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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY



Executive Summary

Computer usage in Pakistan:

- A high majority of over 9 in 10 (92%) Pakistanis claim that they have not used a desktop, laptop, tablet or any other similar device. Nearly double proportion of males claim to have used any such devices as compared to females.
- As compared to laptops, a relatively higher percentage (5%) agree to having used a desktop. Respondents under the age of 30, having achieved graduate and above education, belonging to urban areas and Karachi & Hazara regions report the highest usage of desktops.
- Out of the total respondents that claim to have used a computer or any similar equipment, nearly 3 in 4 (68%) say they have used such equipment at home while 17% agree that they have used computers at their work place. A higher percentage of females (77%) claim to have used a computer at home as compared to a lower 64% of males. Respondents with graduate degrees and higher education rank highest in usage of computers at workplace.
- Over half Pakistanis (52%) that have used computers agree that they have copied or moved a file or folder as compared to other tasks such as using software, spread sheets or making presentations.
- A high 46% claim they have used computers for entertainment while 30% say they have used it for social media. More females (54%) claim to use computers for internet as compared to males (41%).
- Of the respondents that say they are not using a computer, lack of knowledge on how to use the computer (53%) is identified as the major factor while 15% state affordability as the deterrent for computer use. Lack of skills is higher amongst males, respondents over the age of 50, illiterate, rural dwellers and those belonging to KP province.

Mobile Phone usage in Pakistan:

- While 55% Pakistanis claim that they do not have a personal mobile phone, 3 in 10 (30%) Pakistanis agree that they have a mobile phone while 15% Pakistanis claim to have a personal smart phone.
- 27% more males claim to have a personal mobile phone while 12% more males claim to own a smart phone than females.
- Nearly 3 in 4 (71%) Pakistanis say that they have used a mobile phone, 20% say they have used a smart phone while nearly 1 in 10 (9%) Pakistanis claim that they have not used a mobile/smart phone



- 4% more females than males claim to have used a mobile phone while 7% higher usage is reported for smart phones amongst males. Those over the age of 50 claim highest usage of mobile phones while those between ages 19 and 30 rank highest in terms of smart phone usage.
- Majority (28%) reported not being allowed to use a mobile as a major reason for not using a mobile phone followed by over 1 in 4 (27%) Pakistanis identifying lack of skills to use mobile phones and 1 in 5 (21%) claiming not needing a mobile phone as the major factor for not using a mobile/smart phone.
- The highest (50%) proportion of respondents over age 50 claim to not know how to use a phone while 41% of respondents under the age of 18 say they are not allowed to use a phone.

Internet Usage in Pakistan:

- Nearly 1 in 5 (17%) Pakistanis claim to have used the internet in the last three months
- Males, respondents between ages 19 and 30, graduate and above education and urban respondents rank the highest in terms of internet usage.
- A significant majority (89%) claim to have used internet in their homes while 1 in 4 (24%) claim to have used internet at work
- 7% more females than males claim to have used internet at home. A higher percentage of rural respondents say they used internet in mobility as compares to urban respondents.
- Over half Pakistanis (51%) agreed to having used internet once a day. Males, those between ages 19 and 30, graduates and above and urban respondents are more likely to use internet once a day.
- 18% Pakistanis agreed that they had used internet during the last 12 months. A higher proportion of males and respondents between ages 19 and 30 claim to have used the internet.
- During the last 12 months, 83% agreed to having used internet at home while 22% said they had used it at work. Out of the respondents that claim to use internet at work, males and those between ages 31 and 50 rank the highest.
- The highest percentages of uses of internet were for voice/video calls on Skype/WhatsApp etc. (73%), followed by 65% that agreed to having used internet for email, chatting, Facebook etc.
- 24% more males claim to use internet for email, chatting etc while 6% more females claim to use internet for education and research. The highest proportion of people above the age of 50 (79%) say



they use internet for voice and video calls, with minimal (2%) rural urban differences.

- Over half Pakistanis (52%) believe that they do not need the internet while 41% claim to lack the skills to use internet

Characteristics of household having different facilities:

- 34% Pakistanis agreed that their household has internet facility available
- Of the households that claim to have internet facility available, urban households and those in Sindh and KP rank the highest.
- Nearly 3 in 4 (70%) respondents claim to have one internet connection in their household. Highest proportion (11%) in Sindh claim to have three internet connections.
- Nearly all (95%) households claim to have a mobile facility. Highest proportions of respondents from KP South, Interior Sindh and Kalat & Makran Region say that they do not have a mobile facility.
- 43% claim to have one mobile for the household while 32% claim to own two mobiles. A high 17% in Balochistan claim to own more than three mobiles in a household with urban areas reporting higher number of mobiles per household.
- 98% households said that they do not have a landline facility of which 91% households that have a landline say they have one landline connection. Islamabad division reports highest ownership of landlines.
- 8% households claimed to have computer facility of which 95% of the household that owned computers had one computer in their household. Minimal difference observed between urban rural and provinces in terms of computer ownership.
- 7% households claimed to have laptop facility of which 90% claimed to have one laptop. Highest proportion of respondents from Karachi region and Islamabad division confirmed ownership of laptop.
- Only 2% Pakistanis claimed to have tablet/iPad facility of which 88% said they have one tablet/iPad. Relatively higher ownership of tablet/iPad observed in urban areas amongst Karachi region.
- 17% households claim to use cable/wired company (e.g PTCL/NTC/Nayatel) services of which 89% say they have one cable connection. Cable connections are reported more often in urban areas than in rural areas while they are highest in Sindh.
- 8% Pakistanis say they have wireless company services used at home of which 88% claim to have one wireless connection at home. A high 27% of respondents from KPK South claim to have two wireless connections



at home with urban areas having a higher number of wireless connections at home.

- 11% households claimed to have a mobile company service being used at home of which 65% say they have one mobile connection at home. Rural respondents rank highest amongst those that claim to have one mobile connection at home while respondents from Quetta region rank highest in claiming more than three mobile connections in their household.

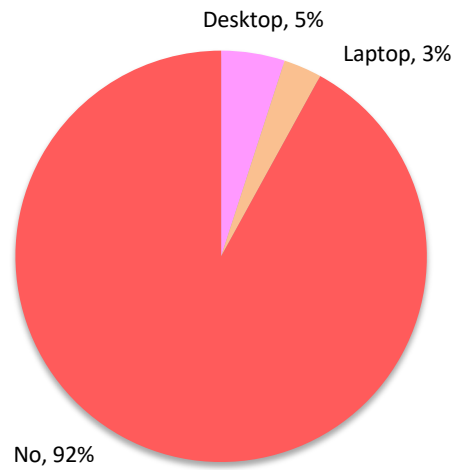


TOPIC 1: Computer Usage in Pakistan

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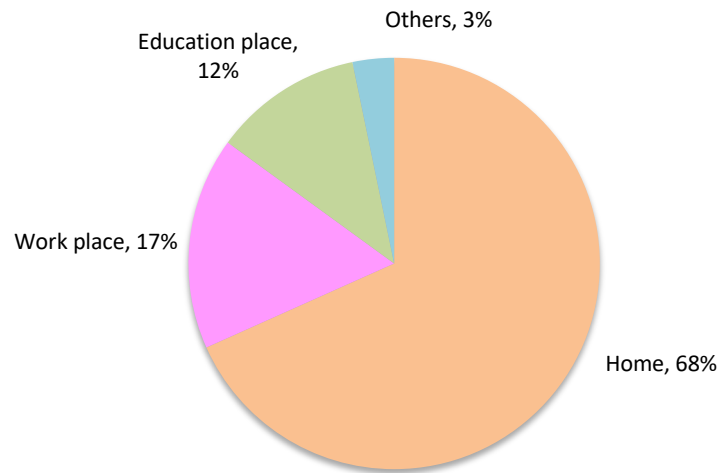

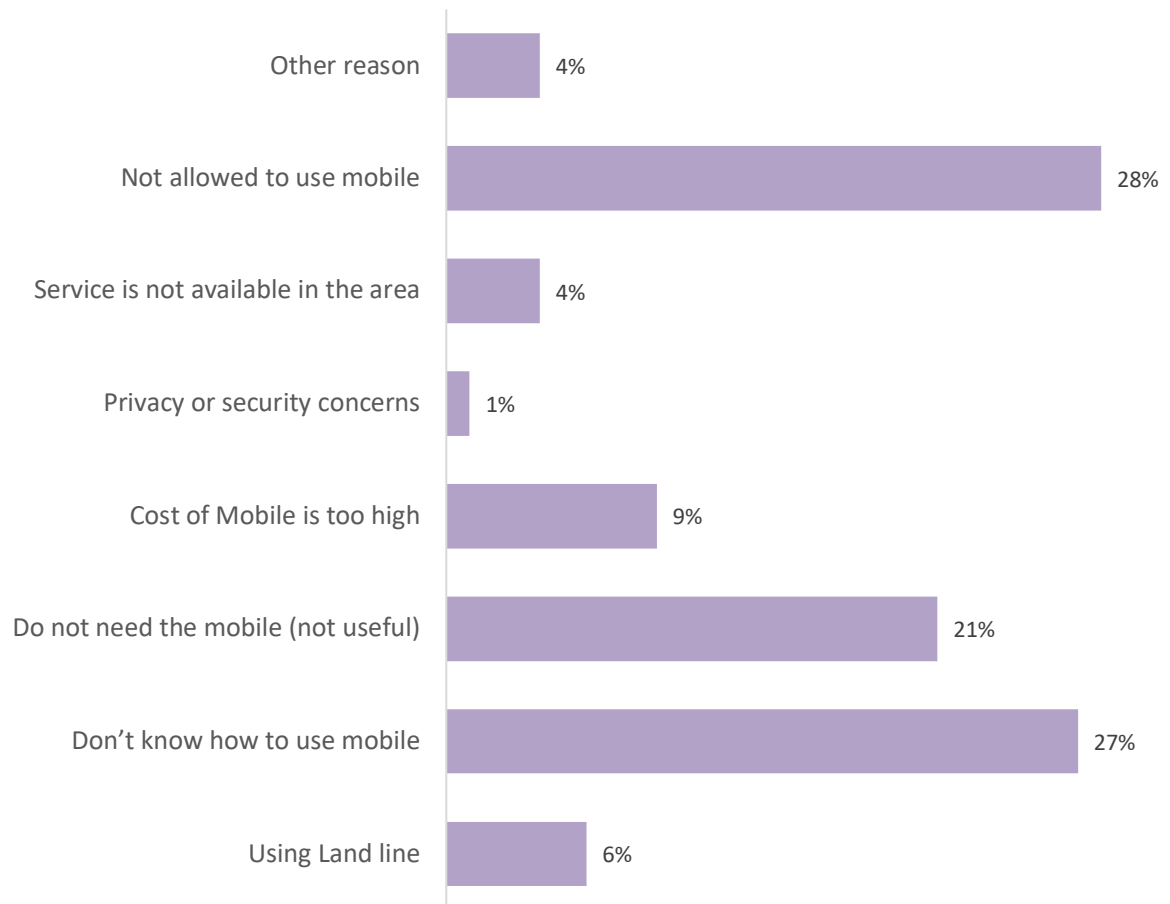

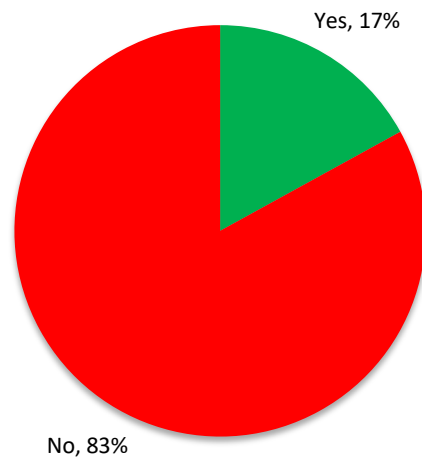

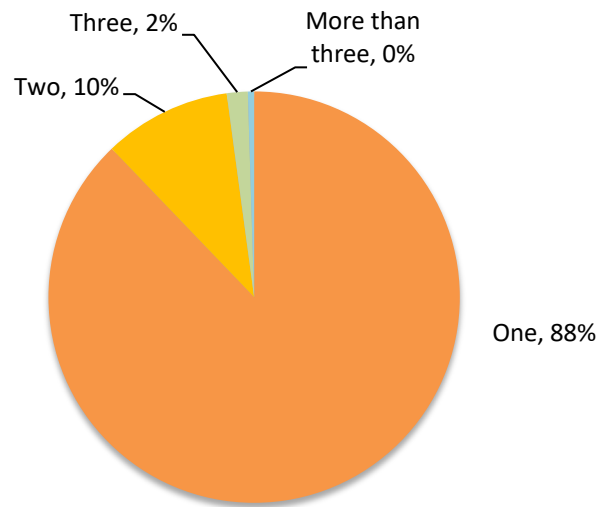

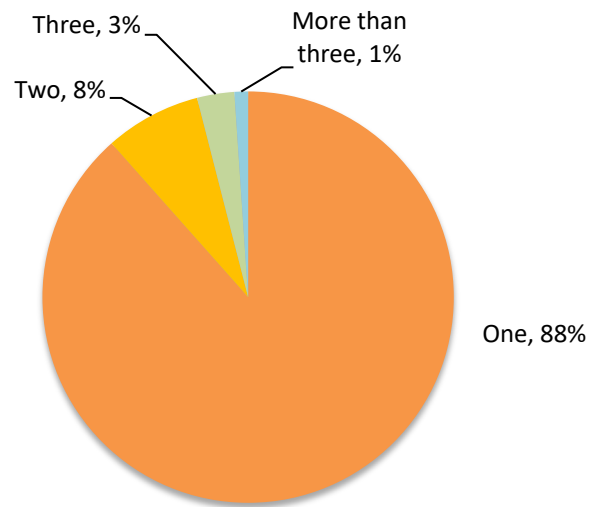

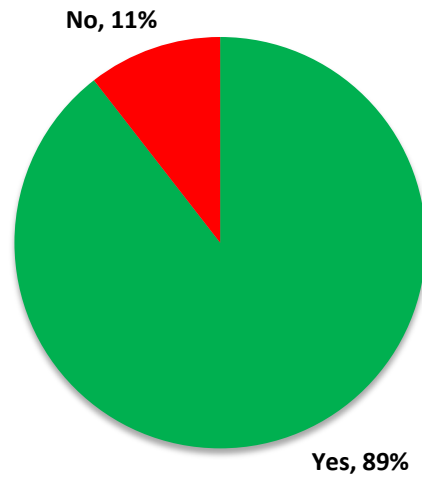

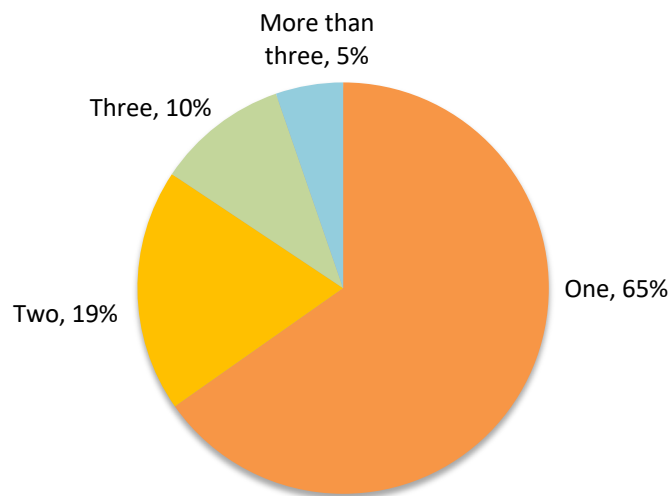

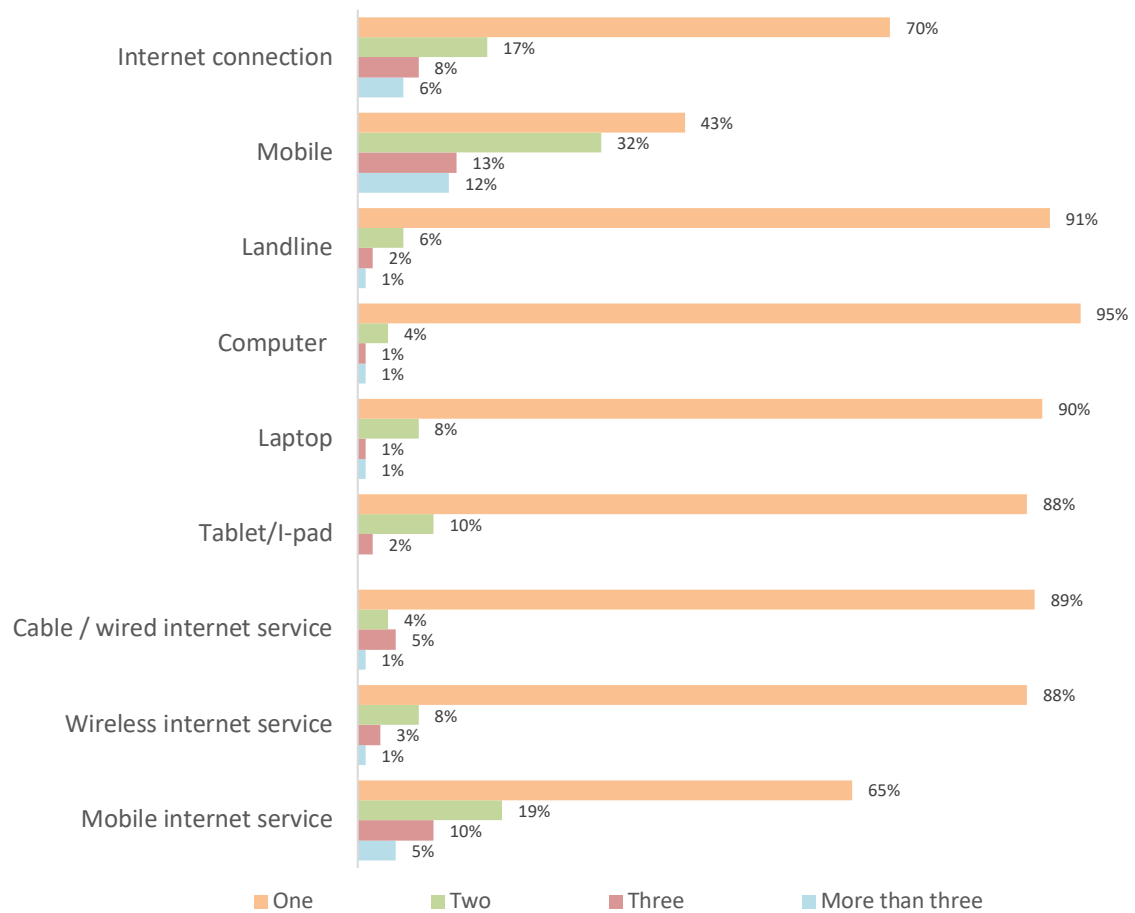
