

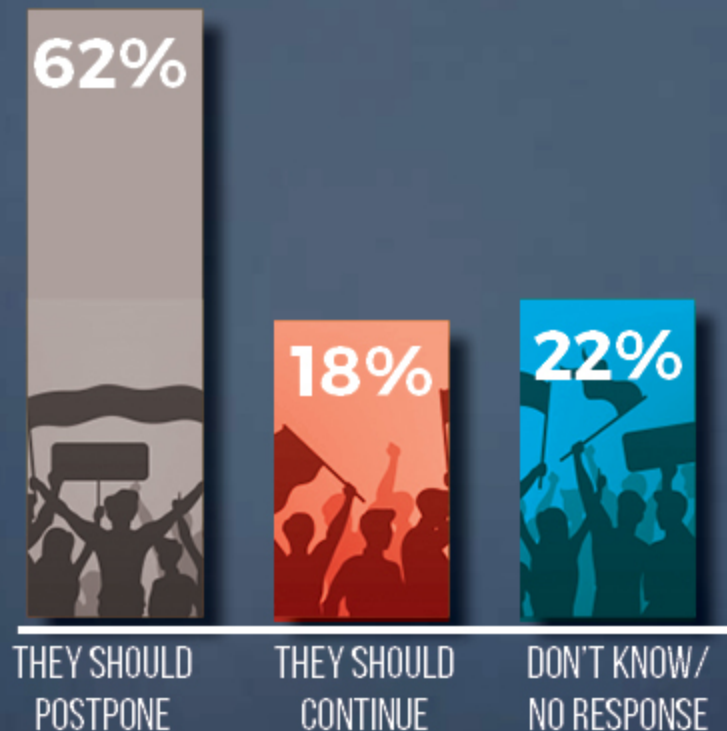

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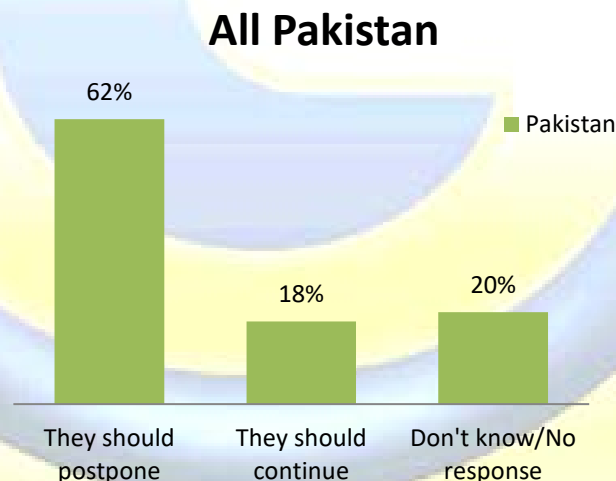
6 in 10 Pakistanis (62 %) believe that the opposition should postpone its rallies, gatherings and political activities because of the COVID-19 situation: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), February 26, 2021

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 62% Pakistanis think in the COVID-19 situation, the opposition should postpone its rallies, gatherings, and political activities.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Some people think that in the COVID-19 situation, the opposition should postpone its rallies, gatherings and political activities, whereas other people think that the opposition should continue with its rallies, gatherings and political activities. What is your opinion on this?” In response to this question, 62% said ‘They should postpone’, 18% said ‘They should continue’. 20% did not know/did not respond.

Question: “Some people think that in the COVID-19 situation, the opposition should postpone its rallies, gatherings and political activities, whereas other people think that the opposition should continue with its rallies, gatherings and political activities. What is your opinion on this?”

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,080 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during December 24, 2020 – January 15, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was phone interviews. Respondents hailed from over 100 districts of Pakistan.
