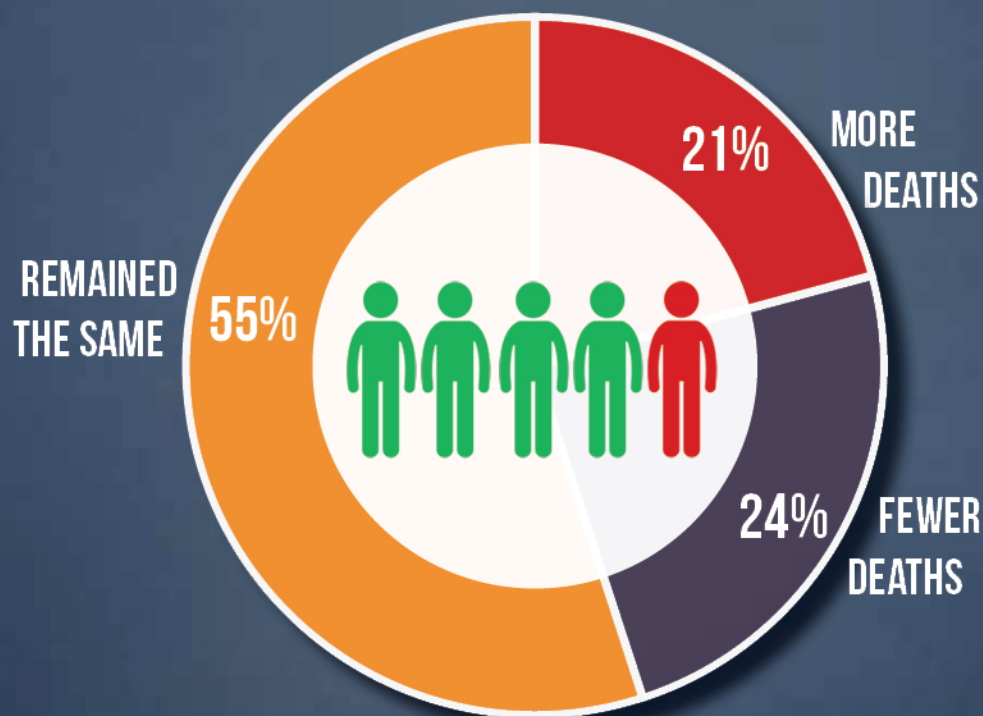

Around 1 in 5 Pakistanis believe that compared to the previous year, there have been more deaths in their family and/or neighborhood: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

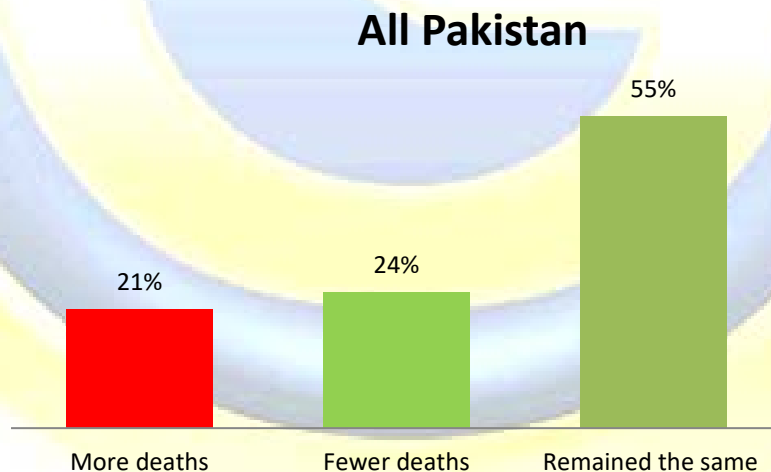

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 21% Pakistanis said that there have been more deaths in their family and/or neighborhood compared to the last year.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Please state if there were more, less or the same number of deaths in your family and/or neighborhood this year, in comparison to the last year?” In response to this question, 21% said ‘More deaths’, 24% said ‘Fewer deaths’ while 55% said that it remained the same.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,590 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during March 19, 2021 – April 6, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was phone interviews. Respondents hailed from over 100 districts of Pakistan.
