

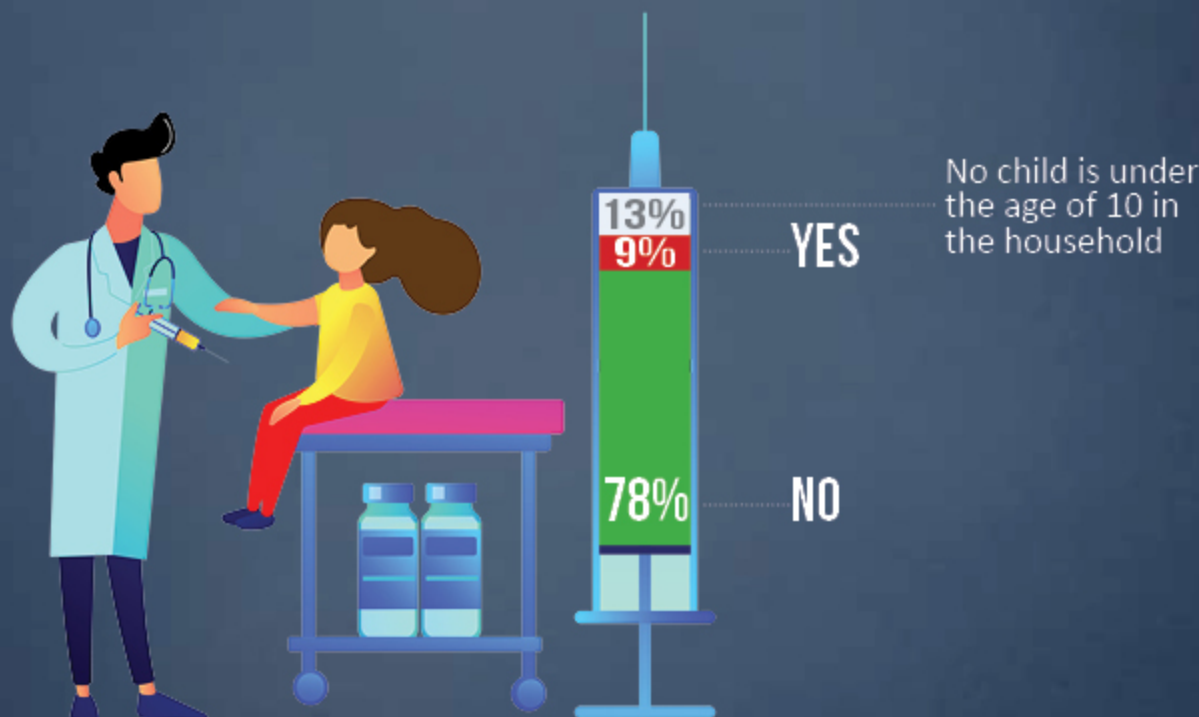

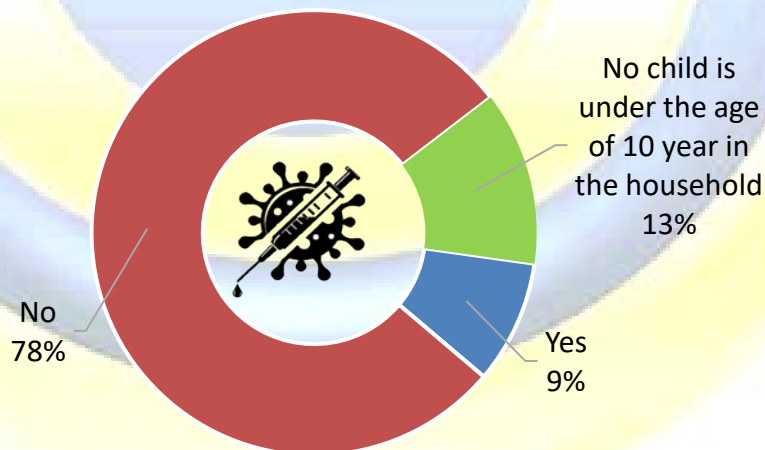
According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 9% Pakistanis said that they missed required vaccines for a child in their household who is under the age of 10.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, ““In the last two months, did you miss any required vaccines for any child who is under the age of 10 in the household?” 9% said ‘Yes’, 78% said ‘No’ while 13% did not have a child under the age of 10.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,590 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during March 19, 2021 – April 6, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was phone interviews. Respondents hailed from over 100 districts of Pakistan.
