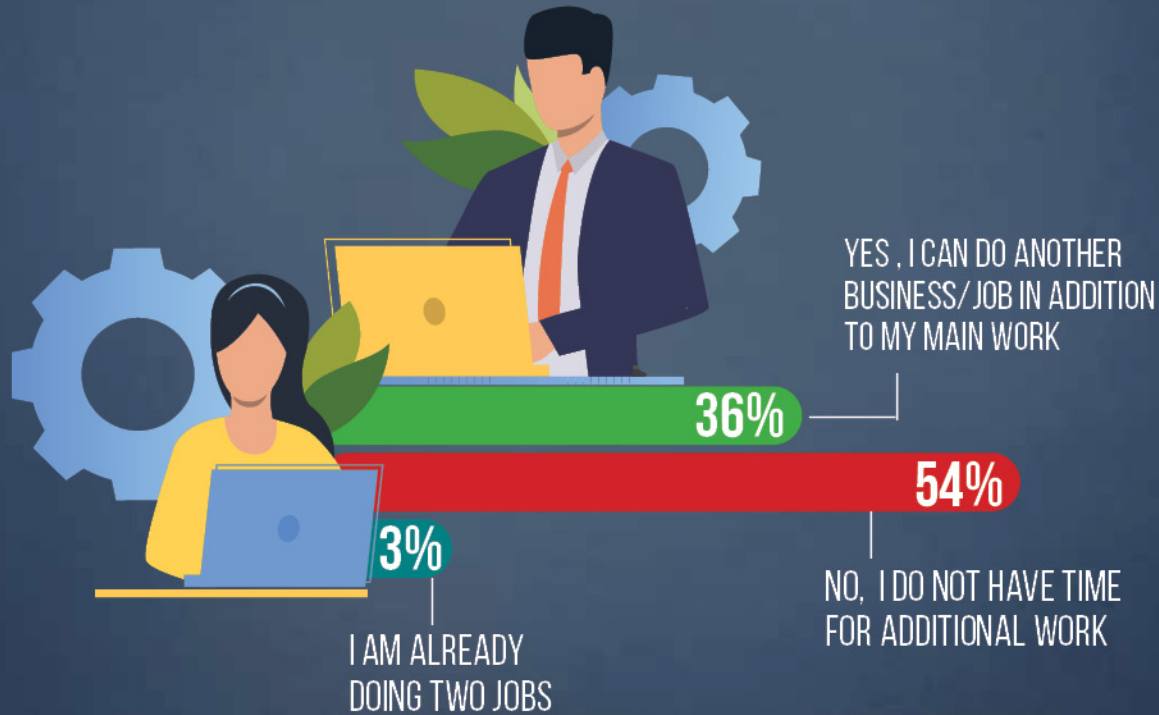

36% PAKISTANIS THINK THAT THEY CAN DO ANOTHER JOB IN ADDITION TO THEIR MAIN WORK; 54% DO NOT HAVE TIME FOR ADDITIONAL WORK: GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN

36 % Pakistanis think that they can do another job in addition to their main work; 54 % do not have time for additional work: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), March 10, 2021

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 36% Pakistanis say that they can do another job in addition to their main work. 54% do not have time for additional work.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Some people are of the opinion that in addition to their main job, they also have time to do a secondary job/business while some people think that their current employment takes up all their time and they cannot even think of doing any additional job/business. Please tell, can you take up additional work along with your main job?” In response to this question, 54% said ‘No, I do not have time for additional work’, 36% said ‘Yes, I can do another business/job in addition to my main work’, while 3% said ‘I am already doing two jobs’. 8% did not know/did not respond.

Question: “Some people are of the opinion that in addition to their main job, they also have time to do a secondary job/business while some people think that their current employment takes up all their time and they cannot even think of doing any additional job/business. Please tell, can you take up additional work along with your main job?”

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,503 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during February 6, 2021 – February 27, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was phone interviews. Respondents hailed from over 100 districts of Pakistan.
