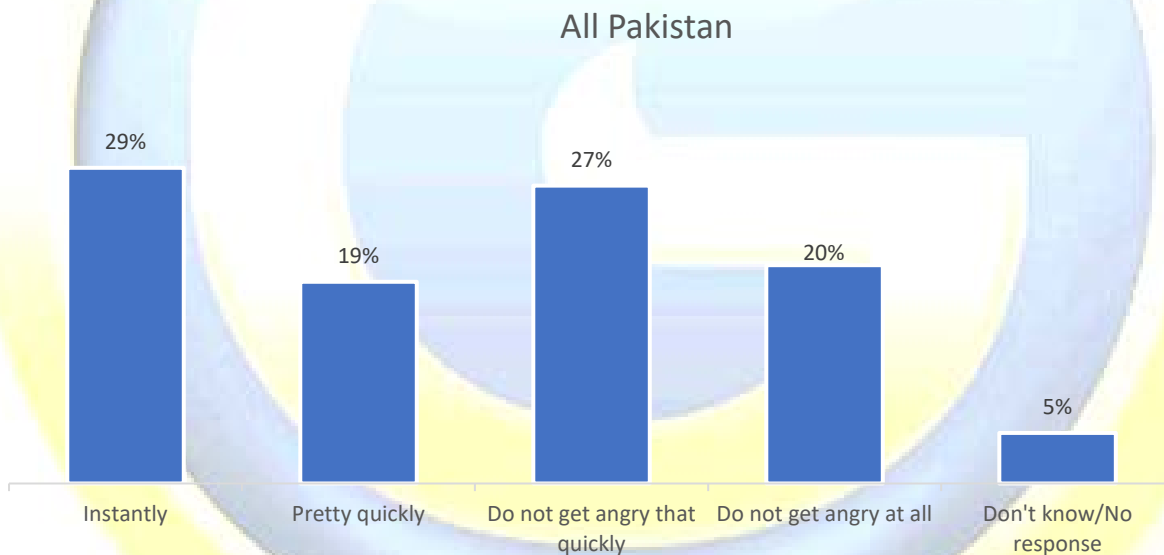
### Nearly half (48%) Pakistanis feel that they get angry quickly: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), July 14, 2021

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 29% Pakistanis say that they get angry instantly and 19% say that they get angry pretty quickly.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “*Some people get angry very quickly whereas other people do not get angry that quickly. How quickly do you think you get angry?*” In response to this question, 29% said ‘instantly’, 19% said ‘pretty quickly’, 27% said ‘do not get angry that quickly’ while 20% said ‘do not get angry at all.’ 5% did not know/did not respond.

**Question: “Some people get angry very quickly whereas other people do not get angry that quickly. How quickly do you think you get angry?”**

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,230 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during April 24, 2021 – April 31, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 2-3$  percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
