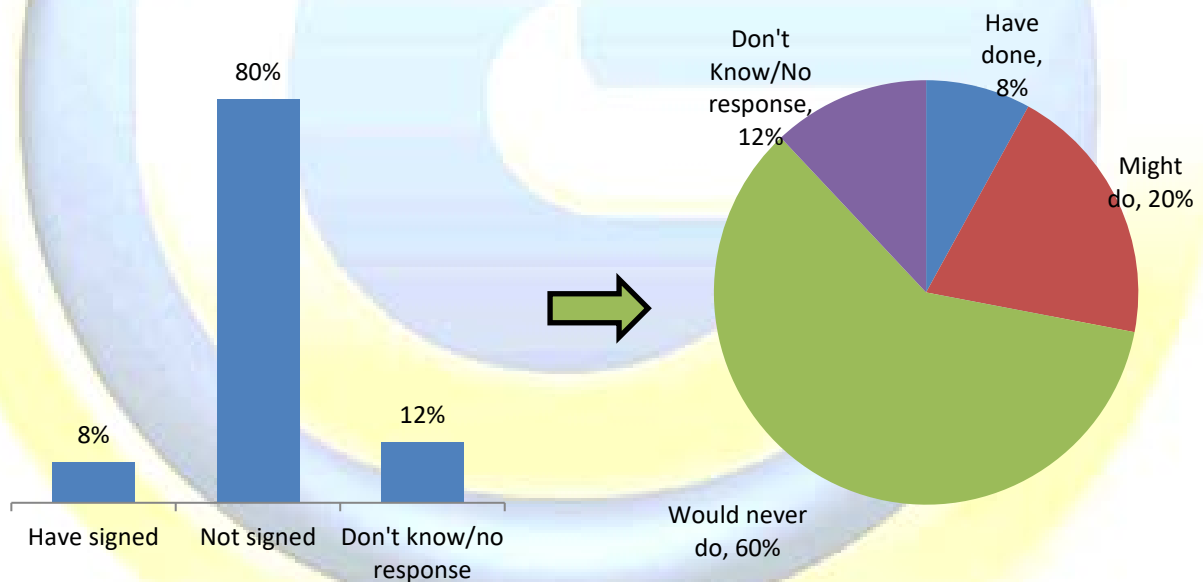
Only 8 % Pakistanis claim to have signed a petition as a political activity; 6 % say that they will never sign a petition: World Values Survey and Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), January 29th, 2021

According to a World Values Survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan in 2018, 8% Pakistanis said that they have attended signed a petition. 60% say that they would never sign a petition.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Have you ever signed a petition, do you think you might or would never under any circumstances sign a petition?” In response to this question, 8% said ‘have done’, 20% said ‘might do’, 60% said ‘would never do’. 12% did not know/did not respond.

The study was released by World Values Survey and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The survey was carried out among a sample of 1995 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of Pakistan, between 4th November and 11th December 2018. The global sample was 125,098. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
