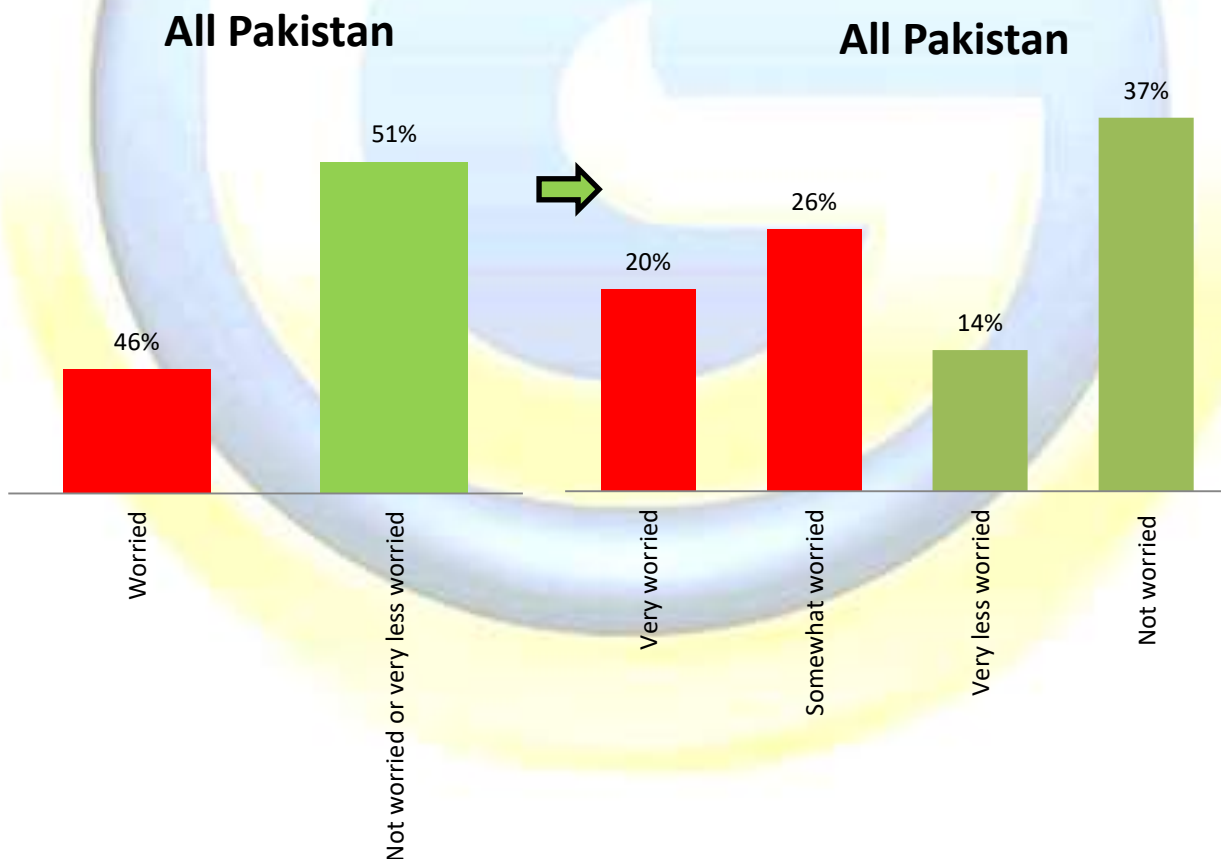
46% Pakistanis are worried during shopping when shopkeepers and other customers are not wearing masks: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), February 22, 2021

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 46% Pakistanis claim to be worried when shopkeepers and customers are not wearing masks.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Please tell us how worrying it is for you while shopping when shopkeepers or customers are not wearing masks” In response to this question, 37% said ‘Not worried’, 26% said ‘Somewhat worried’, 20% said ‘Very worried’, 14% said ‘Very less worried’. 3% did not know/did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,080 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during December 24, 2020 – January 15, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was phone interviews. Respondents hailed from over 100 districts of Pakistan.
