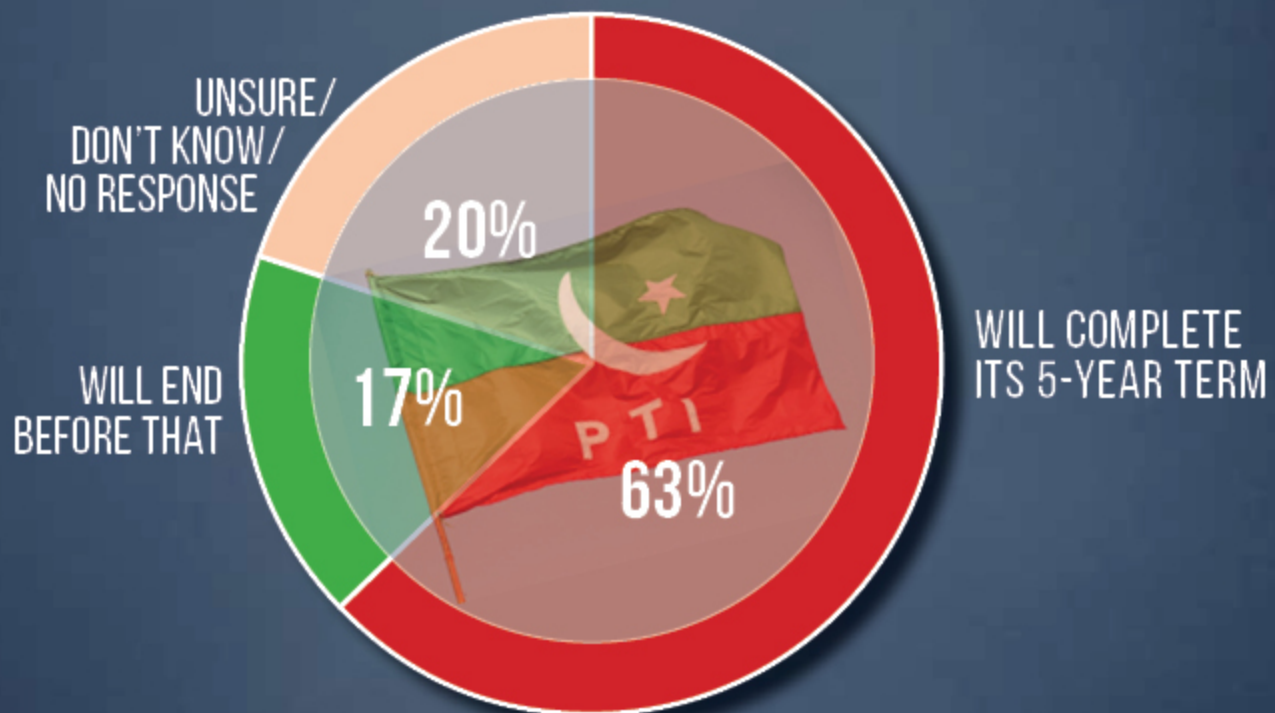

6 IN 10 PAKISTANIS BELIEVE THAT THE CURRENT GOVERNMENT OF PTI WILL COMPLETE ITS 5-YEAR TERM: GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN

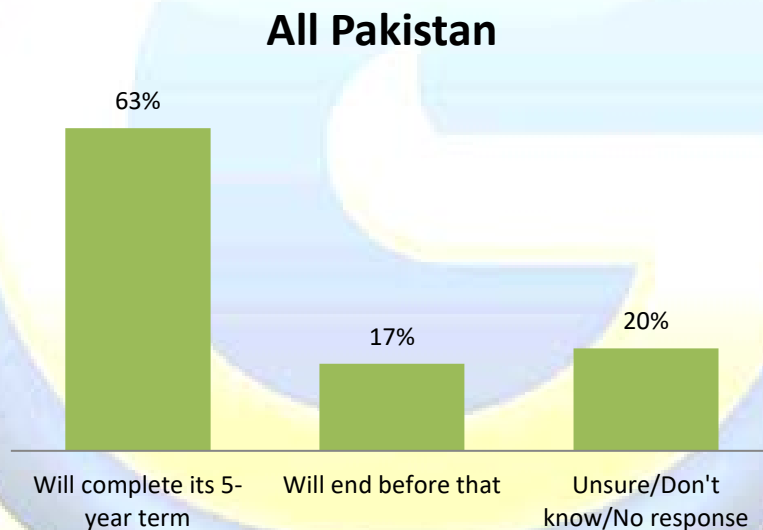
6 in 10 Pakistanis believe that the current government of PTI will complete its 5-year term: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), February 17, 2021

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 63% Pakistanis think that the current federal government will complete its 5-year term while 17% think otherwise.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Do you think that the current federal government will complete its 5-year term or will end before that?” In response to this question, 63% said ‘Will complete it’s 5-year term’, 17% said ‘Will end before that’. 20% did not know/did not respond/were unsure.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,080 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during December 24, 2020 – January 15, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
