66 % Pakistanis state that they would get a COVID-19 vaccine provided it is safe and effective: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

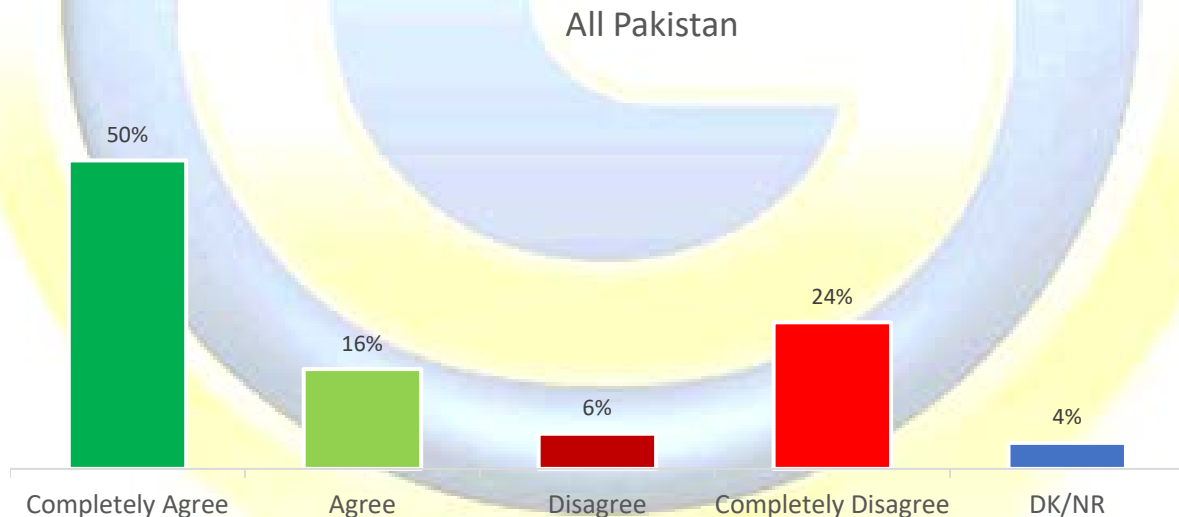

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 66% of Pakistanis agree that they would get a COVID-19 vaccine, given it is safe and effective.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “*Keeping the Corona Virus in mind, kindly state the extent to which you agree or disagree with this statement - If there is a COVID-19 vaccine that is safe and effective, I will get it?*” In response to this question, 50% completely agreed, 16% agreed, 6% disagreed, 24% completely disagreed and 4% did not know/did not respond.

Question: “Keeping the Corona Virus in mind, kindly state the extent to which you agree or disagree with this statement - If there is a COVID-19 vaccine that is safe and effective, I will get it?”

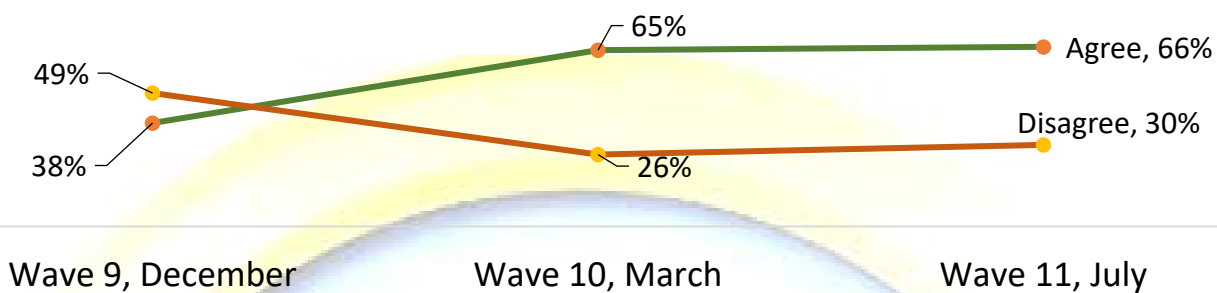

Trend Analysis

As compared to Wave 10 in March (65%), the percentage of people that are more likely to get a COVID-19 vaccine, provided it is safe and effective has only increased very slightly (66%).

Trend Analysis



The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1066 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during July 01, 2021 – July 13, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
