Opinion Poll Miscellaneous

Eggplant (7 %), ladyfinger (5 %) and bitter gourd (Karela) (5 %) are among the least favorite vegetables of Pakistanis: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), July 12, 2021

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 7% cite eggplant as their least favorite vegetable.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “*Please tell us, is there any vegetable that is your least favorite?*” In response to this question, 7% said ‘eggplant/brinjal’, 5% said ‘okra/ladyfinger’, 5% said ‘bitter gourd (karela)’, 3% said ‘pumpkin’, 3% said ‘round gourd/tinda’, 2% said ‘cauliflower’, 2% said ‘turnip’, 1% said ‘potato’, 1% said ‘taro’, 1% said ‘spinach’, 1% said ‘capsicum/bell pepper’, 1% said ‘taro (arvi)’, 1% said ‘spinach’ and 1% said ‘capsicum/bell pepper’.

Question: “Please tell us, is there any vegetable that is your least favorite?”

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 616 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during April 24, 2021 – May 15, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
