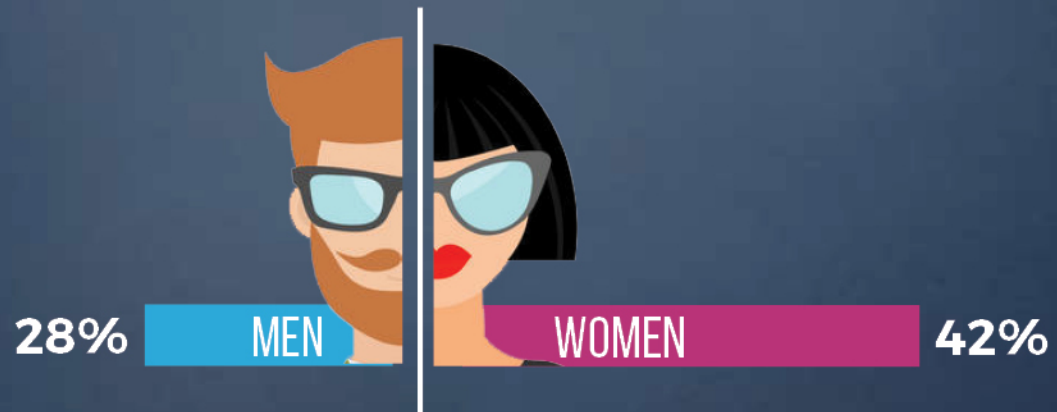

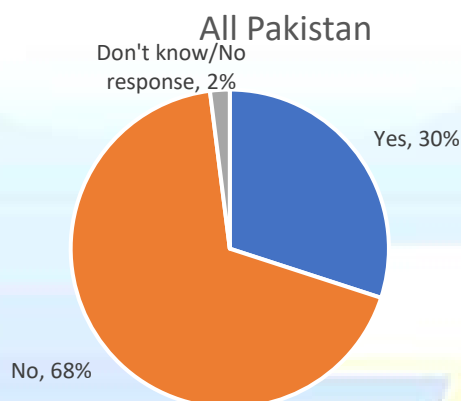

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 30% Pakistanis reported that they wear eyeglasses.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Do you wear eyeglasses?” In response to this question, 30% said ‘Yes’, 68% said ‘No’, while 2% did not know/did not respond.

Question: “Do you wear eyeglasses?”

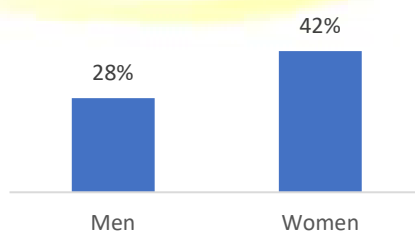

When asked ‘Do you wear eyeglasses?’, 42% Pakistani women said that they wear glasses while 28% of Pakistani men claim to wear glasses.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 616 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during April 24, 2021 – April 31, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
