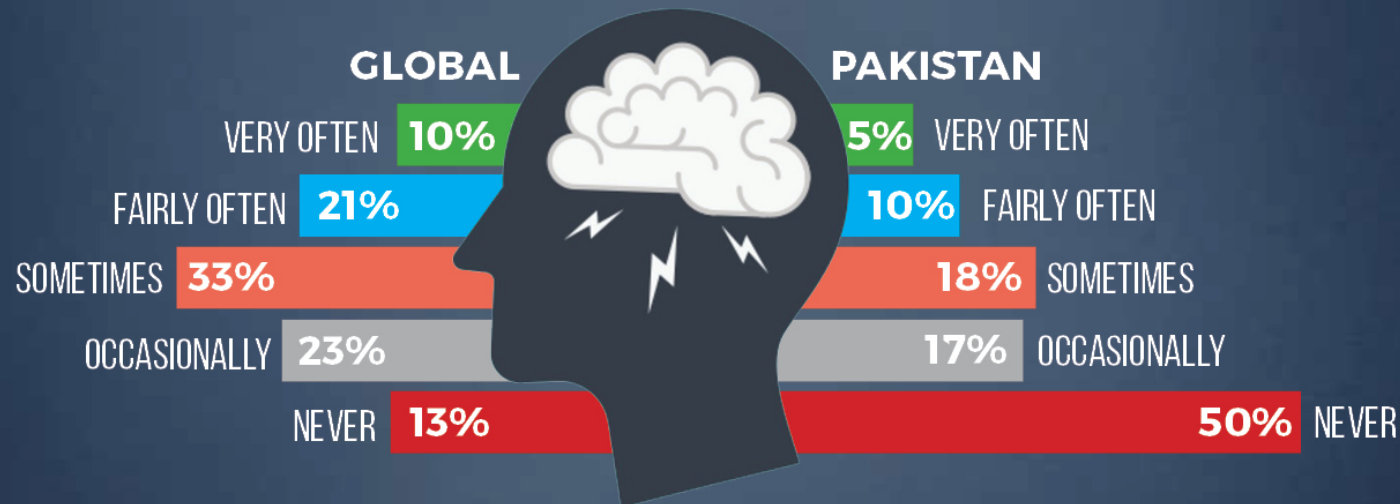

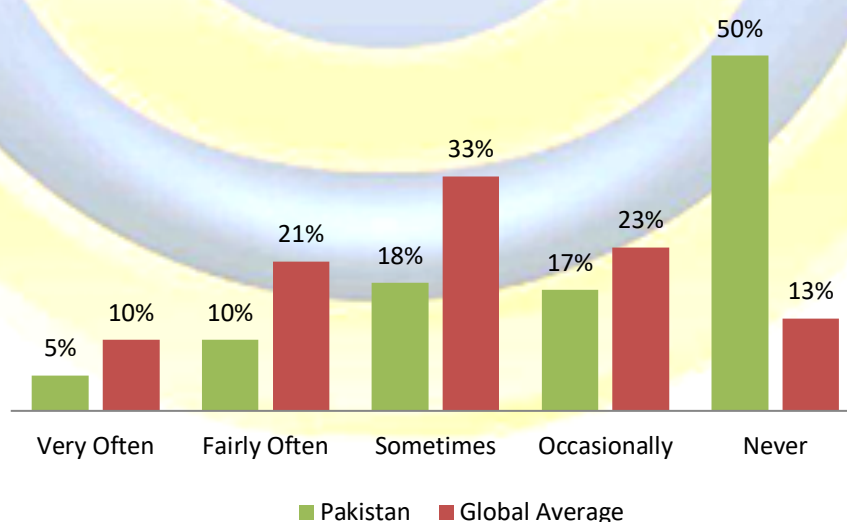

WIN International, the world's leading association in market research and polling, has published the Annual WIN World Survey (WWS - 2020) exploring the views and beliefs of 29,252 individuals among citizens from 34 countries across the globe about their health and lifestyle. The survey analyzes views and opinions related to the perception of health and habits of citizens.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces of Pakistan was asked the following question, “**How often would you say that you suffer from stress?**” 50% of respondents said that they never suffer from stress, 17% said that they suffer from stress occasionally, 18% of the respondents said that they suffer from stress sometimes, 10% of the respondents said that they suffer from stress fairly often and 5% of the respondents said that they suffer from stress very often.

Global picture: Globally, 13% claim to never suffer from stress, 23% claim to suffer from stress occasionally, 33% sometimes, 21% fairly often and 10% very often

The study was released by WIN International and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The survey was carried out among a sample of 1103 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of Pakistan, between 5th November and 15th November 2020. The global sample was 29,252. The margin of error for the survey is between 4.4 and 2.5 at 95% confidence level. The global average has been computed according to the covered adult population of the surveyed countries.
