Opinion Poll Coronavirus Attitudes

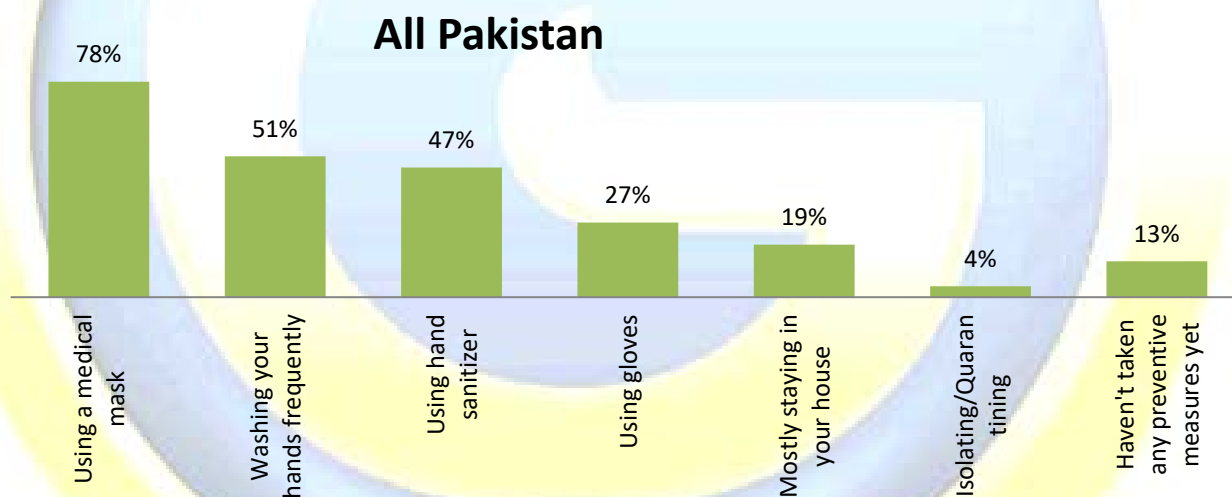
Majority of Pakistanis (78 %) claim to wear a medical mask as a preventive measure against COVID-19; 13 % claim to have taken no precautions at all: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), February 18, 2021

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 78% claim to use a medical mask as a preventive measure against COVID-19.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “*What preventive measures are you taking against COVID-19?*” In response to this question, 78% said ‘Using a medical mask’, 51% said ‘Washing your hands frequently’, 47% said ‘Using hand sanitizer’, 27% said ‘Using gloves’, 19% said ‘Mostly staying in your house’, 4% said ‘Isolating/Quarantining’, while 13% said that they haven’t taken any preventive measures yet.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,080 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during December 24, 2020 – January 15, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was phone interviews. Respondents hailed from over 100 districts of Pakistan.
