## Opinion Poll Health Coronavirus

**45 % Pakistanis claim that their family members have gotten the COVID-19 vaccine; people from urban areas are more likely to have family members that have received the coronavirus vaccine as compared to those from rural areas: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan**

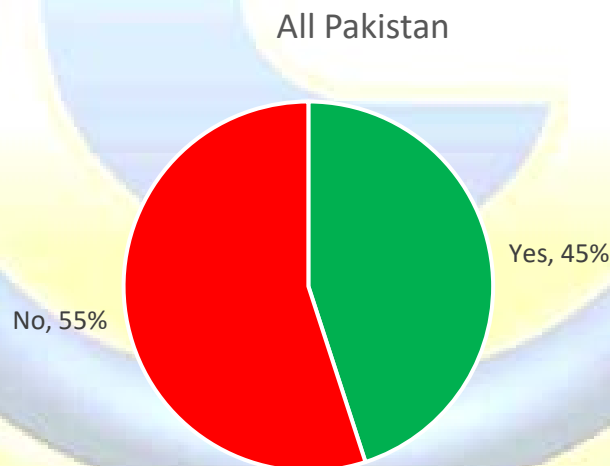

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 45% Pakistanis claim that their family members have gotten the coronavirus vaccine.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “As you know Corona Virus vaccine is now being administered in Pakistan, has any of your family members gotten the vaccine?” In response to this question, 45% responded in the affirmative while 55% responded in the negative.

**Question: “As you know Corona Virus vaccine is now being administered in Pakistan, has any of your family members gotten the vaccine?”**

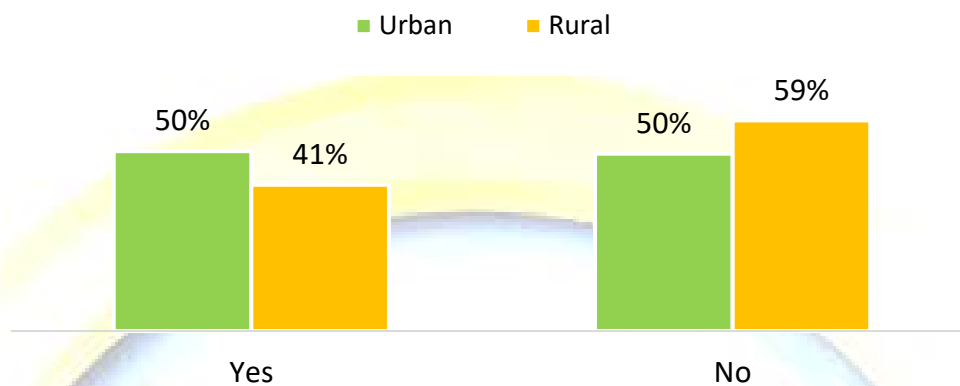

## Urban-rural Breakdown

Urban respondents (50%) are more likely to have family members who have received the coronavirus vaccine as compared to rural respondents (41%).

### Urban-Rural Breakdown



The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1066 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during July 01, 2021 – July 13, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 2-3$  percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
