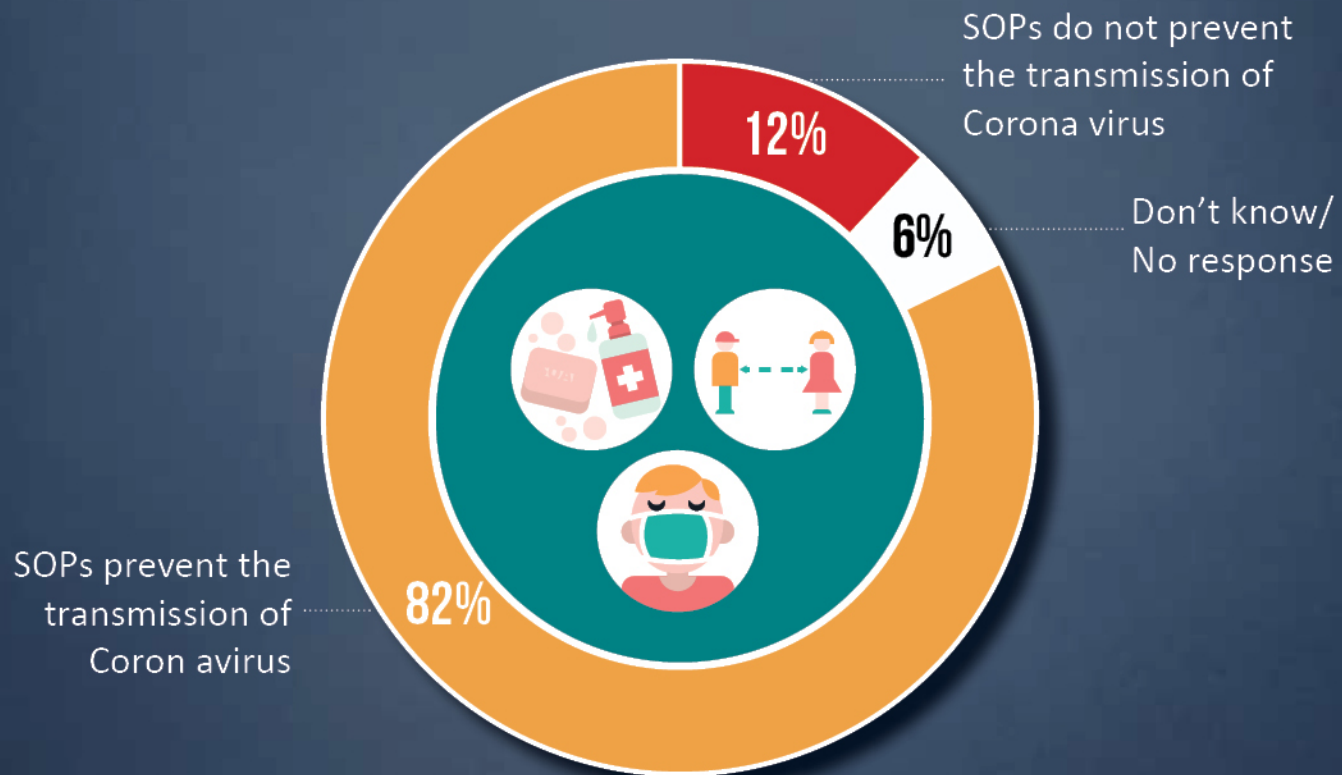

MORE THAN 8 IN 10 PAKISTANIS BELIEVE THAT FOLLOWING SOPS PREVENTS SPREAD OF THE VIRUS: GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN

More than 8 in 10 Pakistanis believe that following SOPs prevents spread of the virus: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

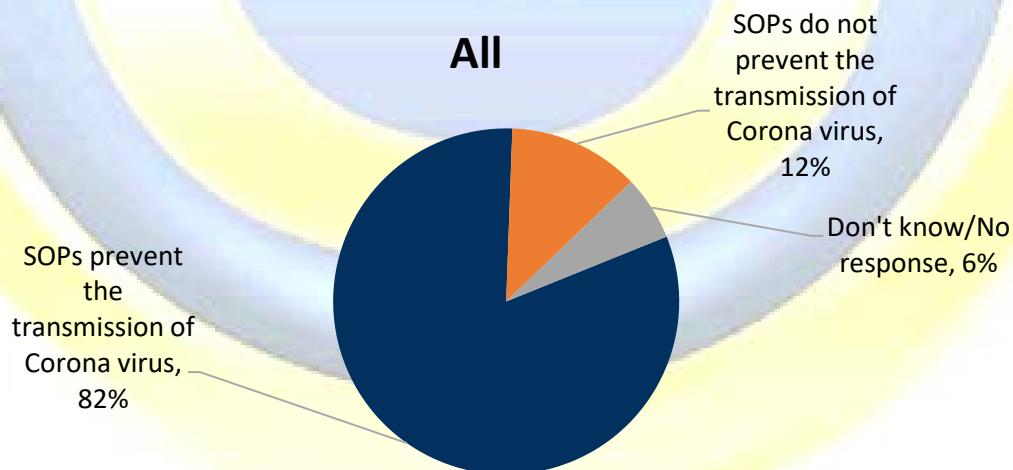

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 82% Pakistanis believe that following SOPs prevents spread of the virus.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Regardless of whether or not you take the necessary preventative measures for Corona Virus, do you think taking these measures (like wearing a mask, washing hands frequently, keeping a social distance of 6 feet) prevents the spread of the virus?” 82% think that following SOPs prevents spread of the virus, 12% think that SOPs do not prevent the spread while 6% did not know or did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,590 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during March 19, 2021 – April 6, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was phone interviews. Respondents hailed from over 100 districts of Pakistan.
