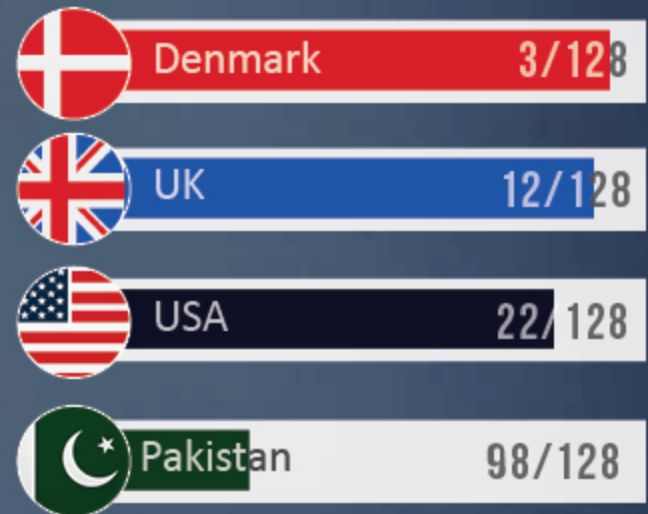

Criminal Justice Index: Pakistan ranks 98 across 128 countries in the world, lower than regional counterparts India and Iran. (World Justice Project and Gallup & Gilani Pakistan)

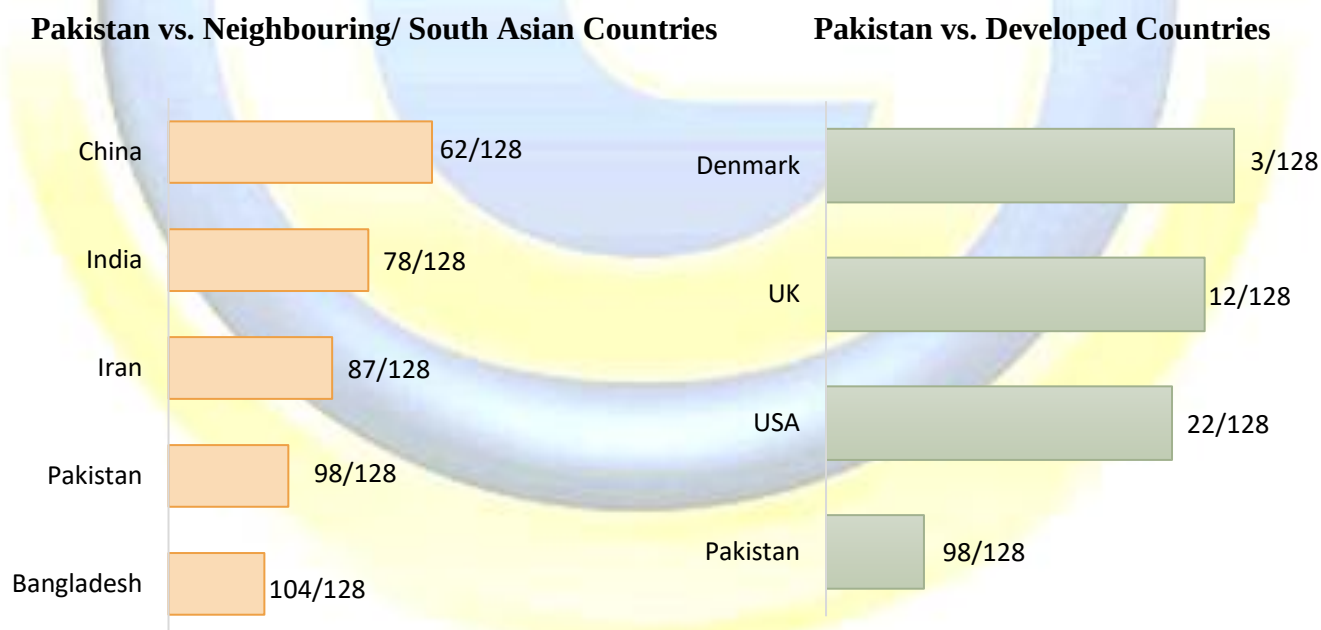

According to a World Justice Project (WJP) Survey conducted by Gallup Pakistan, Pakistan ranks 98 among 128 countries surveyed in the world in terms of criminal justice.

The global survey results are based on Factor 8 of the WJP Rule of Law Index which evaluates a country's criminal justice system. An effective criminal justice system is a key aspect of the rule of law, as it constitutes the conventional mechanism to redress grievances and bring action against individuals for offenses against society. An assessment of the delivery of criminal justice should take into consideration the entire system, including the police, lawyers, prosecutors, judges, and prison officers.

Pakistan's score on the index has remained at 0.35 in 2019 and 2020, however Pakistan's rank has fallen by four places.

The index is based on several indicators such as effective criminal investigation system, effective adjudication and corrective system, criminal justice is corruption free, impartial & devoid of improper government influence. Within the sub-factors, Pakistan ranks 107/128 on effective criminal investigation system, and 119/128 on due processes of law and rights of the accused.

The study was released by World Justice Project and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The country scores and rankings presented in this report are built from more than 500 variables drawn from the assessments of more than 130,000 households and 4,000 legal practitioners and experts in 128 countries and jurisdictions. The study in Pakistan was carried out among a sample of 1,000 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during 2019. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
