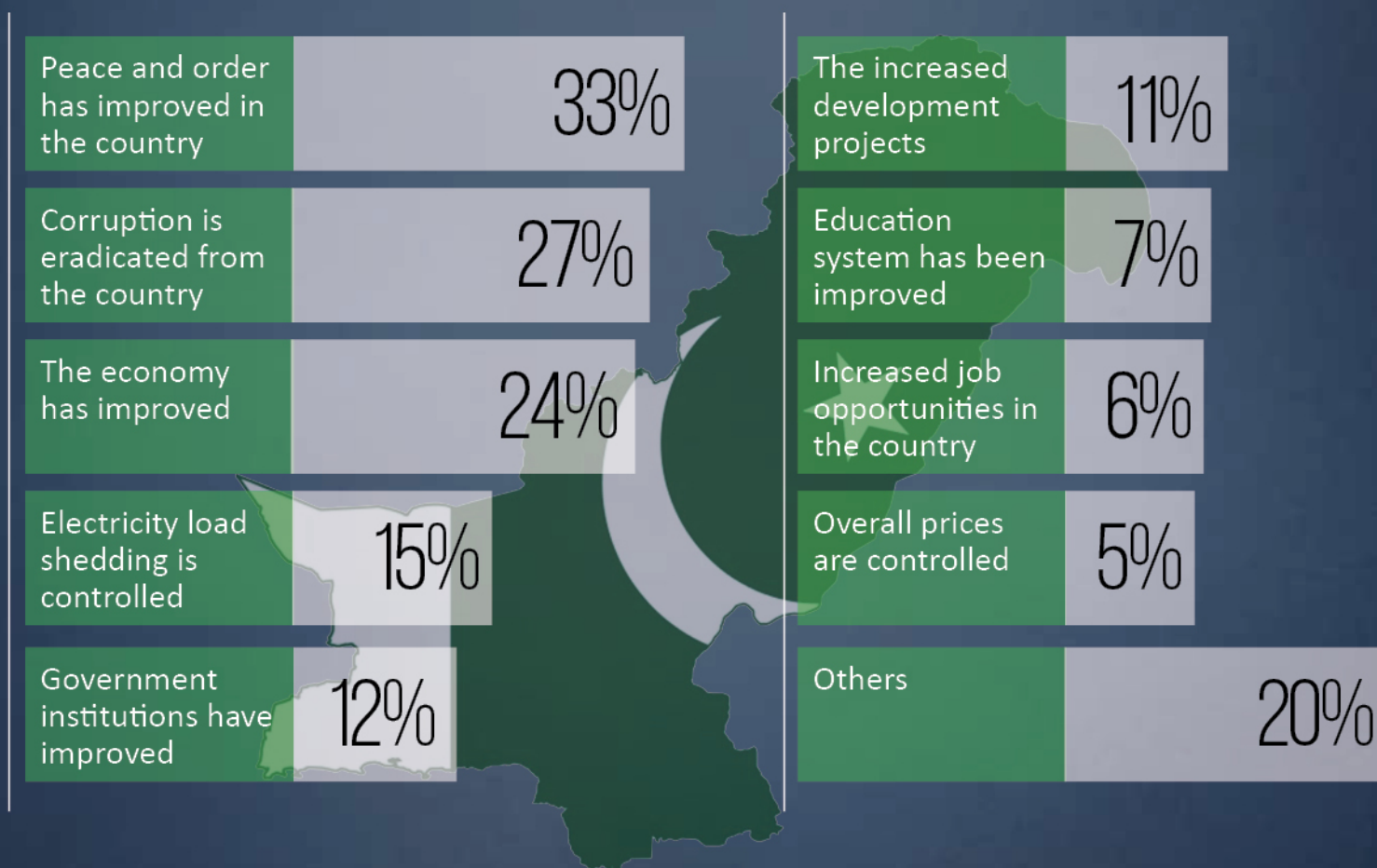

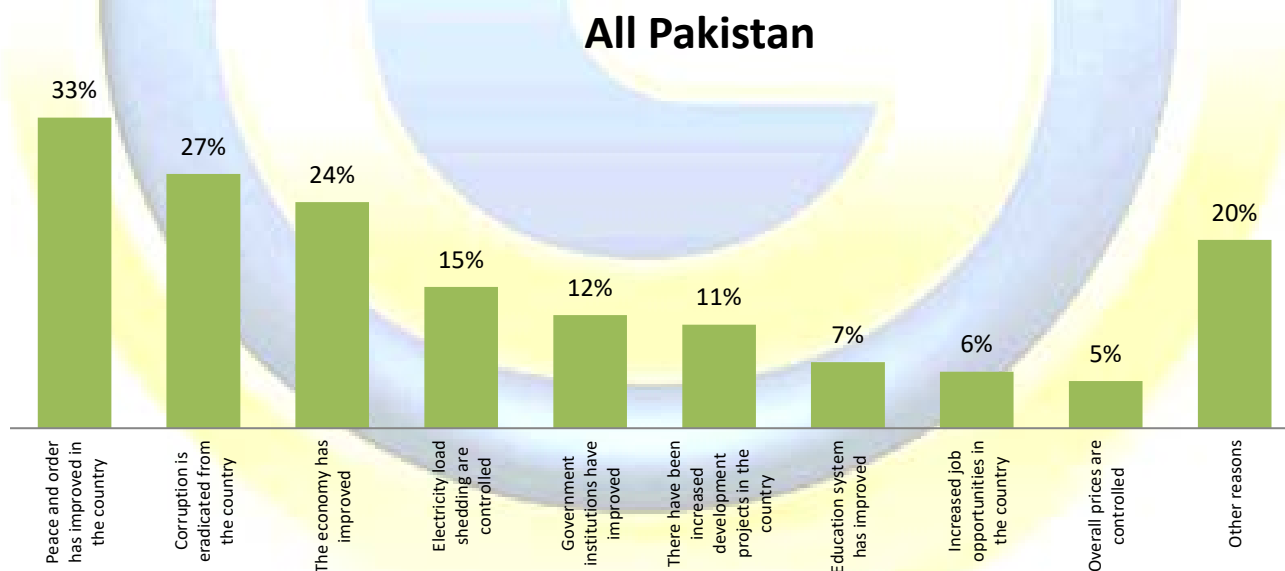
1 in 3 Pakistanis who believe the country is headed in the right direction cite peace and improvement in law-and-order situation in the country as the top reason; followed by 27 % who say corruption is eradicated: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), April 21, 2021

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 1 in 3 Pakistanis who believe the country is headed in the right direction cite peace and improvement in law-and-order situation in the country as the top reason.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces who believe the country is headed in the right direction was asked the following question, “Normally, why do you think our country is headed in the right direction?” In response to this question, 33% said peace and order has improved in the country, 27% said corruption is eradicated from the country, 24% said economy has improved, 15% said electricity load shedding is controlled, 12% said government institutions have improved, 11% said increased development projects in the country, 7% said because the education system has been improved, 6% said increased job opportunities in the country, 5% said inflation control while 20% cited other reasons.

*Survey was conducted between 19th March and 6th April 2021

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,590 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during March 19, 2021 – April 6, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was phone interviews. Respondents hailed from over 100 districts of Pakistan.
