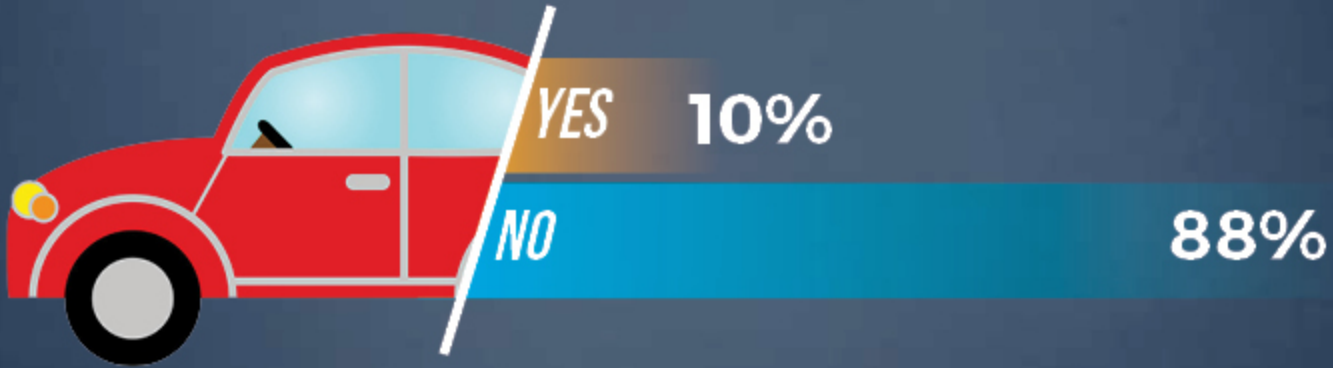

Only 1 in 10 Pakistanis have a car at their house; 9% more people from urban areas as compared to rural areas claim that they have a car at their house: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

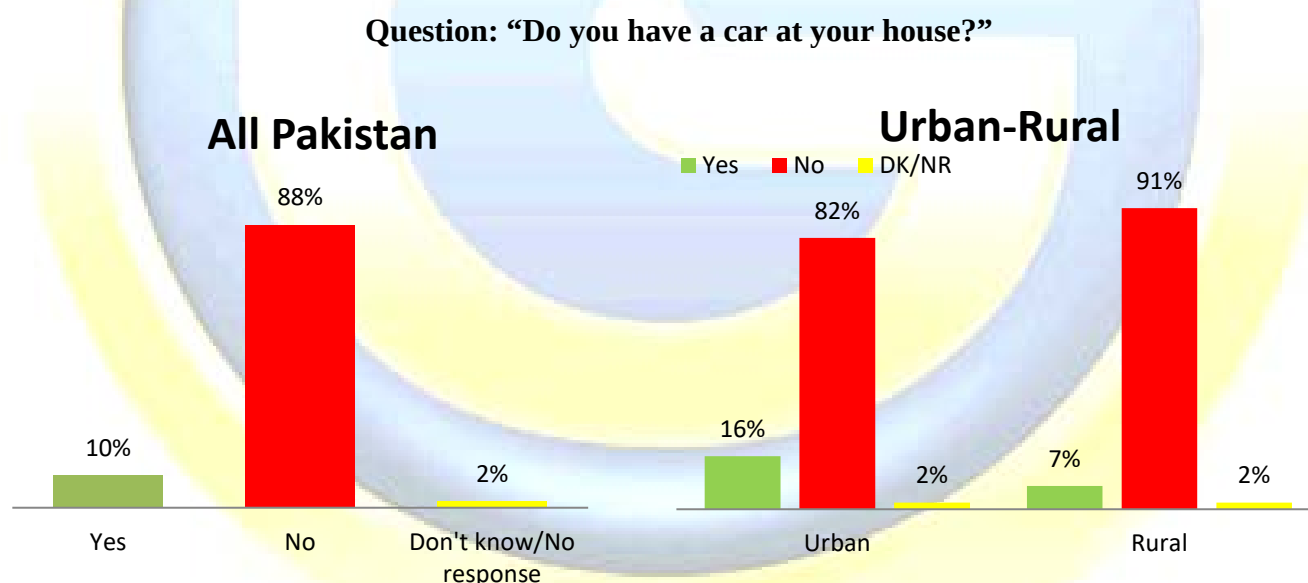

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 10% Pakistanis have a car at their house.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Do you have a car at your house?” In response to this question, 10% said ‘Yes’, 88% said ‘No’. 2% did not know/did not respond.

Urban-rural breakdown: 9% more urban respondents claim to have a car at their homes as compared to rural area respondents

16% from urban areas said that they have a car while 7% from rural areas said so. 82% from urban areas said that they do not have a car at their home while 91% from rural areas said so.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,080 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during December 24, 2020 – January 15, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was phone interviews. Respondents hailed from over 100 districts of Pakistan.
