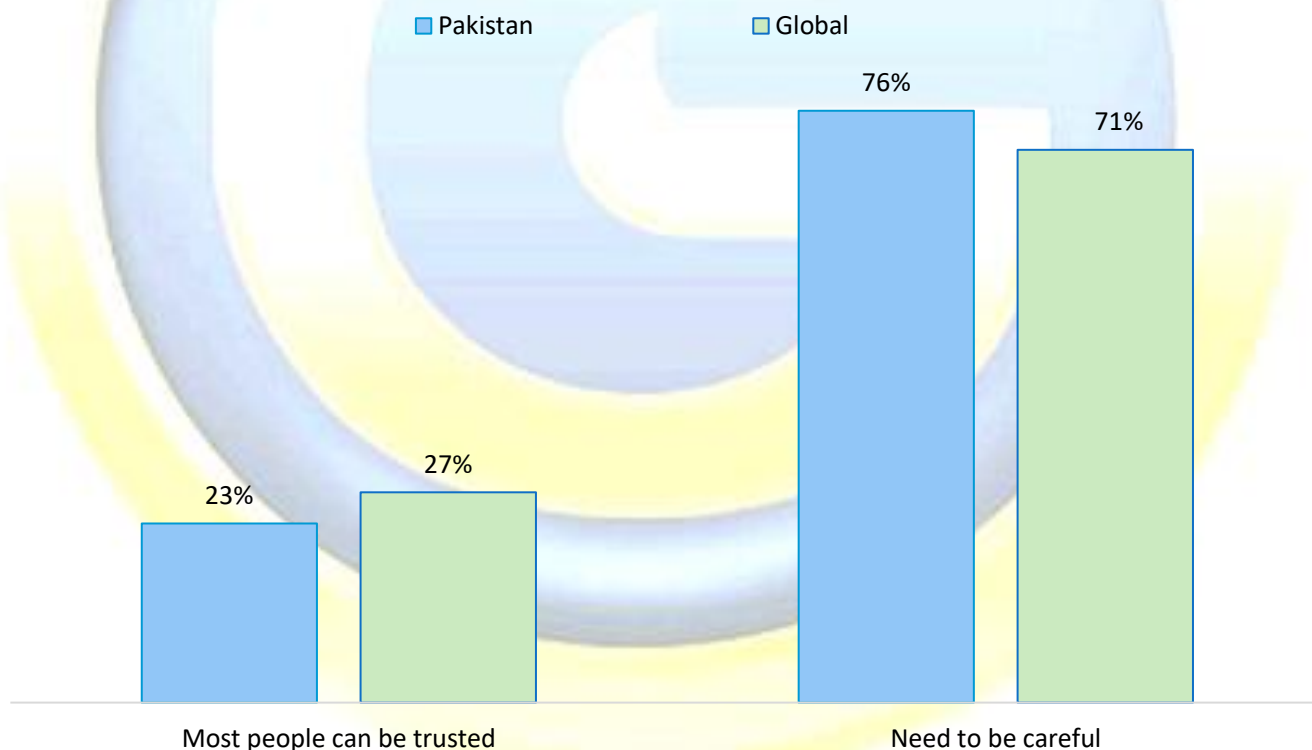

According to a World Values Survey and Gallup & Gilani Pakistan Poll, 23% Pakistanis believe that most people can be trusted.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, *“Generally speaking, would you say that most people can be trusted or that you need to be very careful in dealing with people?”* In response to this question, 23% said most people can be trusted while 76% said we need to be careful.

Global Results: Globally, 27% said most people can be trusted.

The study was released by World Values Survey and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The survey was carried out among a sample of 1995 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, between 2017 and 2019. The global sample was 125,098. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
