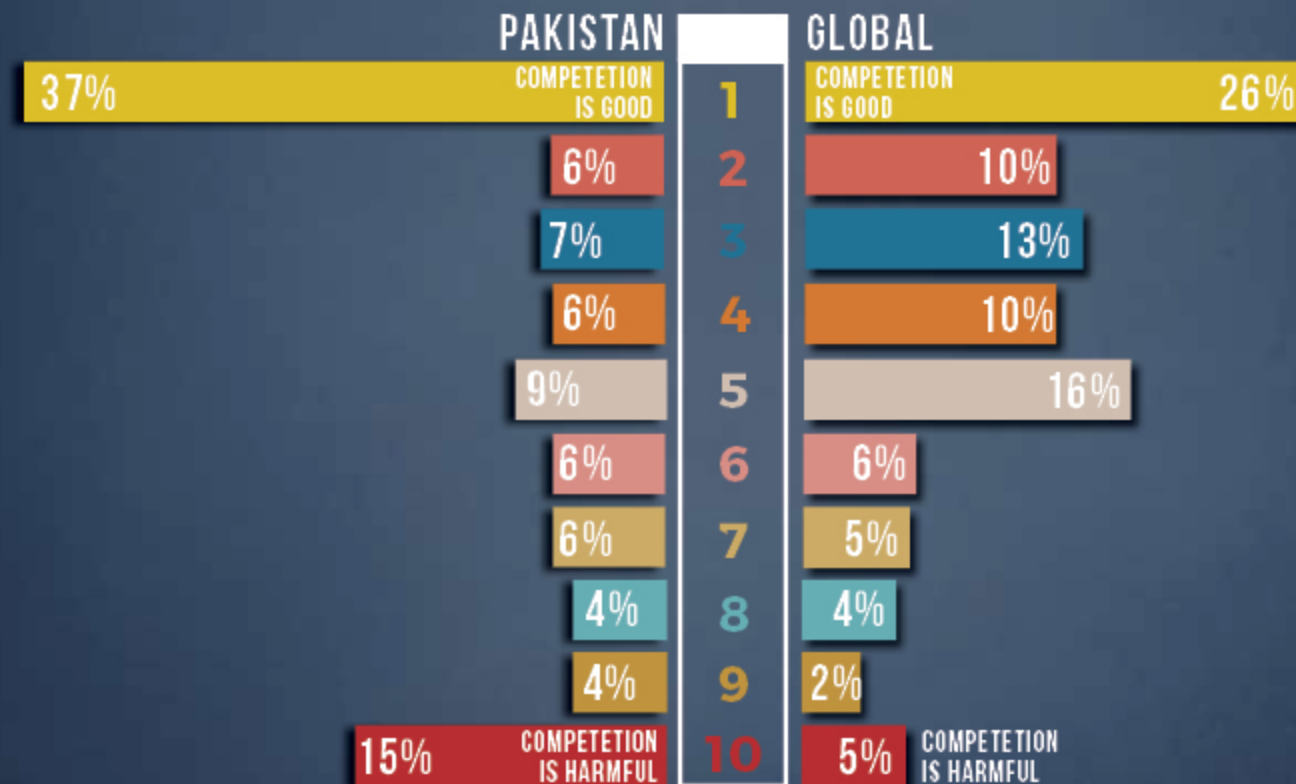


NEARLY 2 IN 5 PAKISTANIS (37%) BELIEVE COMPETITION IN LIFE TO BE GOOD COMPARED TO 26% GLOBALLY, WHILE 15% PAKISTANIS CONSIDER COMPETITION HARMFUL CONTRARY TO 5% GLOBALLY (WORLD VALUES SURVEY AND GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN)

Nearly 2 in 5 Pakistanis (37%) believe competition in life to be good compared to 26% globally, while 15% Pakistanis consider competition harmful contrary to 5% globally (World Values Survey and Gallup & Gilani Pakistan)

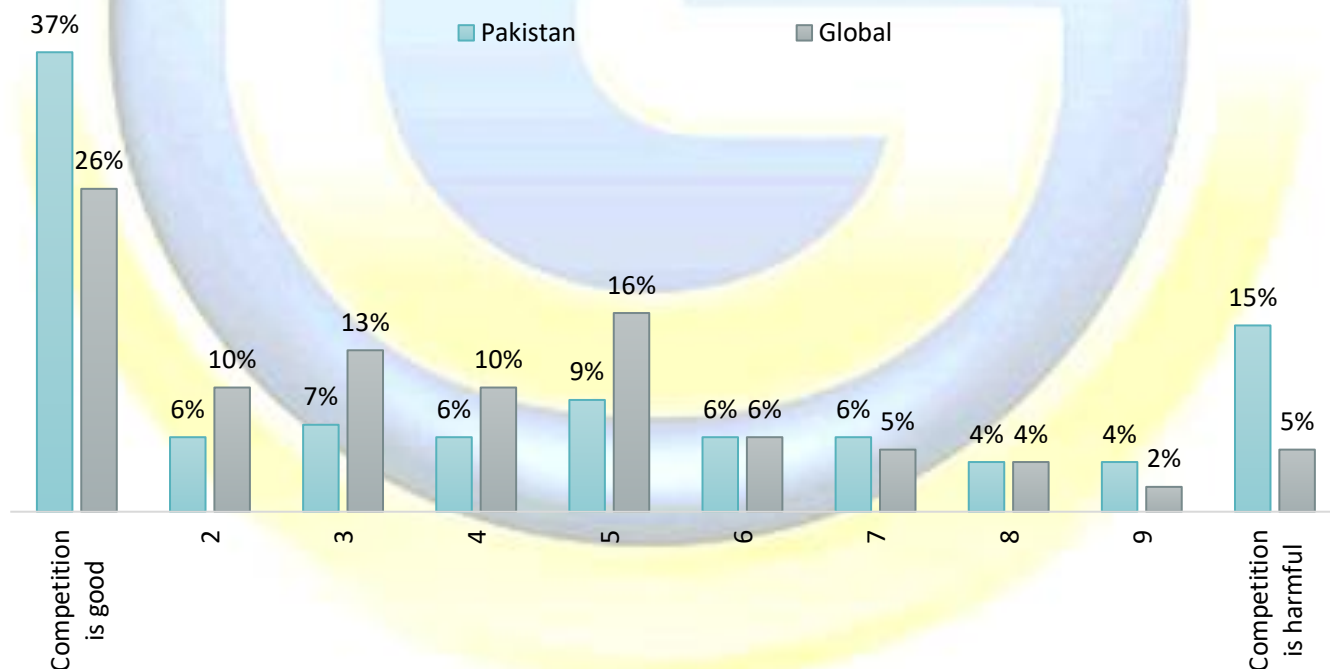

According to a World Values Survey and Gallup & Gilani Pakistan Poll, 37% Pakistanis believe competition to be a good thing.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Do you think competition in life is good or harmful? Please use this scale where 1 means “competition is good” and 10 means “competition is harmful” to indicate your opinion?” In response to this question, 37% said competition is good and while 15% said competition is harmful.

Global Comparison: Globally 26% consider competition to be good while 5% consider competition harmful.

Question: “Do you think competition in life is good or harmful? Please use this scale where 1 means “competition is good” and 10 means “competition is harmful” to indicate your opinion?”

The study was released by World Values Survey and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The survey was carried out among a sample of 1995 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, between 2017 and 2019. The global sample was 125,098. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
